CONSUMER PRICE INDICES AND INFLATION RATES FOR APRIL 2016

Kenya National Bureau of Statistics hereby releases Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation rates for April, 2016. These numbers have been generated using data collected during the second and third weeks of the month under review. The prices were obtained from selected retail outlets in 25 data collection zones located in Nairobi and 13 other urban centers.

As shown in Tables 1 and 2, the CPI increased by 0.69 per cent from 165.92 in March 2016 to 167.07 in April 2016. The overall inflation rate in April 2016 stood at 5.27 per cent.

increased by 1.48 per cent. As indicated in Table 3, this resulted from notable increases in prices of some food items. However, in totality food inflation stood at 6.84 per cent, which is the lowest, recorded in the recent past.

Over the same review period, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' Index, increased by 0.15 per cent. This small aggregate increase was mainly as a result of price increases in respect of kerosene and other cooking fuels. The cost of electricity however, remained at the same level as in the previous three months of January to March 2016.

The Transport Index decreased by 0.42 per cent in April 2016 compared to the previous month mainly due to reduced costs of petrol.
