

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The Leading Economic Indicators highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) decreased from 193.31 points in June 2018 to 191.59 points in July 2018. The overall rate of inflation rose slightly from 4.28 per cent to 4.35 per cent during the same period. In July 2018, the Kenyan Shilling appreciated against the major trading currencies except for the Sterling Pound and the Ugandan Shilling. The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates decreased slightly from 7.87 per cent in June 2018 to 7.69 per cent in July 2018, while the inter-bank rate rose from 5.03 per cent in June 2018 to 5.06 per cent in July 2018.

The Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE) 20 share index increased from 3,286 points in June 2018 to 3,320 points in July 2018, while the total number of shares traded dropped from 453 million shares to 323 million shares during the same period. The total value of NSE shares traded decreased from KSh 13.69 billion in June 2018 to KSh 9.74 billion in July 2018.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, increased from KSh 3,242.94 billion in June 2018 to KSh 3,258.99 billion in July 2018. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves increased from KSh 1,221.83 billion in June 2018 to KSh 1,235.33 billion in July 2018. Net Foreign Exchange Reserves decreased from KSh 760.51 billion in June 2018 to KSh 759.29 billion in July 2018.

AGRICULTURE



The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange was 1,221.20 MT in July 2018 while the average auction price stood at KSh 356.73 per kilogram over the same period. The quantity of produced tea decreased from 43,299.06 MT in June 2018 to 35,278.16 MT in July 2018. The price of processed tea dropped from KSh 257.40 to KSh

250.84 per kilogram over the same period. The amount of cane deliveries decreased from 436.86 thousand tonnes in March 2018 to 386.12 thousand tonnes in April 2018. The average monthly price per Kg for maize was 36.20 KSh in July 2018. Bean prices averaged at KSh 82.40 per Kg during the same month.

The quantity of cut-flower horticultural exports in April 2018 was at 12,833.44 MT while its' value of exports was KSh 9,116.46 million during the period. The volume of vegetable exports decreased from 7,548.81 MT in March 2018 to 4,825.37 MT in April 2018. The value of vegetable exports increased from KSh 2,098.62 million in March 2018 to KSh 2,130.99 million in April 2018.

INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported increased from 4,649.03 MT in June 2018 to 4,683.09 MT in July 2018, while its value went down from KSh 2,664.46 million to KSh 2,457.05 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported increased from 45,182.12 MT in June 2018 to 45,242.32 MT in July 2018, while its value decreased from KSh 12,463.24 million to KSh 12,226.12 million over the same period.

Volume of trade rose from KSh 195.44 billion in June 2018 to KSh 205.60 billion in July 2018. The value of total exports decreased to KSh 52.89 billion in July 2018 while the value of imports rose from KSh 142.52 billion in June 2018 to KSh 152.71 billion in July 2018.

Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages was the main export category in July 2018 accounting for 51.93 per cent of exports, while non-food industrial supplies and consumer goods not elsewhere specified accounted for 19.72 per cent and 25.47 per cent of the value of total domestic exports, respectively.

Imports by BEC indicate that non-food industrial supplies was the main import category in July 2018 with a share of 33.98 per cent. Machinery & other capital equipment; fuel and lubricants; and transport equipment constituted 16.77, 19.82 and 12.42 per cent, of the total value of imports, respectively. Imports of food and beverage recorded a share of 8.90 per cent of the total imports while consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 7.96 per cent in July 2018.

ENERGY



Total local electricity generation increased from 914.48 million KWh in June 2018 to 947.01 million KWh in July 2018. In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil decreased from an average of US Dollars 73.22 per barrel in June 2018 to US Dollars 57.70 per barrel in July 2018.

The national average domestic retail oil prices of motor gasoline premium rose from KSh 109.67 per litre in June 2018 to

KSh 113.07 per litre in July 2018. The price of light diesel oil dropped slightly to retail at KSh 104.21 in July 2018. The average price for Kerosene rose to retail at KSh 86.69 in July 2018 up from 85.05 in June 2018. Charcoal prices averaged KSh 137.39 per 4KG tin in July 2018. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,176.31 in July 2018.


MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION



The quantity of cement produced increased from 452,034 MT in May 2018 to 454,322 MT in June 2018. Consumption of cement rose from 436,722 MT in May 2018 to 447,381 MT in June 2018. Sugar production decreased from 40,918 Metric tonnes in March 2018 to 38,573 Metric tonnes in April 2018. Production of assembled vehicles

decreased from 548 units in March 2018 to 425 units in April 2018. Milk uptake in the formal sector rose from 49.63 million litres in May 2018 to 50.33 million litres in June 2018.

ICT, TOURISM AND TRANSPORT



The total number of mobile money transactions was 137.41 million transactions in June 2018 while their value stood at KSh 317.67 billion over the same period. The value of imports for telecommunication equipment rose from KSh 1,659.62 million in April 2018 to KSh 1,981.77 million in May 2018.

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports (MIA) increased to 76,608 in June 2018 up from 75,028 persons in May 2018.

The number of passengers who landed at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) increased from 265,055 in June 2018 to 309,352 in July 2018, while passengers who embarked increased from 152,090 persons to 174,891 persons during the same period.

Fig. 1: Inflation rates



Fig. 2: End of Month Mean Exchange rate of Kenya Shillings against Major Selected Currencies



Fig. 3: Nairobi Securities Exchange 20 Share Index



Fig. 4: Coffee Sales at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange



Fig. 5: Tea Production



Fig. 6: Cane Deliveries



Fig. 7: Electricity Generation by Source



Fig. 9: Average Prices for Liquefied Petroleum Gas in Kenya ('000 KSh per 13 Kg cylinder)



Fig. 10: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector



Fig. 11: Visitor Arrivals through J.K.I.A and M.I.A


