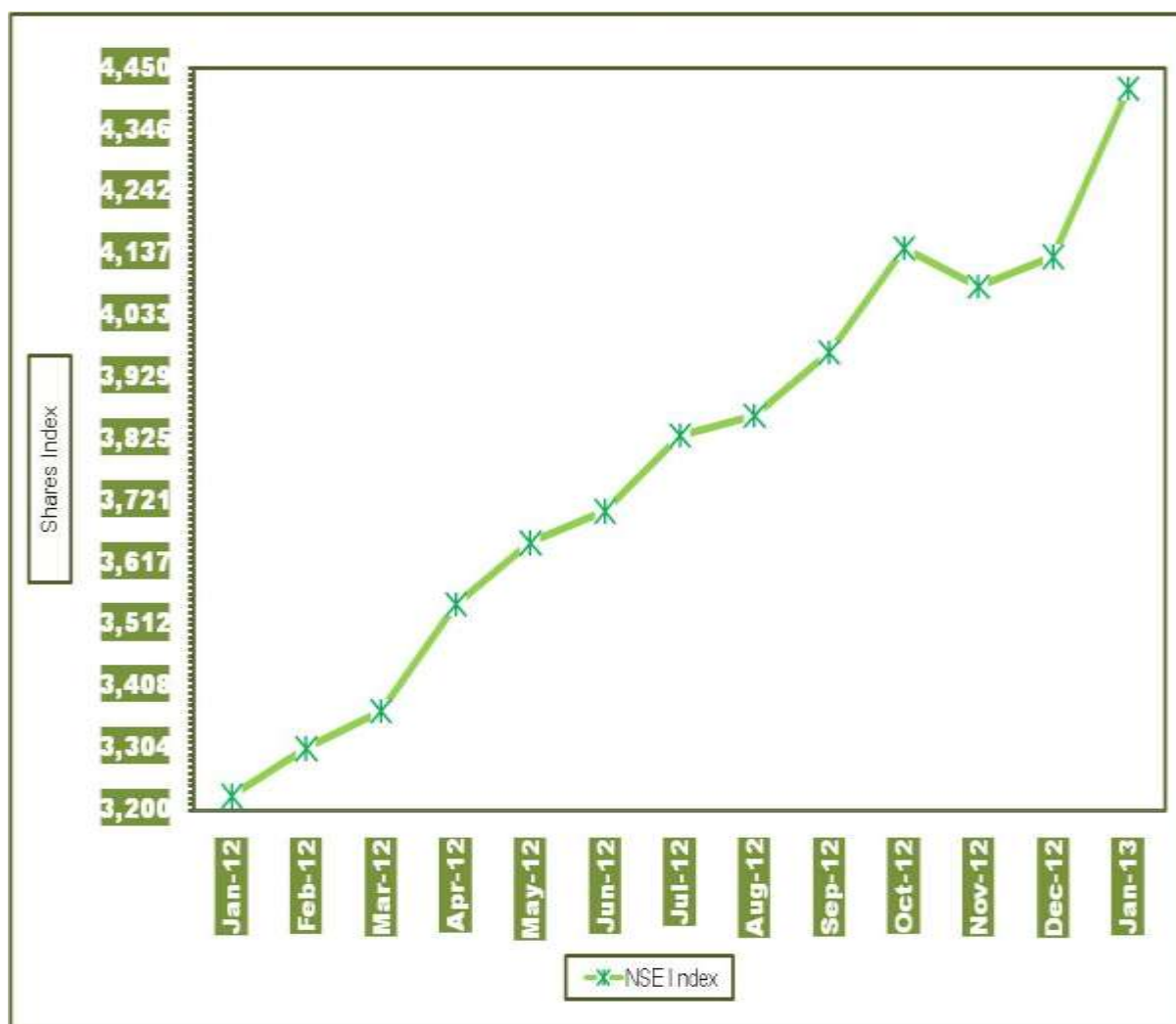

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators publication for January 2013 highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 1.02 per cent from 134.25 points in December 2012 to 135.62 points in January 2013. The overall rate of inflation increased to 3.67 per cent from 3.20 per cent in the same period. The Kenyan Shilling appreciated against worlds' major currencies; the Sterling Pound, the Japanese Yen, the South African rand and Tanzanian shilling to exchange at an average of KSh 138.589, 139.019, 96.289, 9.7006 and 18.4452 respectively, as at the end of January 2013. However, the shilling depreciated against the US dollar, Euro and the Ugandan shilling.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, decreased from 8.25 per cent in December 2012 to 8.097 in January 2013. The inter-bank rates remained at 5.89 during the period. The Nairobi Stock Exchange share index (NSE 20) increased from 4,133 points in December 2012 to 4,417 points in Jan 2013, while the total number of shares traded rose substantially by 12.3 per cent from 462 million shares traded to 519 million shares traded during the same period. The total value of shares traded at the NSE increased from KSh 7.6 billion to KSh 8.5 billion. Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, expanded from KSh 1,727.3 billion in December 2012 to 1,729.6 billion in January 2013. In contrast, Money and quasi-money (M2) decreased from KSh 1,469.0 billion to KSh 1,455.7 billion over the same period. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves and Net Foreign Exchange Reserves inflated to 635.1 billion and KSh 349.6 billion respectively, over the same period.

A). AGRICULTURE

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange dropped from 1,794 MT in November 2012 to 1,075 MT in December 2012 while its average auction price went up from KSh 272.27 per kilogram to KSh 307.99 per kilogram in the same period. The quantity of processed tea went up from 39,977 MT in November 2012 to 41,401 MT in December 2012 while its average auction price rose from KSh 277.26 per kilogram to KSh 281.47 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize declined from KSh 38.27 per kilogram in November 2012 to KSh 36.80 per kilogram in December 2012 while the average price for dry beans in December 2012 averaged KSh 73.19 per Kilogram.

B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported decreased from 4,109.6 MT in November 2012 to 2,223.2 MT in December 2012 and its value went down from KSh 1,453.1 million to KSh 740.4 million over the same period. In contrast, the quantity of tea exported dropped from 38,681.5 MT in November 2012 to 30,067.4 MT in December 2012, while its value decreased from KSh 10,840.4 million in November 2012 to KSh 8,462.9 million in December 2012. Volume of trade fell by 10.7 per cent from KSh 176.0 billion in November 2012 to KSh 157.2 billion in December 2012. Similarly, total value of exports decreased by 13.2 per cent, while the value of imports went down by 9.9 per cent over the same period. Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that food and beverages category was the main export category in December 2012 with a share of 42.66 per cent, while the value of Non-food industrial supplies and Consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered a share of 28.44 and 24.70 per cent, respectively. All the other economic categories recorded less than 5.0 per cent shares. Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that fuel and lubricants was the main import category in December 2012 with a share of 28.18 per cent, while the values of industrial supplies, transport equipment, machinery & other capital equipment and registered shares of 26.25, 16.06 and 15.57 per cent respectively. Food and beverage realized a share of 6.41 per cent while Consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 6.96 per cent.

C). ENERGY

Total electricity generation declined marginally from 673.6 million KWh in November 2012 to 669.2 million KWh in December 2012. Domestic consumption of electricity increased by 1.7 per cent from 537.3 million KWh in November 2012 to 546.2 million KWh in December 2012. The total consumption of petroleum products increased to 297.88 thousand MT in December 2012 from 313.05 thousand MT recorded in November 2012. National domestic average oil prices of motor gasoline premium decreased to retail at an average of KSh 112.35 per litre in January 2013 from KSh 113.35 per litre retailed in December 2012. The price of light diesel oil fell to KSh 104.83 in January 2013 from KSh 106.64 in December 2012. The average price for kerosene went up to retail at KSh 84.71 from KSh 87.29 during the same period. In Nairobi, average retail prices for motor gasoline decreased from the retail price of KSh 112.61 per litre in December 2012 to retail at KSh 111.60 per litre in January 2013. The price of kerosene fell to retail at KSh 83.86 and light diesel oil fell to 103.99 per litre respectively, during the same period.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil rose by 1.17 per cent per barrel from US Dollars 110.75 per barrel in December 2012 to US Dollars 112.05 per barrel in January 2013.

D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION

Domestic production of sugar rose from 31,886 MT in November 2012 to 34,651 MT in December 2012. Production of soft drinks went up from 31,497 MT to 33,067 MT during the same period. The production of

new assembled vehicles decreased further from 420 vehicles in November 2012 to 344 vehicles in December 2012. The production of galvanized dropped by 3.1 per cent from 21967 MT in November 2012 to 21,283 MT in December 2012. The quantity of cement produced decreased by 14.1 per cent from 415,866 MT in November 2012 to 357,212 MT in December 2012. On the other hand, consumption of cement fell by 18.8 per cent from 382,400 MT recorded in November 2012 to 310,639 MT in December 2012. Milk deliveries to the formal sector increased by 2.4 per cent from 48.6 million litres in November 2012 to 50.0 million litres in December 2012.

E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT

The number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Moi International Airports decreased by 16.5 per cent from 99,257 persons recorded in November 2012 to 115,655 persons in December 2012. The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) went up 0.4 per cent from 183,889 persons in November 2012 to 184,194 persons in December 2012, while passengers who landed increased from 183,240 persons to 183,972 persons in the same period. The total number of vehicles registered went up from 11,689 vehicles in December 2012 to 20,997 vehicles in January 2013. Motor cycles remained the leading category of vehicles registered during the month of January 2012 accounting for 64.0 per cent of the total.

FIG. 1: INFLATION RATES

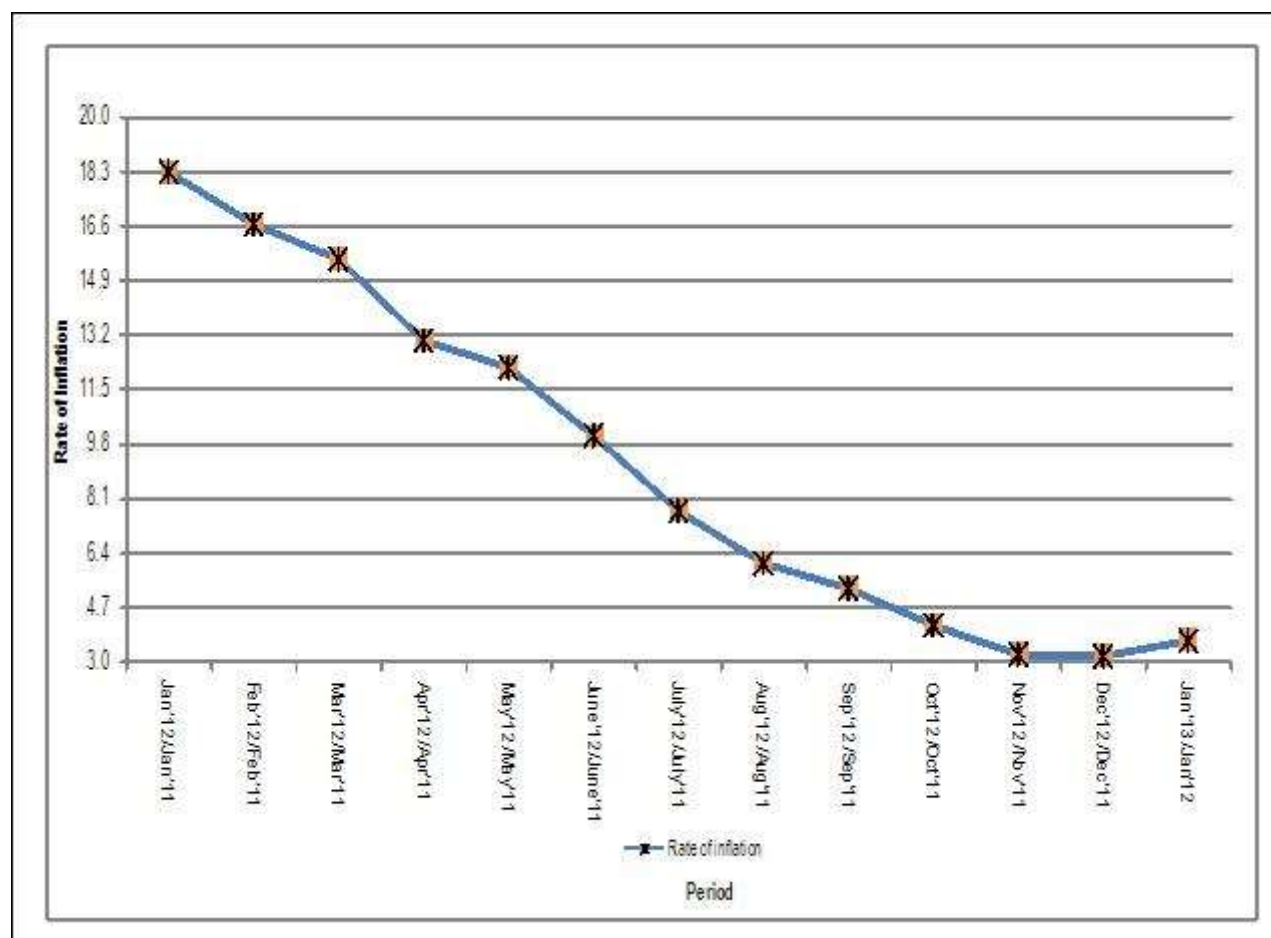

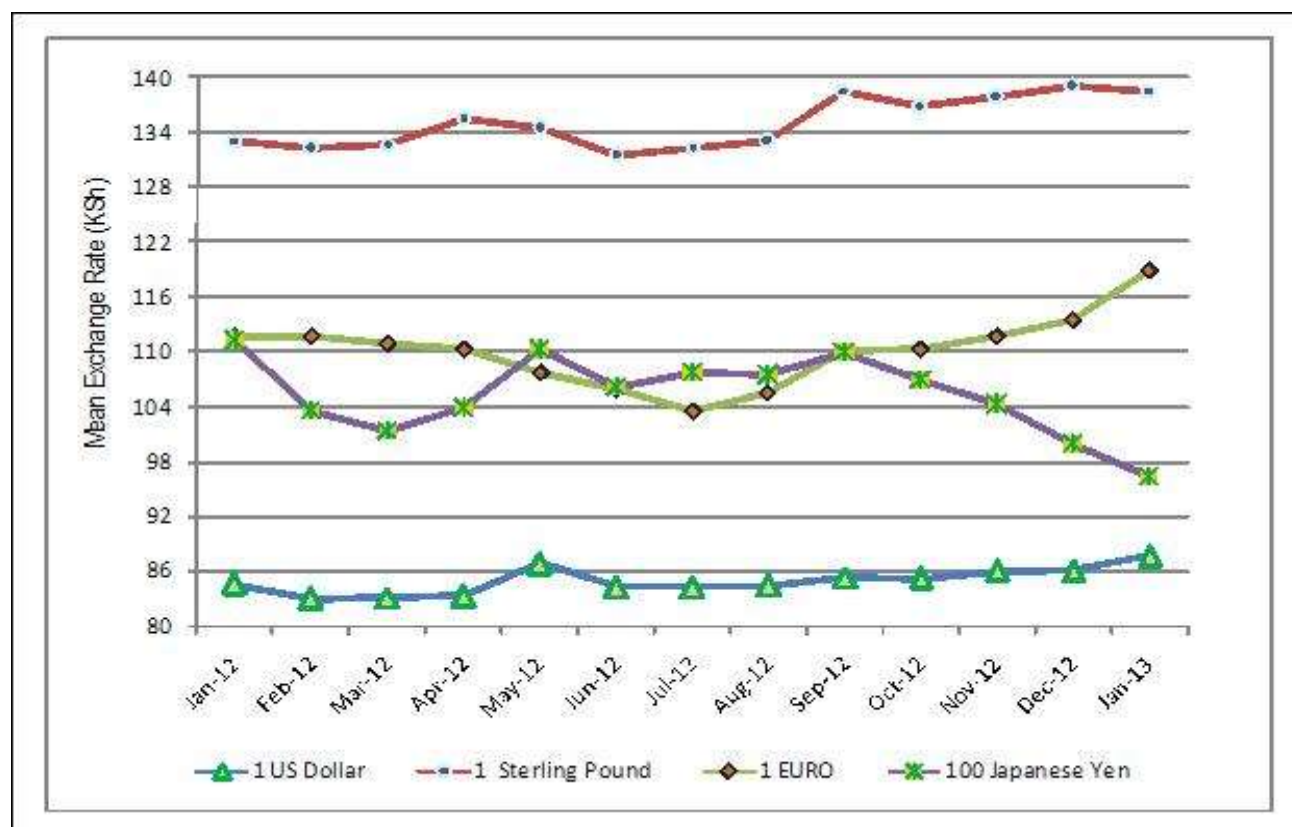

FIG 3: INTEREST RATES

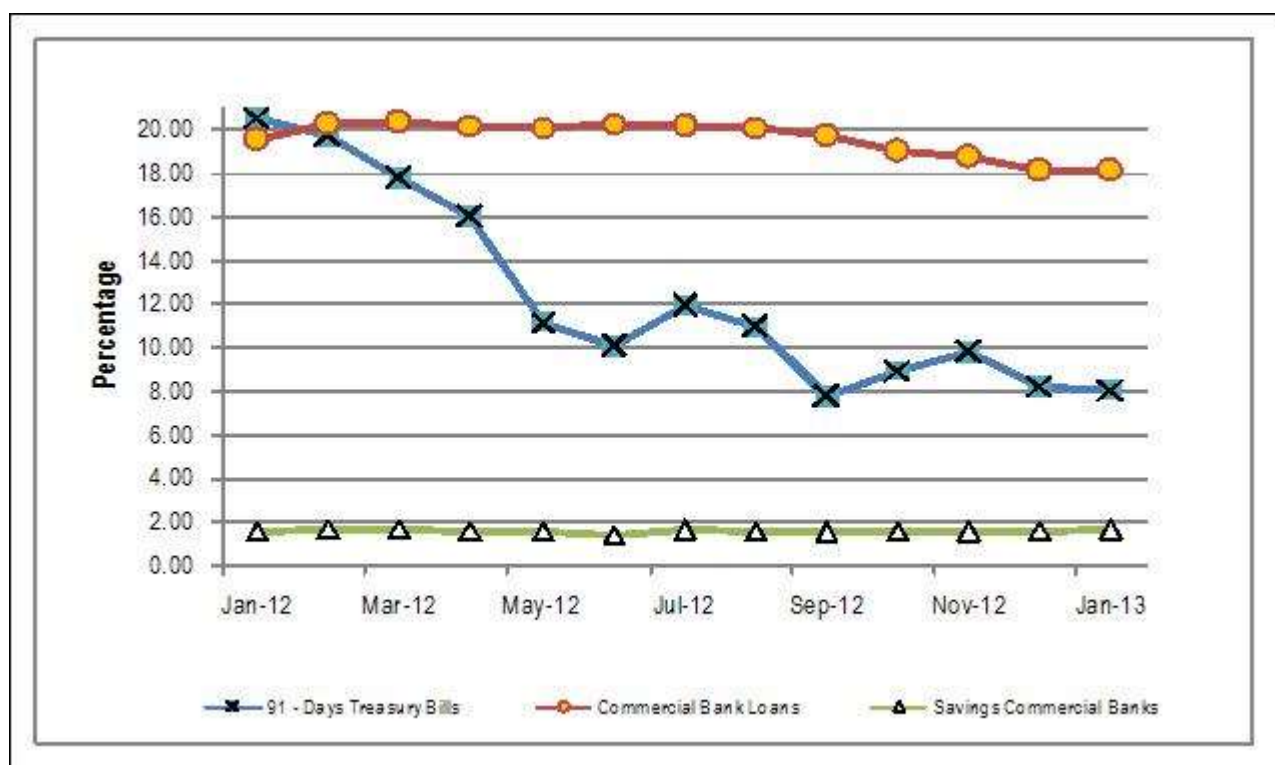

FIG 4: NAIROBI STOCK EXCHANGE SHARES INDEX

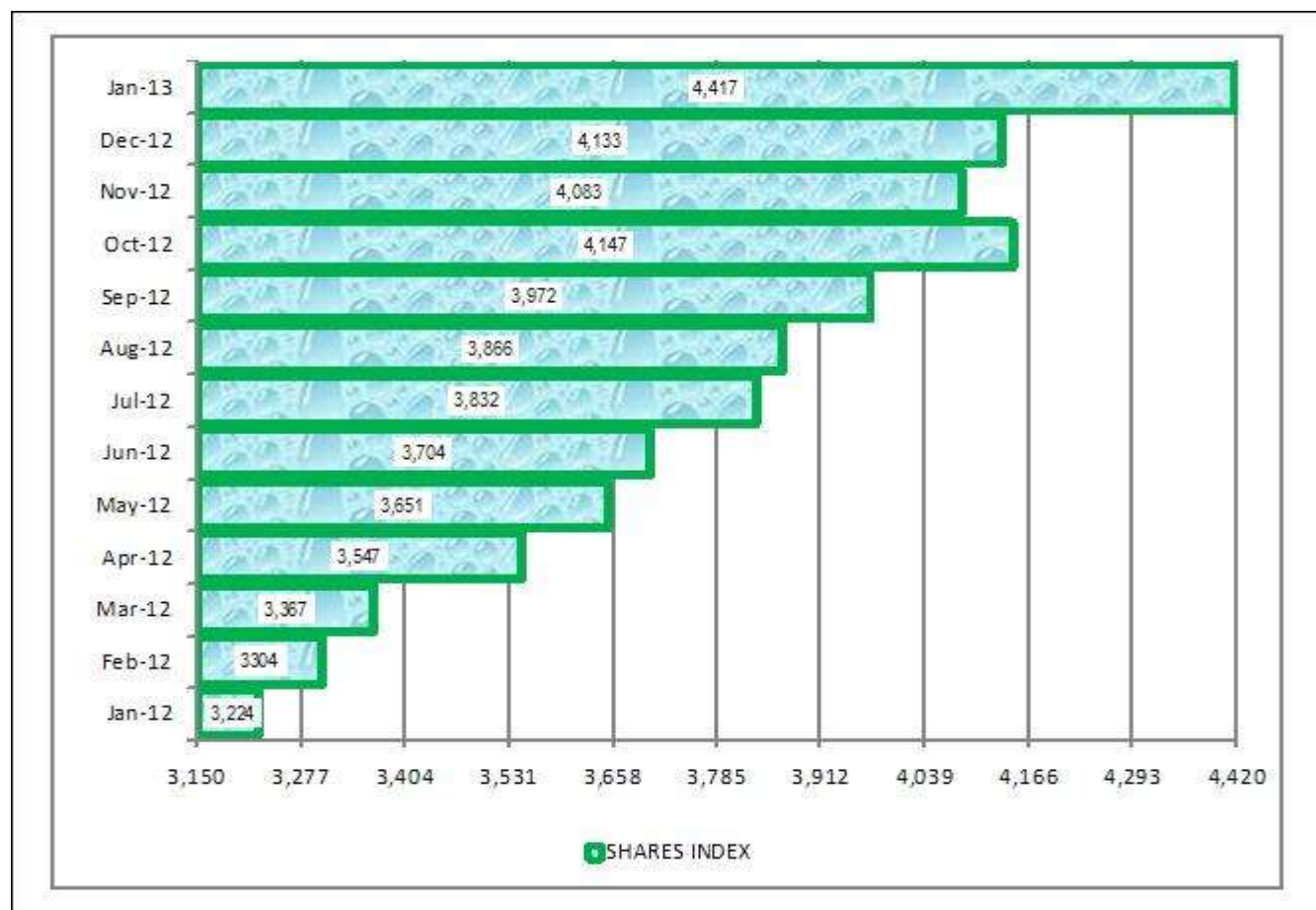

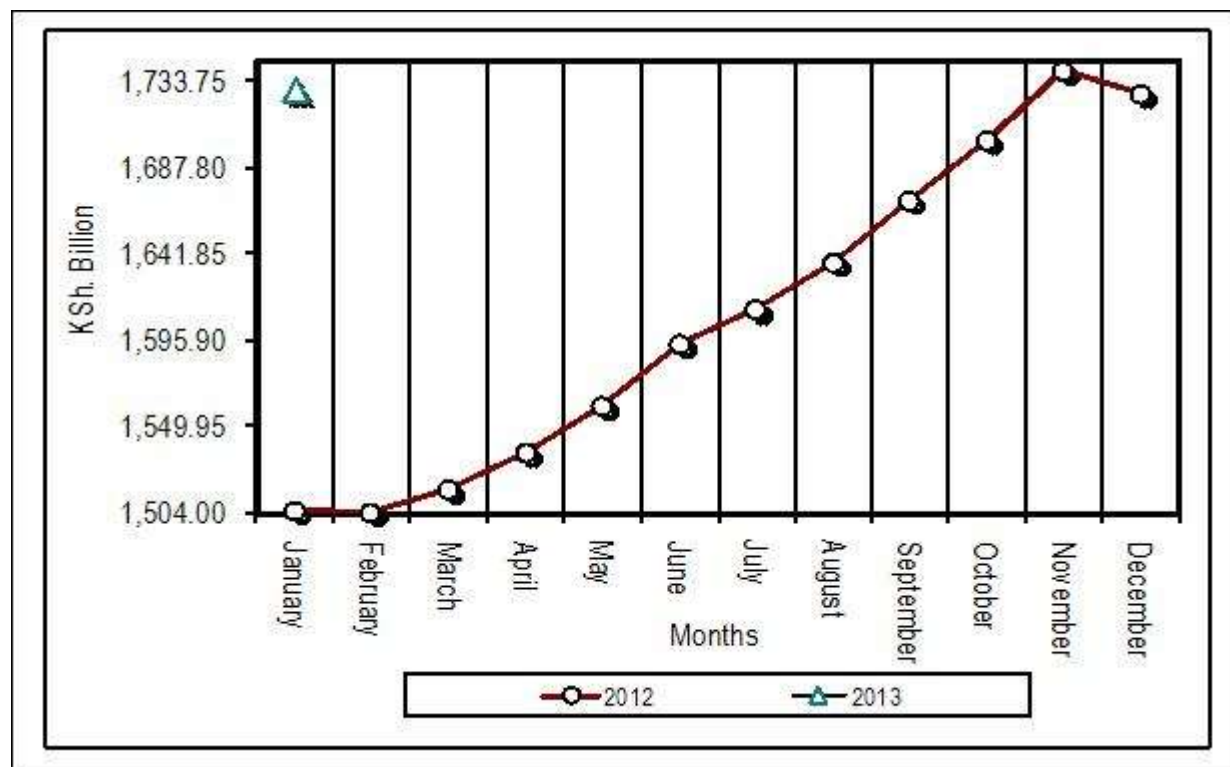
FIG 5: MONEY SUPPLY (M3)

FIG 6: FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

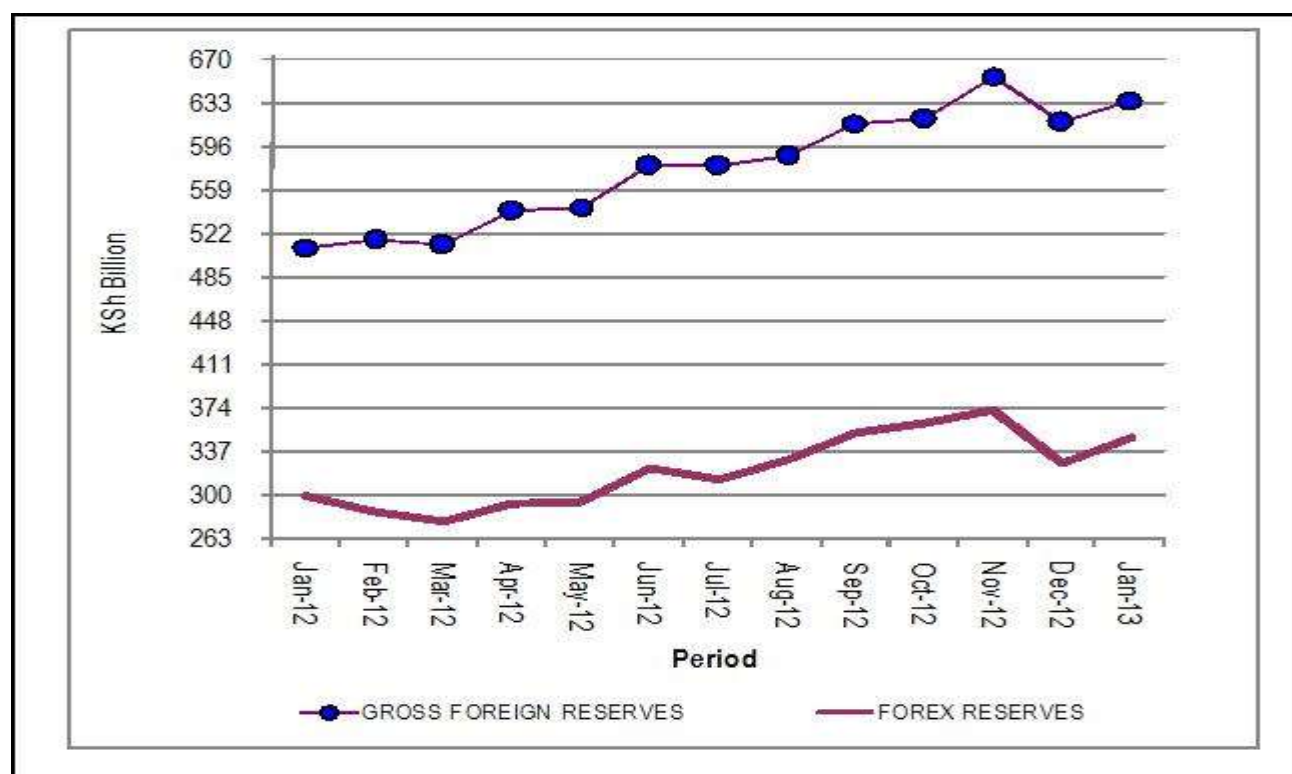

FIG.7: COFFEE SALES AT THE NAIROBI COFFEE EXCHANGE

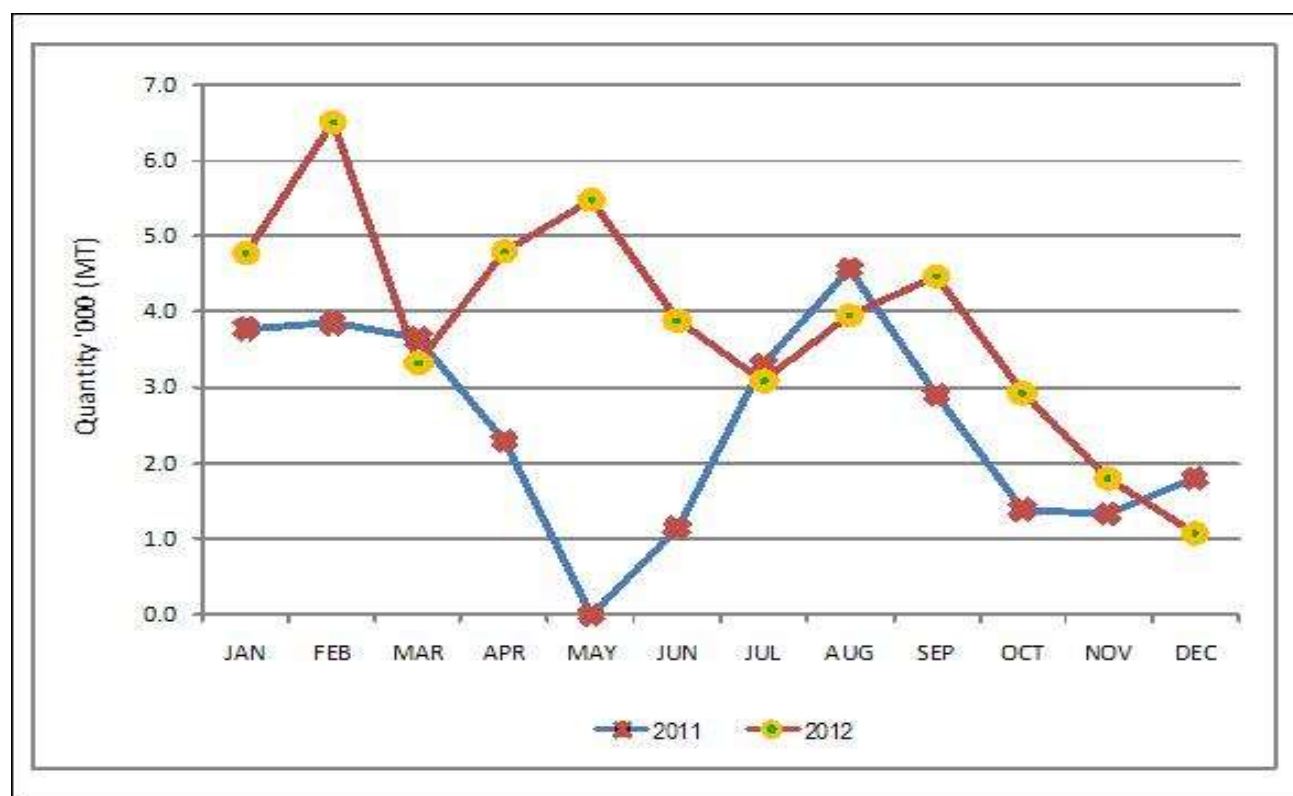

FIG.9: CANE DELIVERIES

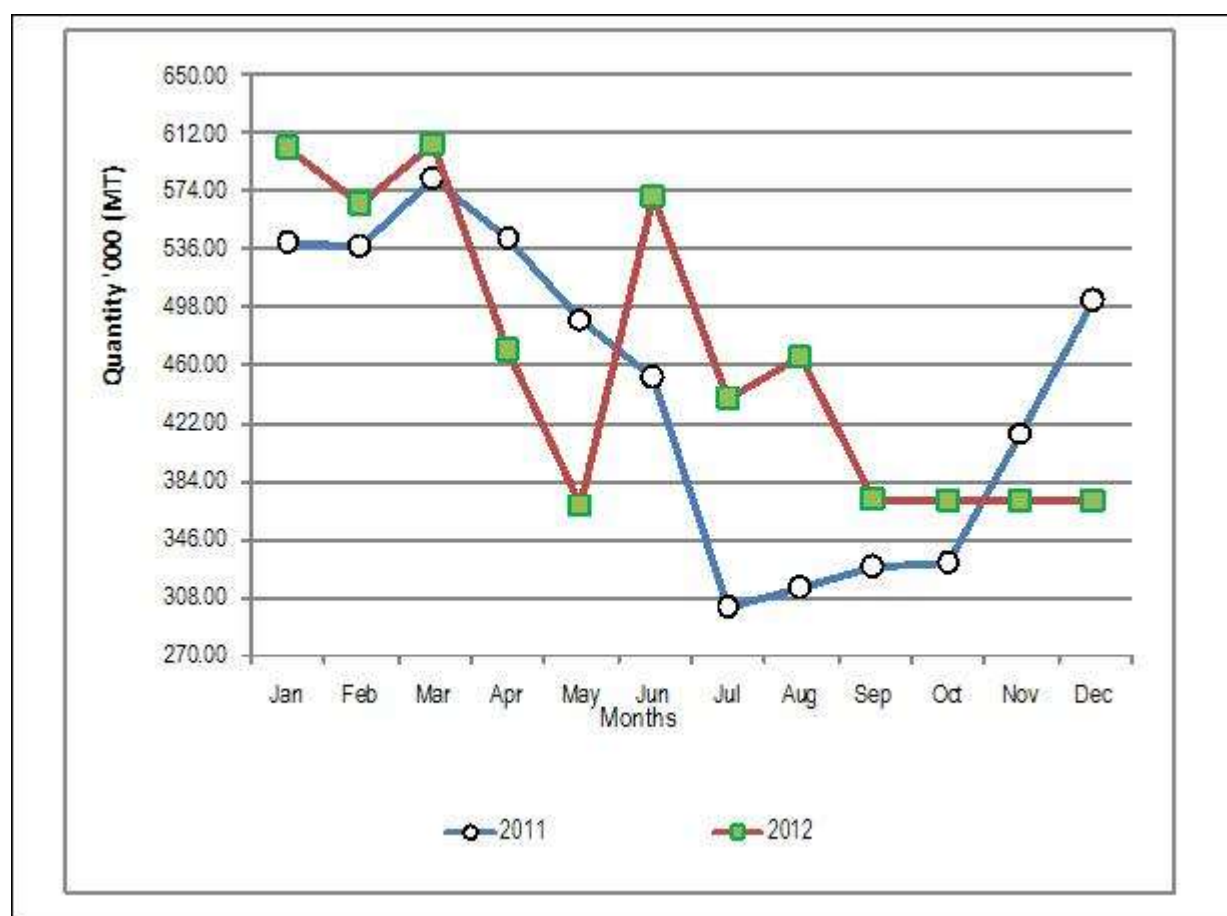

FIG 10: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE

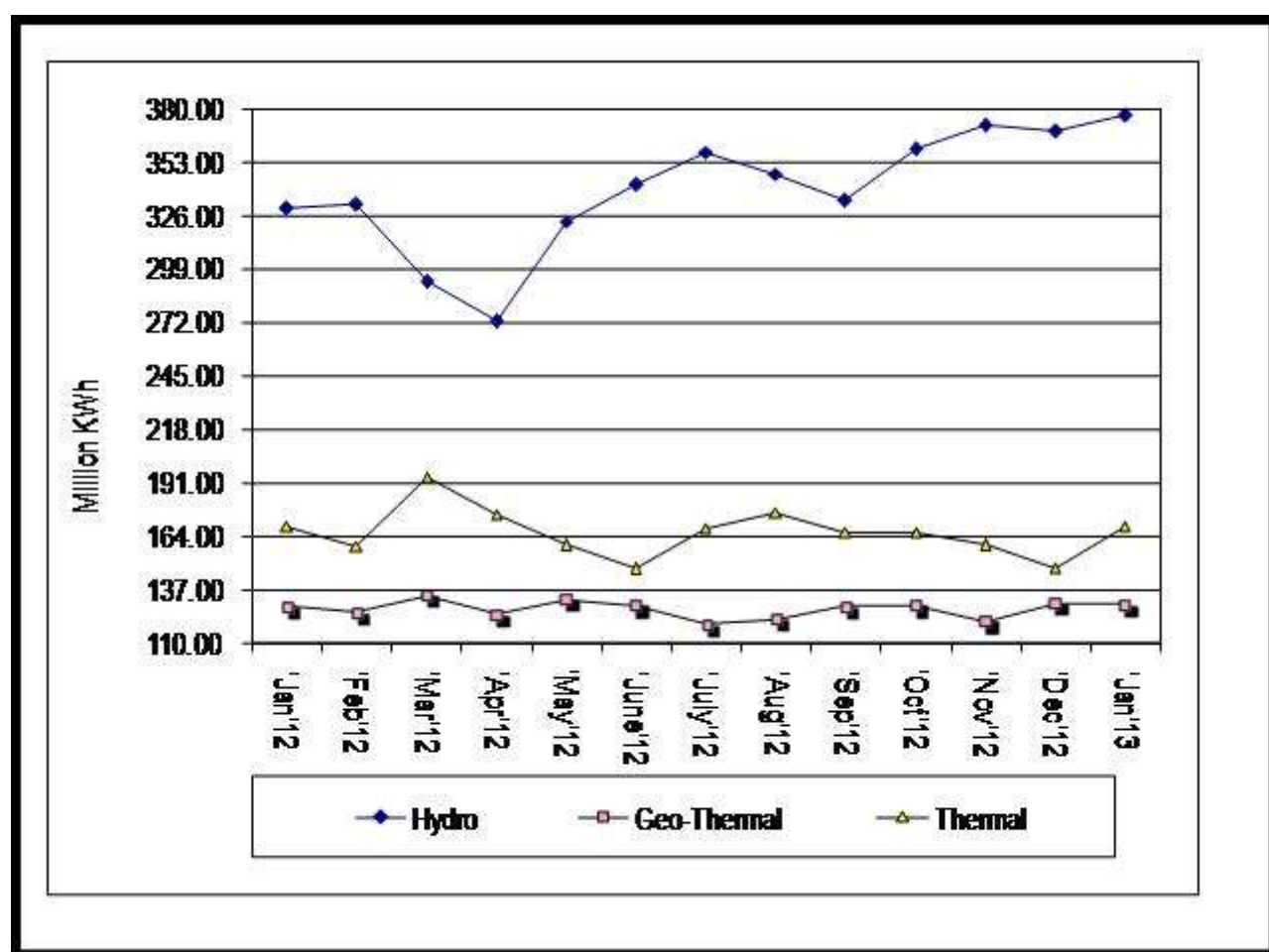

FIG 11: ELECTRICITY GENERATION, CONSUMPTION AND POWER LOSSES

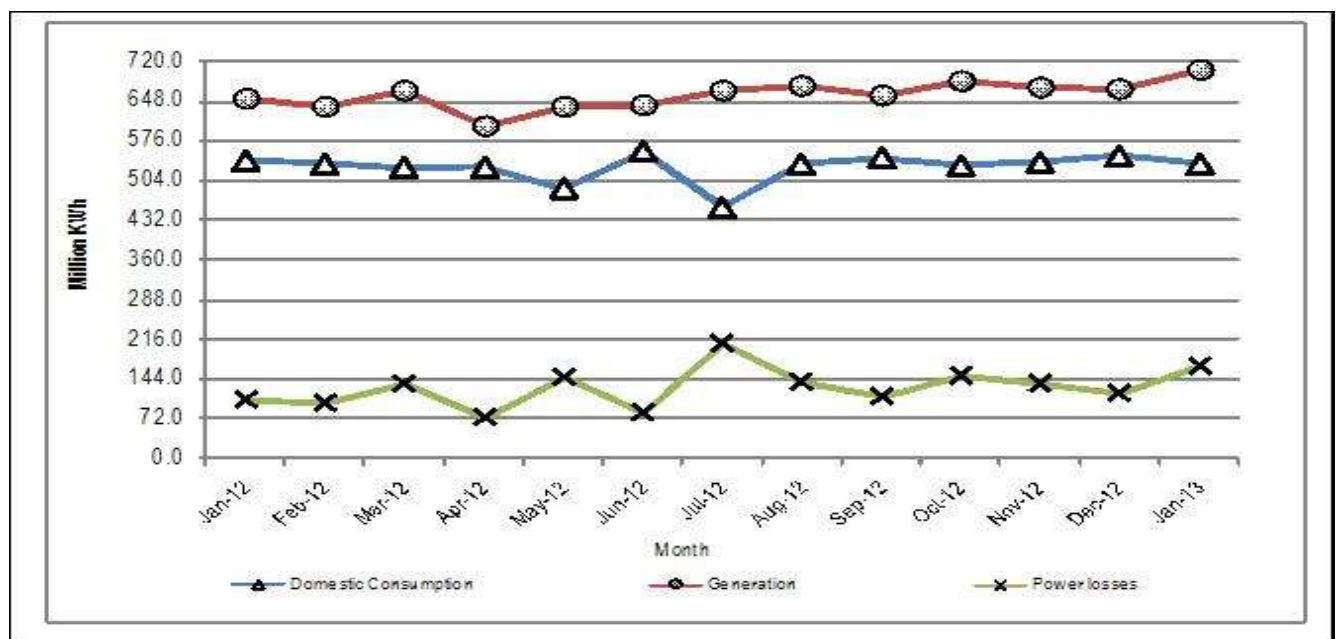

FIG 12(A): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

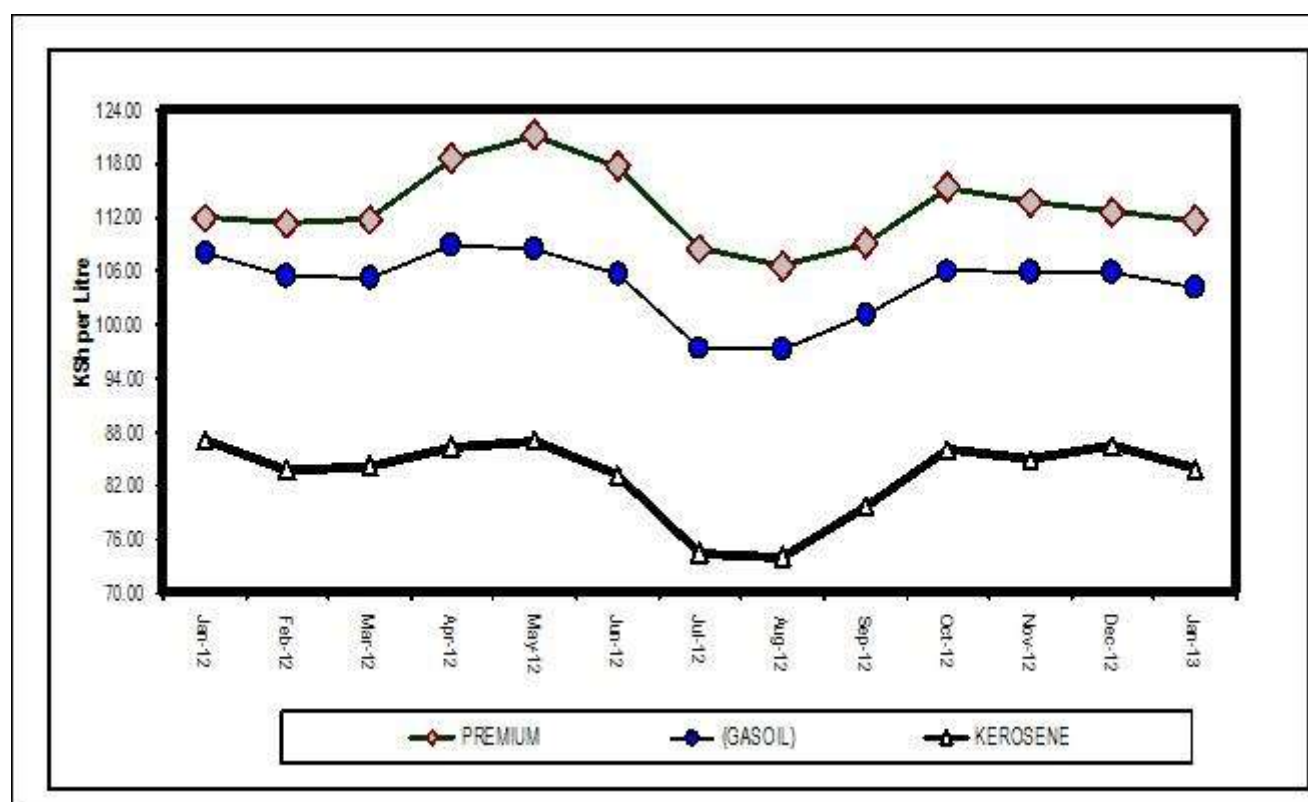

FIG 12(B): AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA

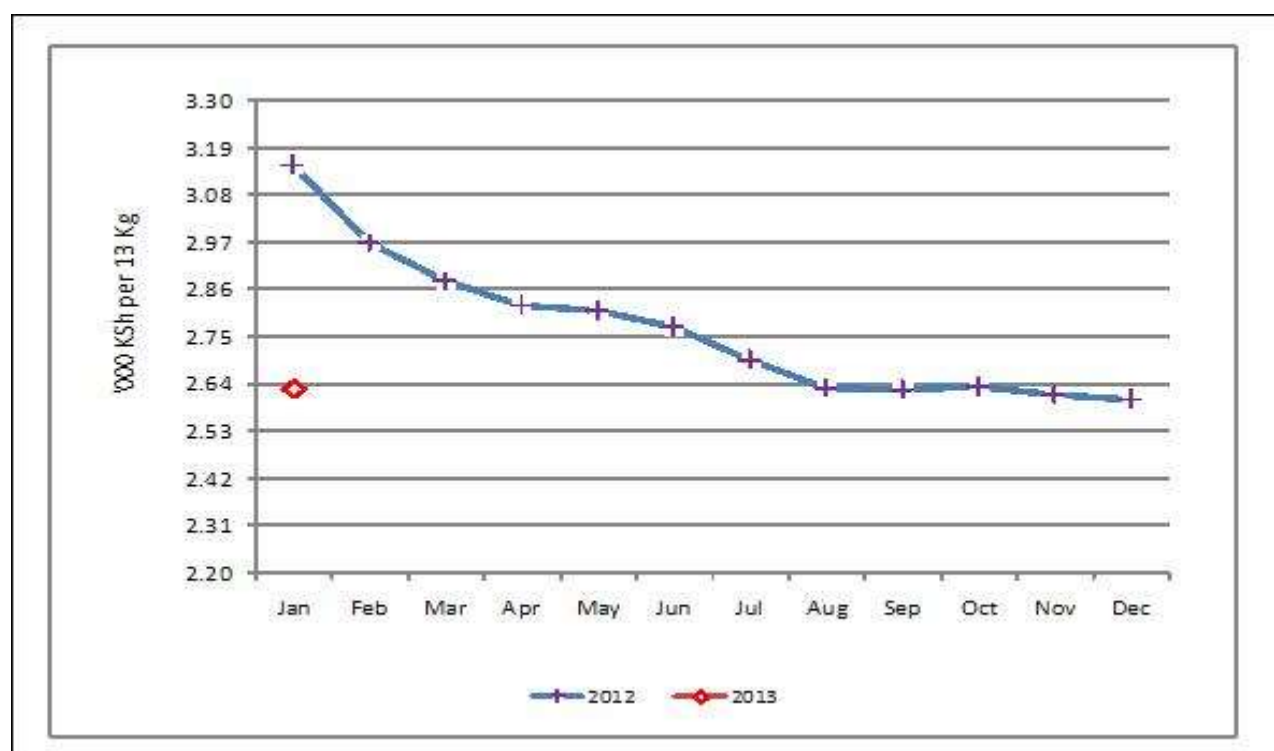

FIG 13: TRENDS FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES

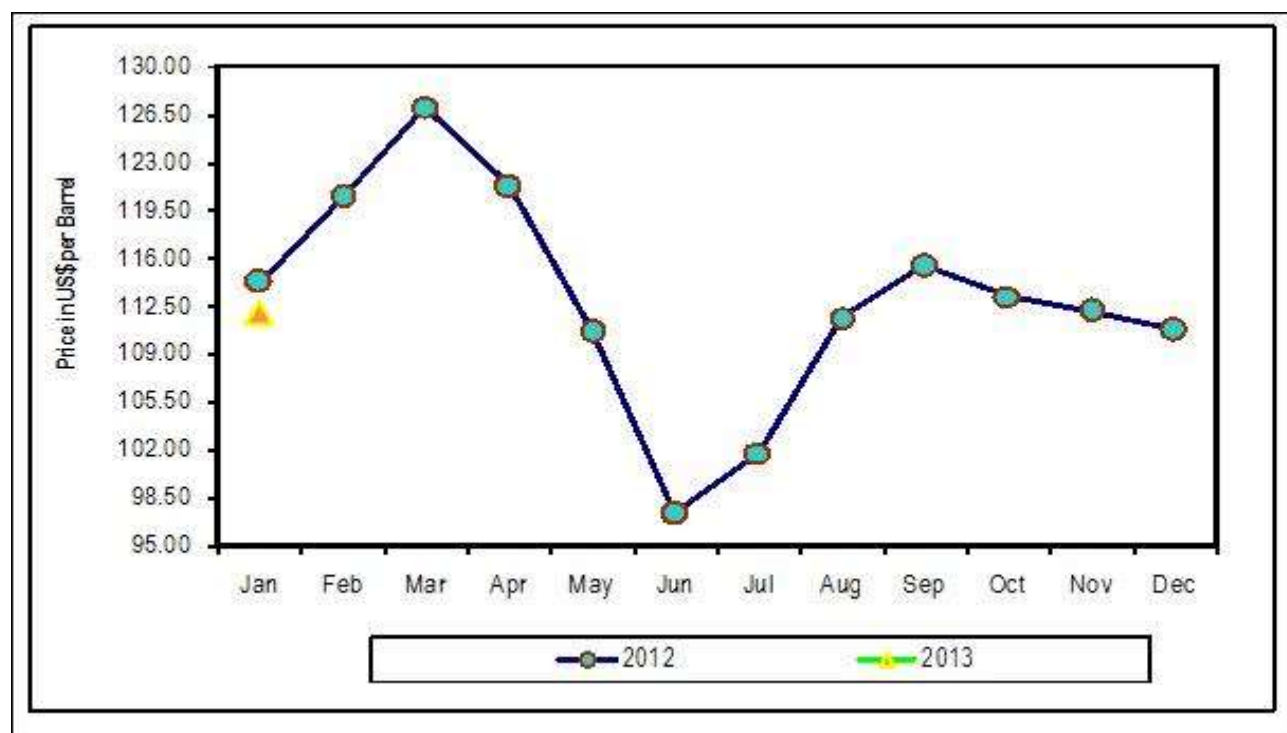

FIG 14: MILK INTAKE IN THE FORMAL SECTOR

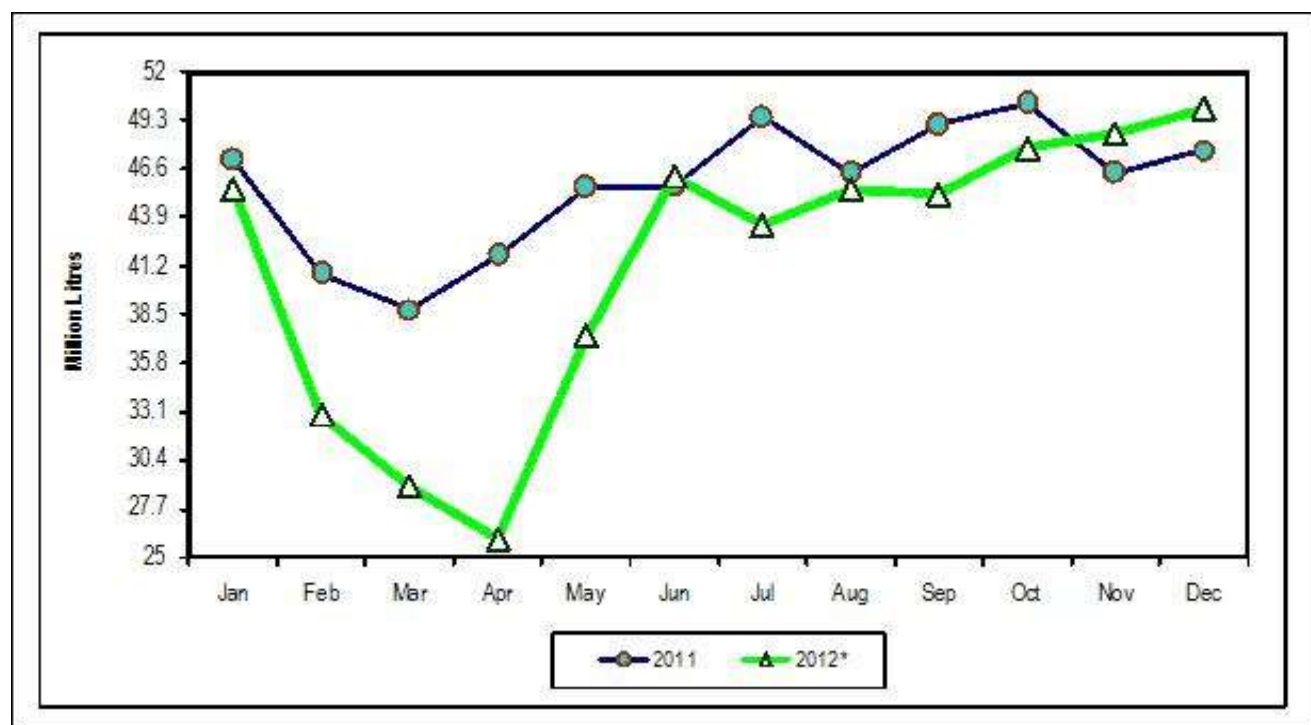

FIG 15: VISITORS ARRIVING IN KENYA THROUGH THE MAIN AIRPORTS

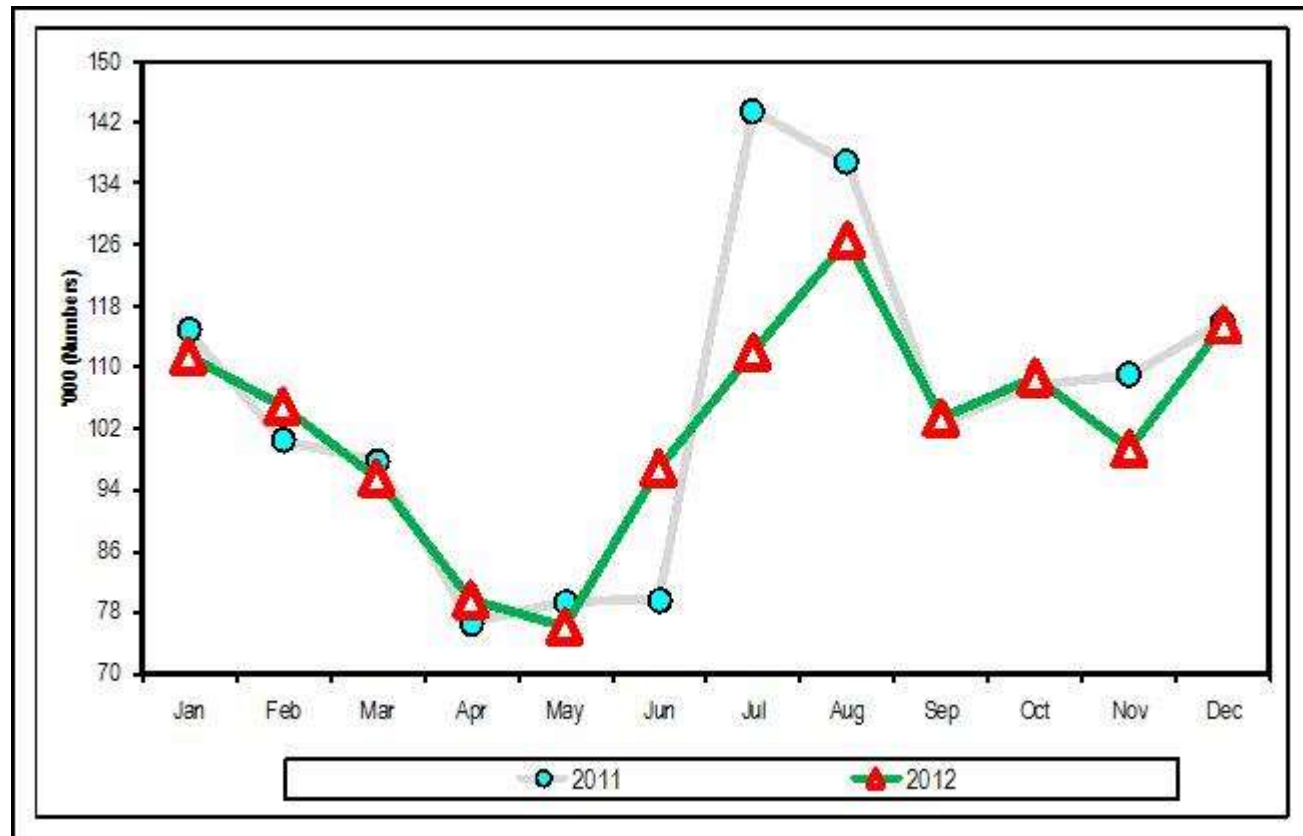

FIG 16: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF DESTINATION

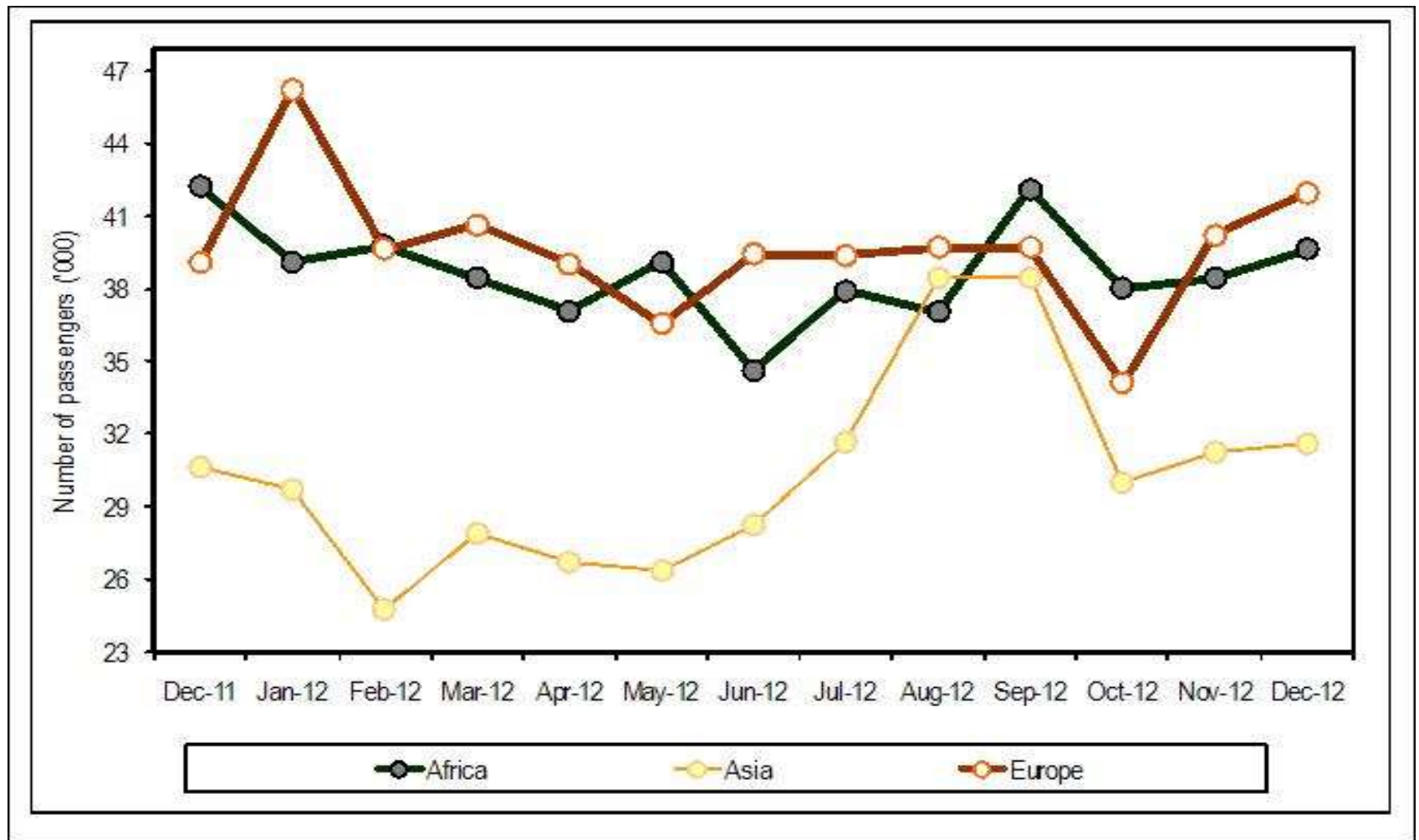

FIG 17: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF ORIGIN

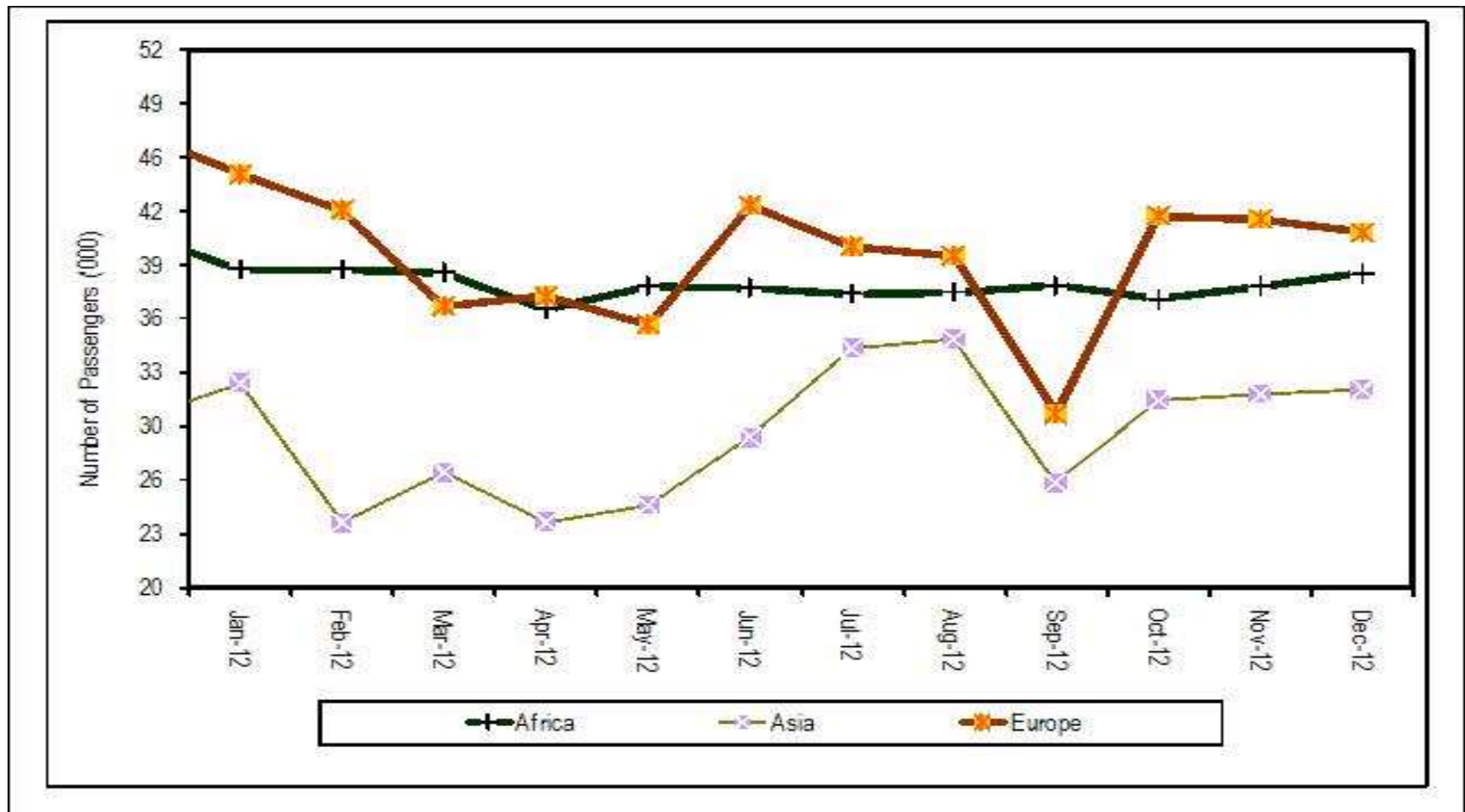
