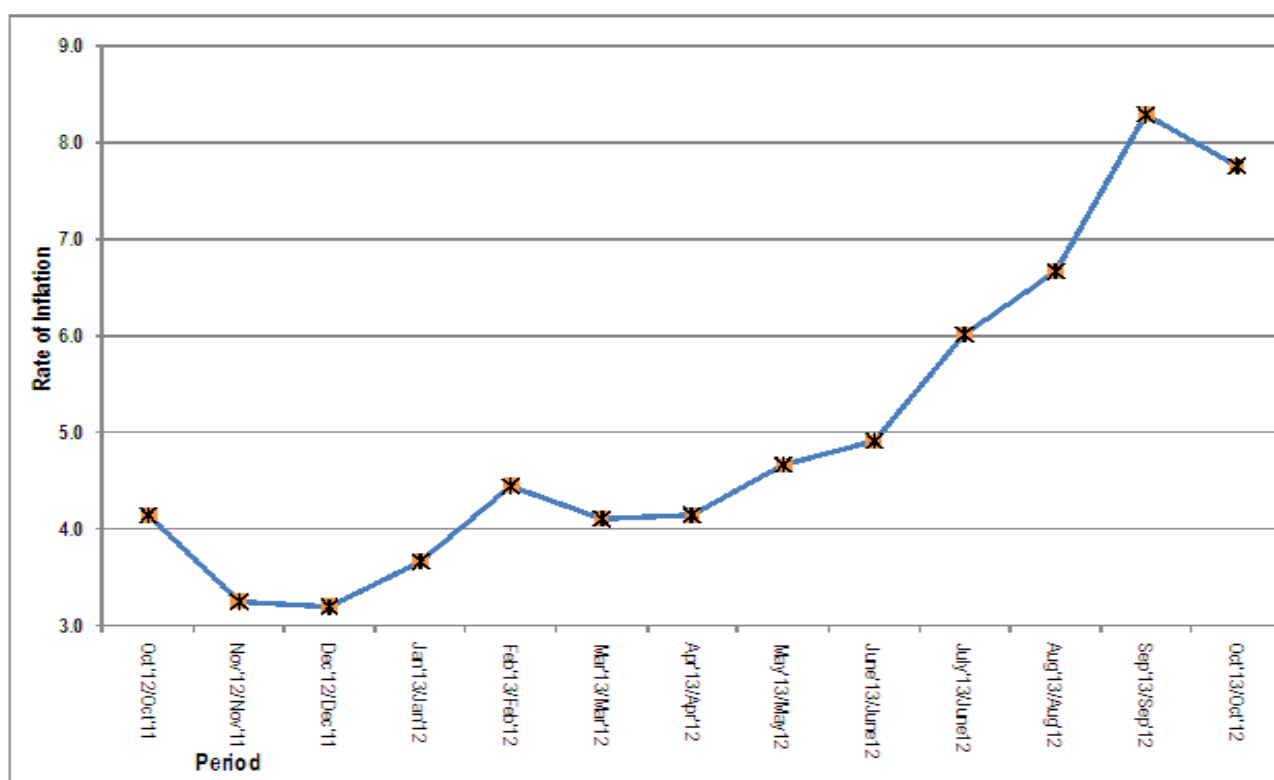

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KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators publication for October 2013 highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) fell slightly from 142.82 points in September 2013 to 142.75 points in October 2013. The overall rate of inflation declined from 8.29 per cent to 7.76 per cent during the period. The Kenyan shilling appreciated against all major currencies and exchanged at an average of KSh 85.31, KSh 137.31, KSh 116.33, KSh 87.24, KSh 8.80, KSh 29.74 and KSh 18.87 against the US dollar, sterling pound, Euro, Japanese Yen, South African rand, the Ugandan and Tanzanian shilling respectively, as at the end of October 2013.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, increased from 9.58 per cent in September 2013 to 9.70 in October 2013. The inter-bank rates increased from 7.82 per cent to 10.60 per cent during the period. The Nairobi Securities Exchange share index (NSE 20) went up from 4,793 points in September 2013 to 4,936 points in October 2013, while the total number of shares traded increased from 489 to 804 million shares during the same period. The total value of NSE shares traded rose from KSh 10.1 billion to KSh 15.9 billion. Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, increased from KSh 1,862.0 billion in September 2013 to 1,879.1 billion in September 2013. Money and Quasi-money (M2) expanded from KSh 1,593.4 billion to KSh 1,596.6 billion over the same period. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves decreased from KSh 695.2 billion in September to KSh 671.3 billion in October 2013. Net Foreign Exchange Reserves decreased to KSh 366.4 billion over the same period.

A). AGRICULTURE

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange declined from 3,411.46 MT in August 2013 to 2,442.26 MT in September 2013 while its average auction price decreased from KSh 296.96 per kilogram to KSh 286.46 per kilogram in the same period. The quantity of processed tea increased from 26,338 MT in August 2013 to 32,055.0 MT in September 2013 while its average auction price dropped from KSh 208.13 per kilogram to KSh 174.39 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize declined from KSh 36.10 per kilogram in September 2013 to KSh 33.88 per kilogram in October 2013 while the average price for dry beans averaged KSh 70.24 per Kilogram in October 2013.

B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported increased from 4,740.8 MT in August 2013 to 4,802.3 MT in September 2013 while its value rose from KSh 1,409.0 to KSh 1,436.1 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported fell from 36,175.1 MT in August 2013 to 34,082.31MT in September 2013, while its value decreased from KSh 8,236.4 million to KSh 7,635.4 million during the same period. Volume of trade decreased from KSh 160.5 billion in August 2013 to KSh 153.6 billion in September 2013. The total value of exports declined by 1.2 per cent from 40.8 billion to 41.3 billion during the same period. Value of imports decreased by 6.1 per cent over the same period. Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages category was the main export category in September 2013 and accounted for 41.42 per cent, while the value of Non-food industrial supplies and Consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered 27.67 and 26.87 per cent shares, respectively. All the other economic categories recorded values less than 2.00 per cent shares. Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that industrial supplies (non-food) was the main import category in September 2013 with a share of 34.1 per cent, while the values of fuel and lubricants, machinery & other capital equipment and transport equipment registered shares of 19.89, 18.44 and 10.63 per cent respectively. Food and beverage recorded a share of 8.59 per cent while Consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 6.91 per cent.

C). ENERGY

Total electricity generation increased from 711.81 million KWh in September 2013 to 754.07 million KWh in October 2013. Domestic consumption of electricity rose from 609.59 million KWh in September 2013 to 622.17 million KWh in October 2013. The total consumption of petroleum products dropped to 253.21 thousand MT in September 2013 from 310.85 thousand MT realized in August 2013. Average national domestic average oil prices of motor gasoline premium decreased to retail at an average of KSh 113.09 per litre in October 2013 from KSh 114.69 per litre retailed in September 2013. The price of light diesel oil dropped to retail at KSh 105.39 in October 2013 from KSh 106.47 in September 2013. The average price

for kerosene decreased to retail at KSh 85.92 from KSh 86.47 during the same period. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,835.20. In Nairobi County, average retail prices for motor gasoline decreased from the retail price of KSh 113.88 per litre in September 2013 to retail at KSh 112.27 per litre in October 2013. Diesel oil price declined to KSh 104.47 and that of Kerosene fell to KSh 85.01 during the same period. The price of Murban crude oil declined from US Dollars 114.50 per barrel in September 2013 to US Dollars 112.45 per barrel in October 2013 in the international market.

D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION

Domestic production of sugar decreased from 58,687 MT in August 2013 to 50,303 MT in September 2013. Production of soft drinks rose from 28,705 MT in July 2013 to 29,605 MT in August 2013. The production of new assembled vehicles increased from 598 vehicles in July 2013 to 617 vehicles in August 2013. The production of galvanized sheets increased from 21,228 MT in May 2013 to 22,108 MT in June 2013. The quantity of cement produced went up from 407,074 MT in August 2013 to 414,807 MT in September 2013. Consumption of cement decreased from 347,602 MT recorded in August 2013 to 342,537 MT in September 2013. Milk deliveries to the formal sector decreased from 38.7 million litres in August 2013 to 35.0 million litres in September 2013.

E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports increased from 97,775 persons in June 2013 to 123,812 persons in July 2013. The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) fell from 178,958 persons in August 2013 to 178,685 persons in September 2013, while passengers who landed decreased from 178,775 persons to 178,694 persons in the same period. The total number of vehicles registered went up from 15,225 vehicles in August 2013 to 15,749 vehicles in September 2013. Motor cycles accounted for 40.4 per cent of the total motor vehicles in the month of September.

FIG. 1: INFLATION RATES

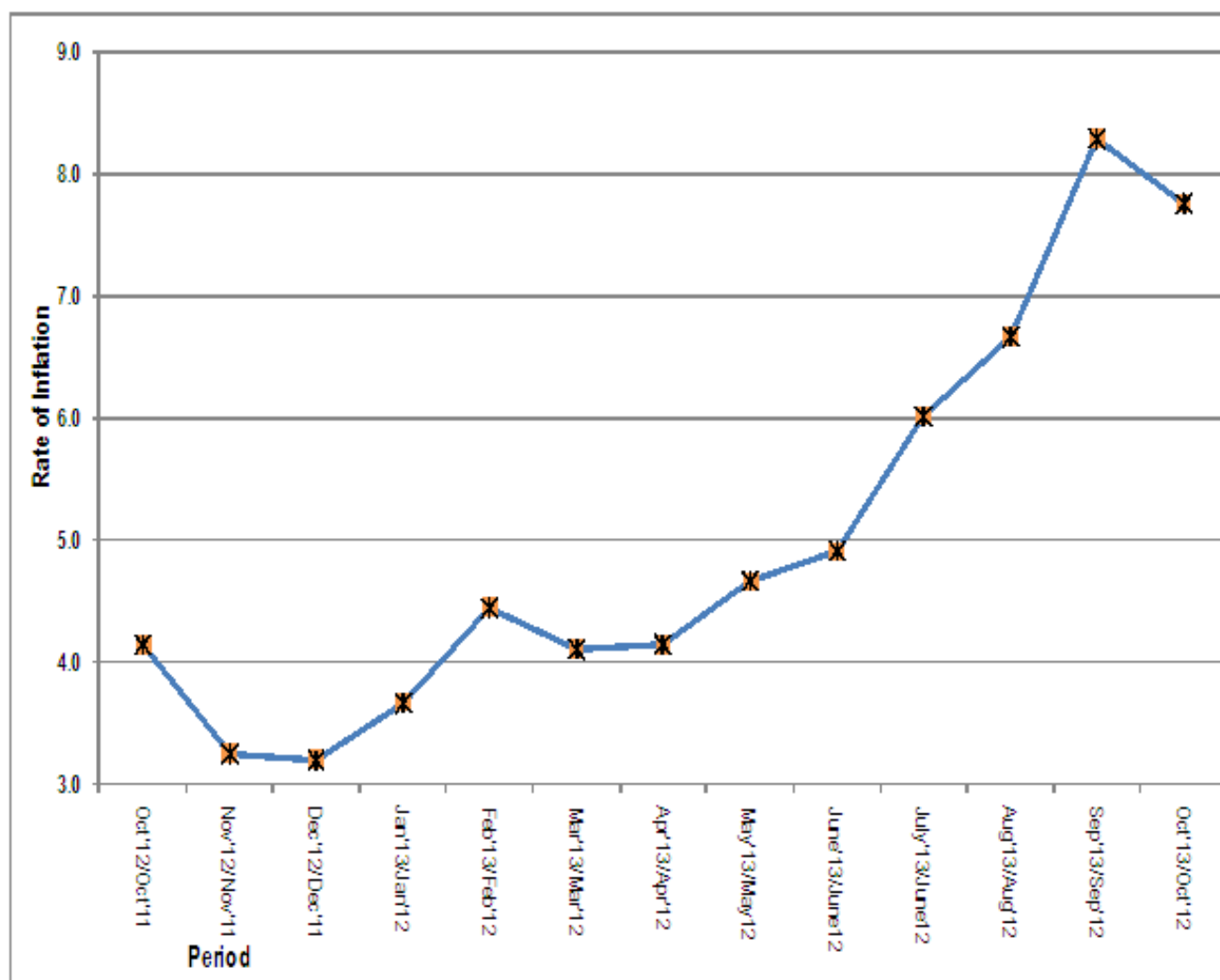

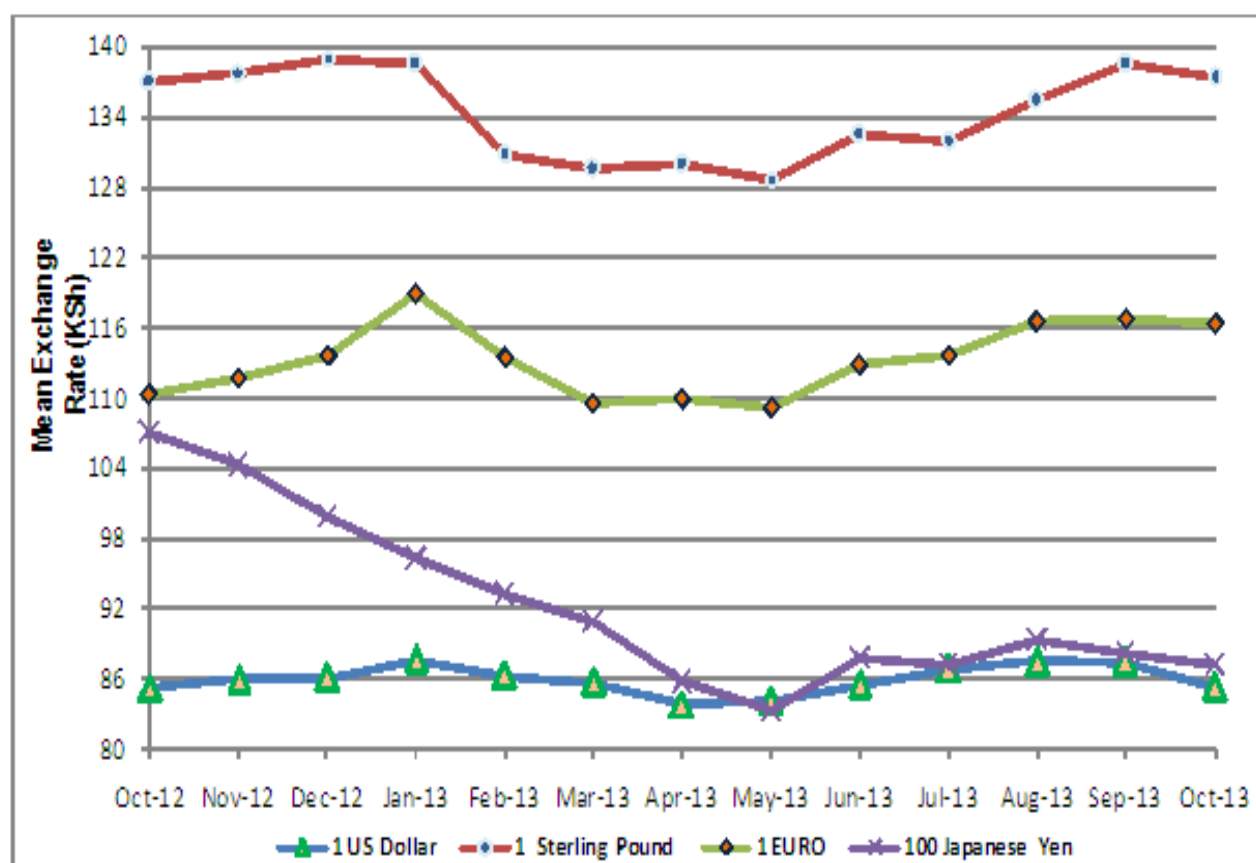

FIG 3: INTEREST RATES

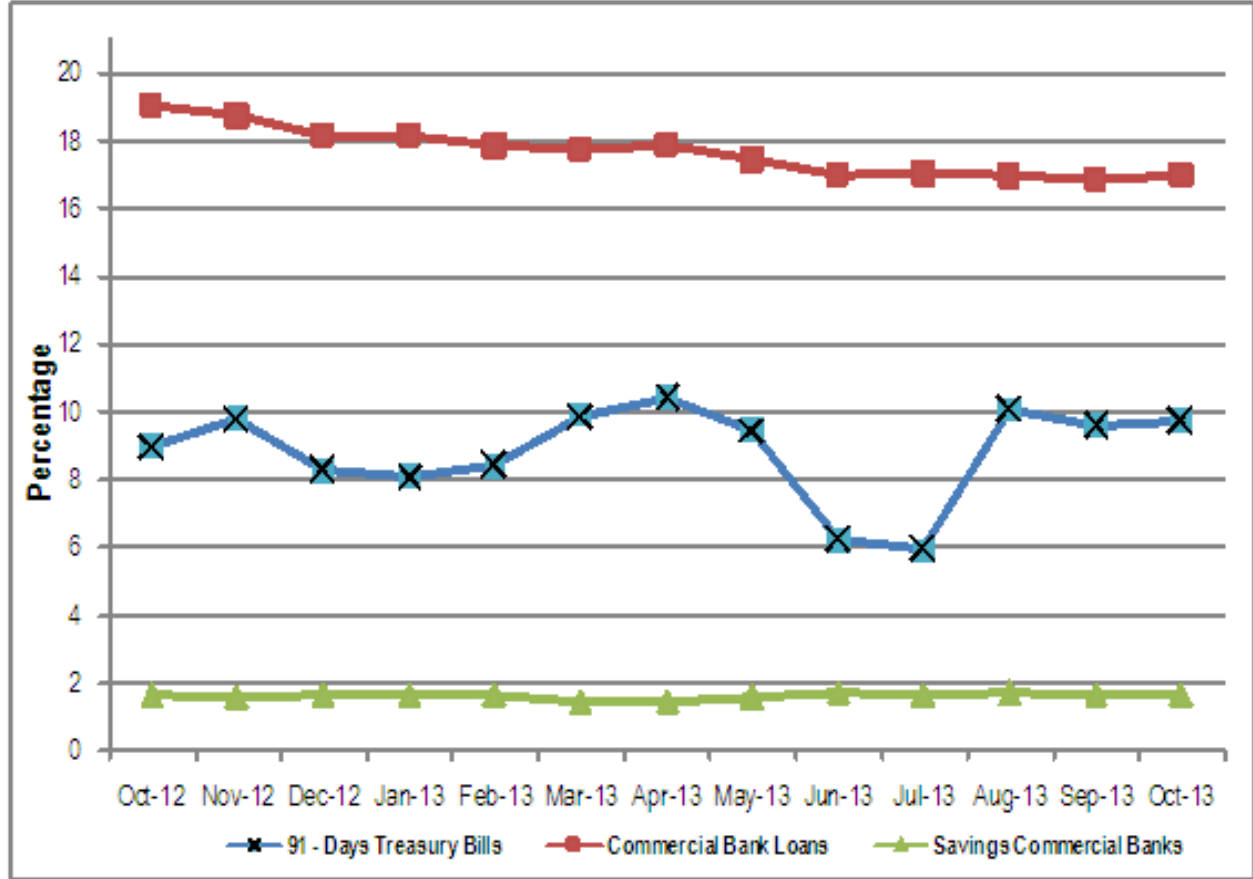

FIG 4: NAIROBI STOCK EXCHANGE SHARES INDEX

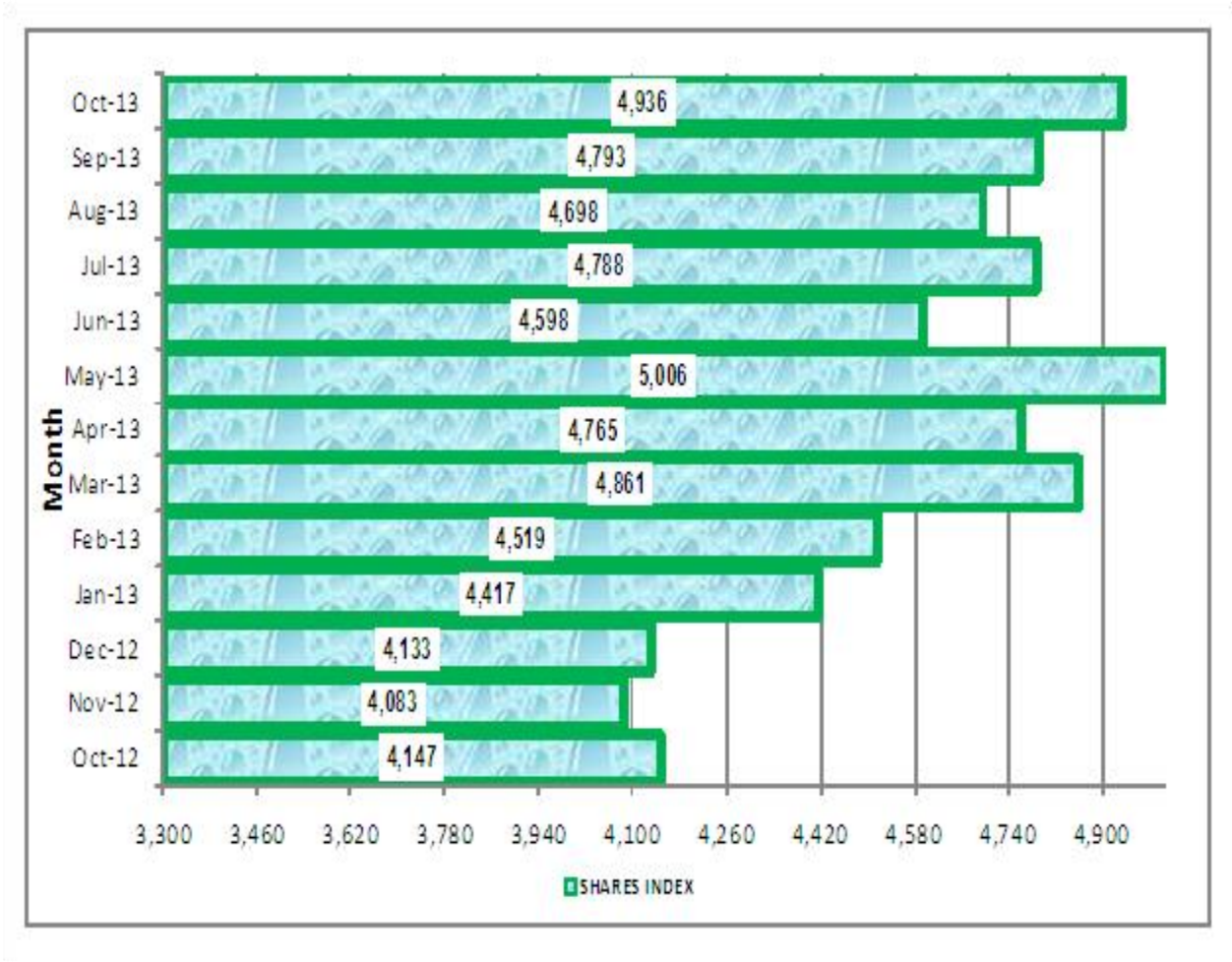

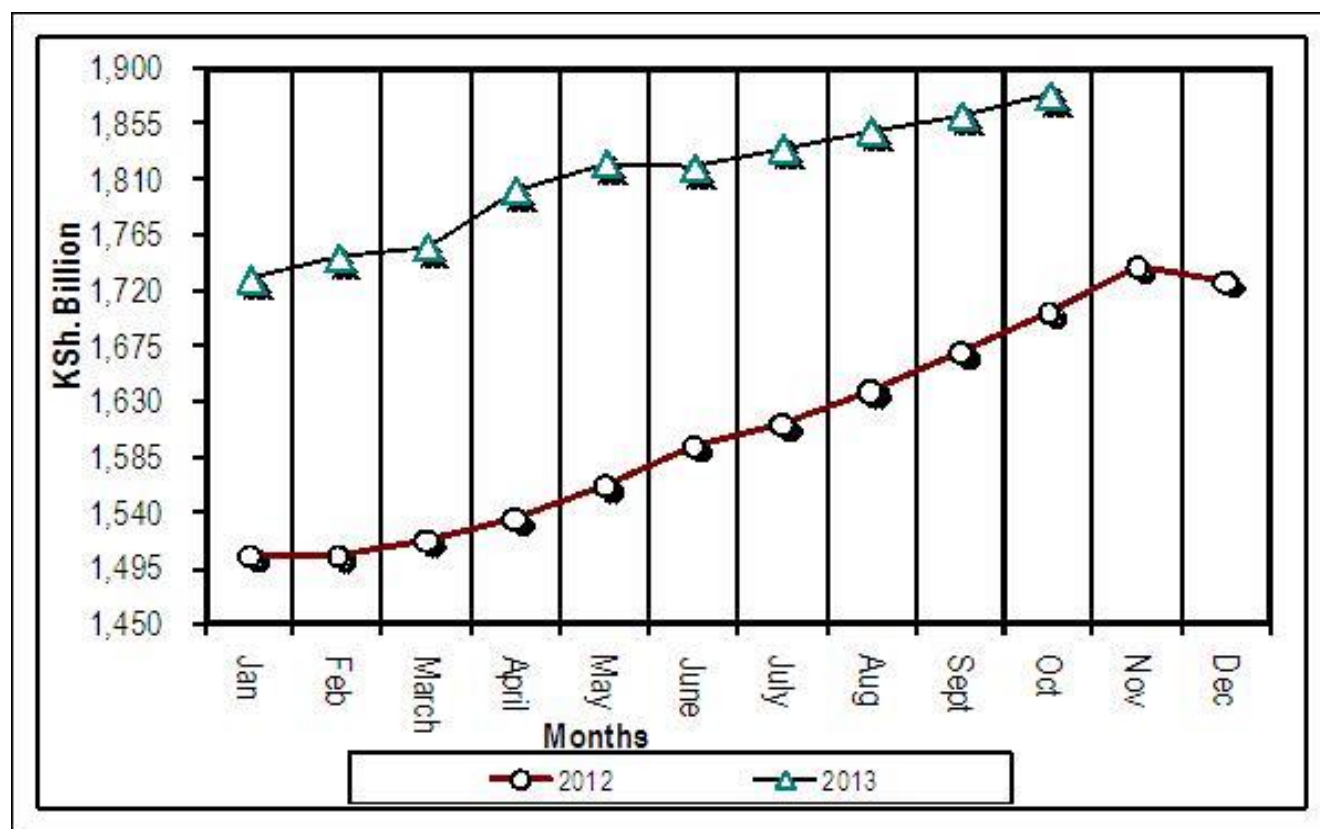
FIG 5: MONEY SUPPLY (M3)

FIG 6: FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

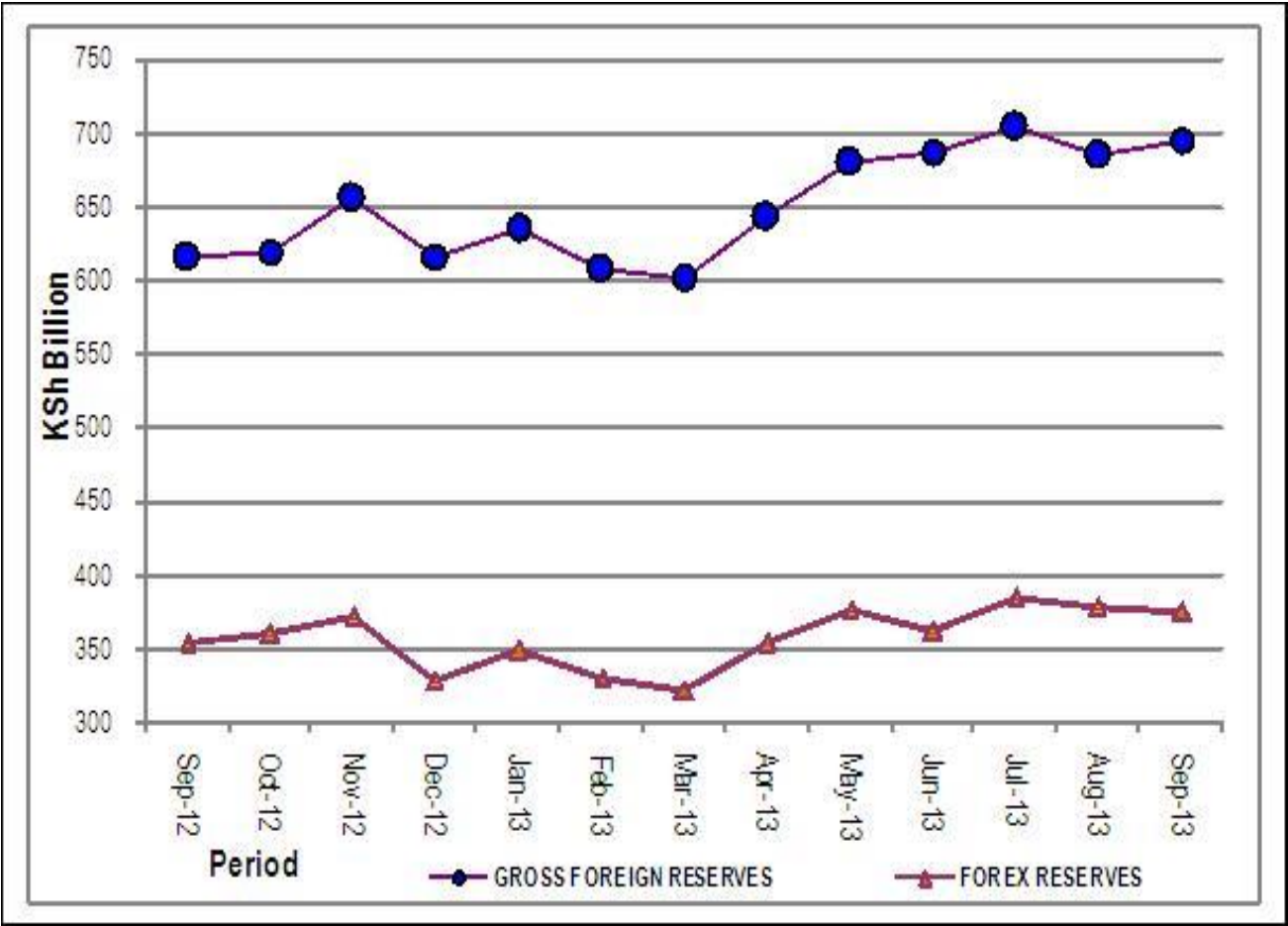

FIG.7: COFFEE SALES AT THE NAIROBI COFFEE EXCHANGE

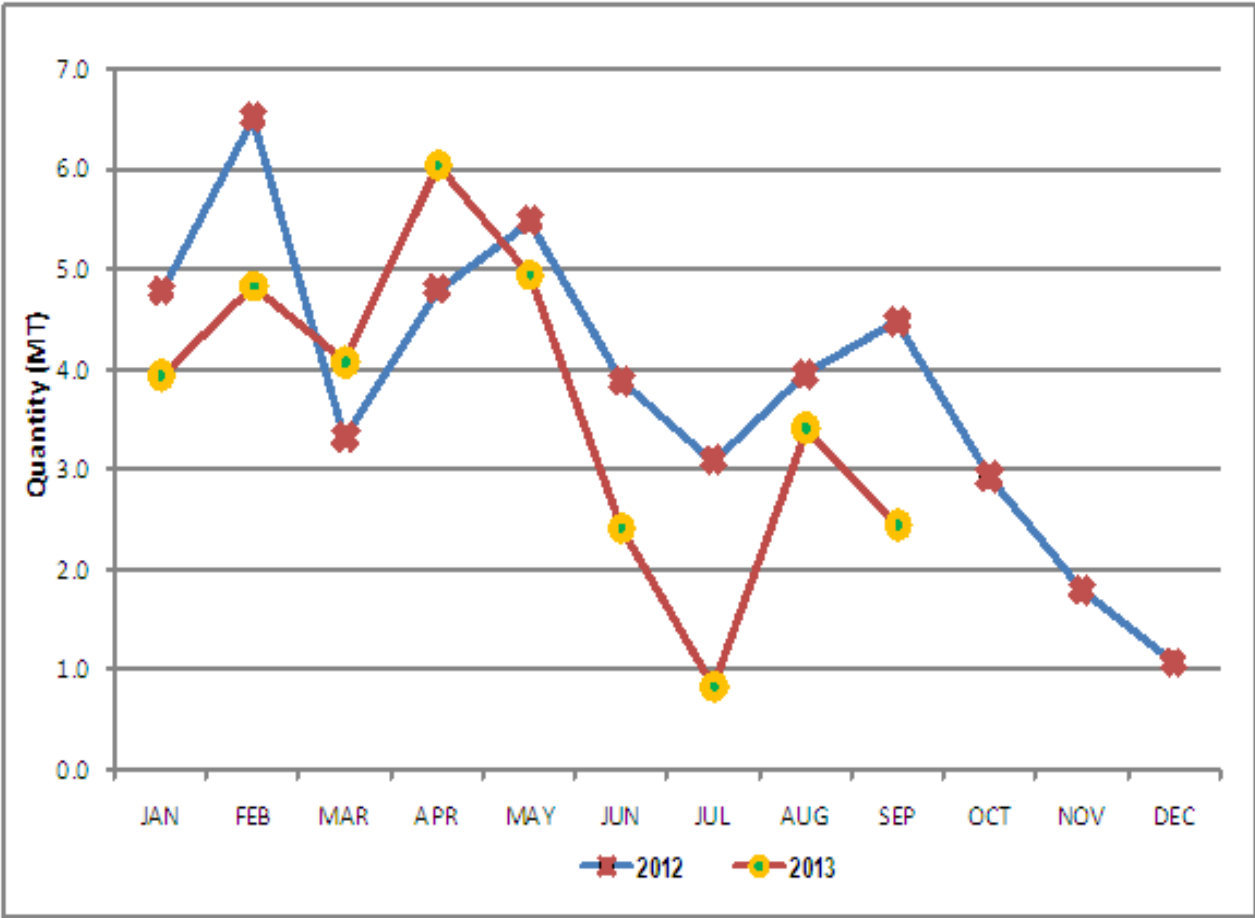

FIG.8: TEA PRODUCTION

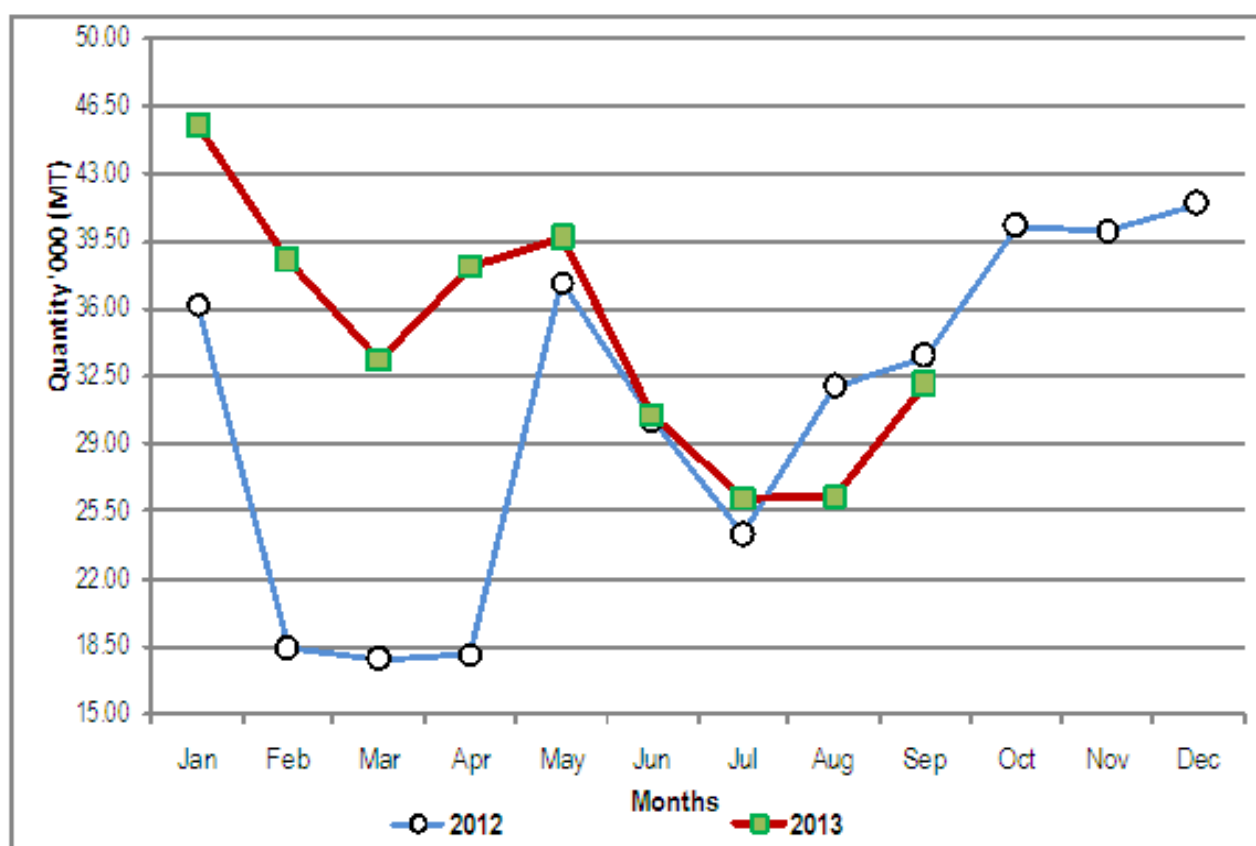

FIG.9: CANE DELIVERIES

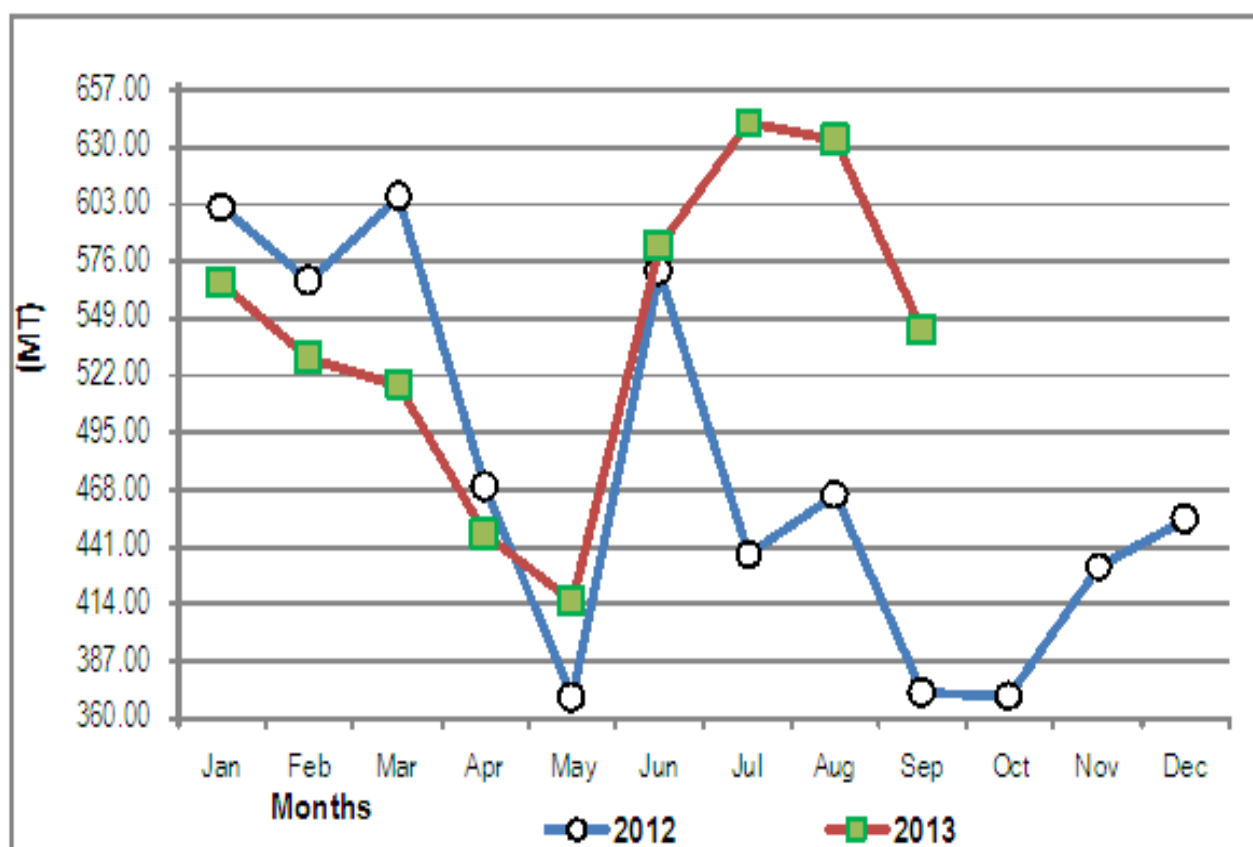

FIG 10: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE

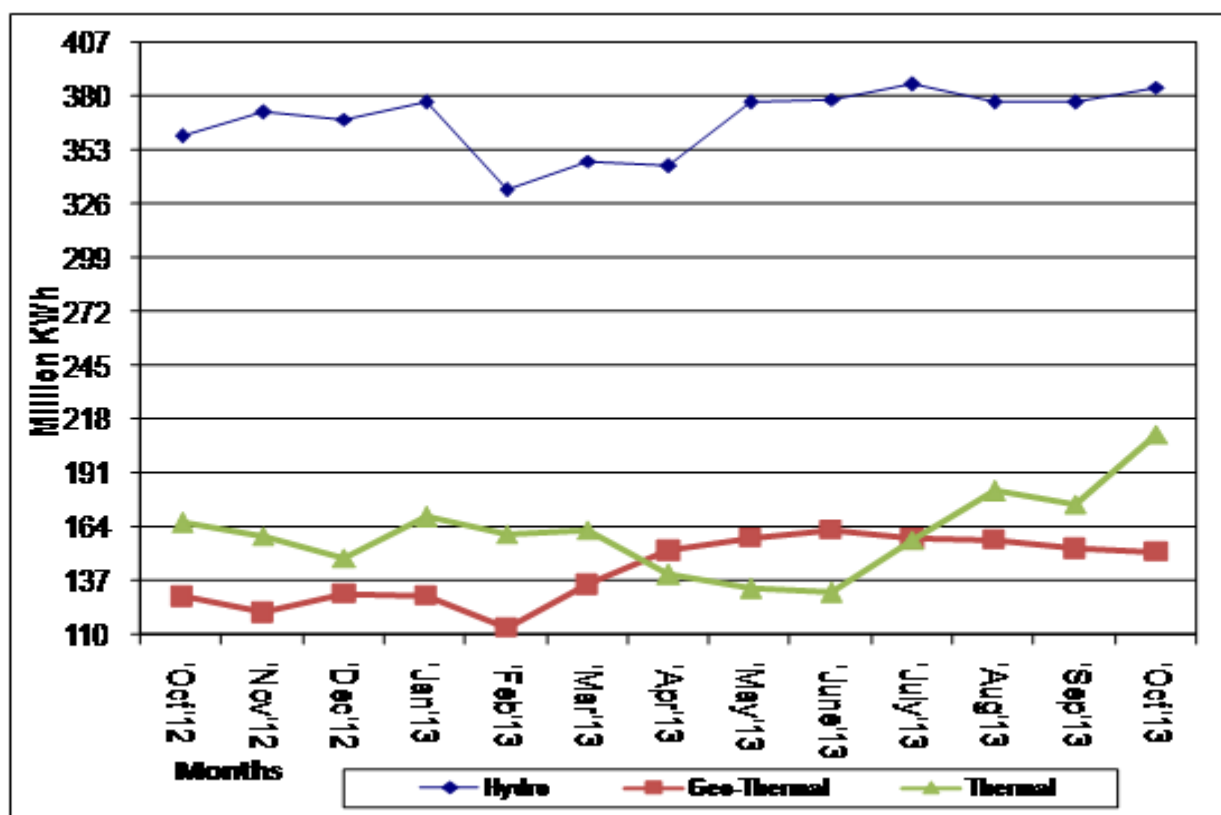

FIG 11: ELECTRICITY GENERATION, CONSUMPTION AND POWER LOSSES

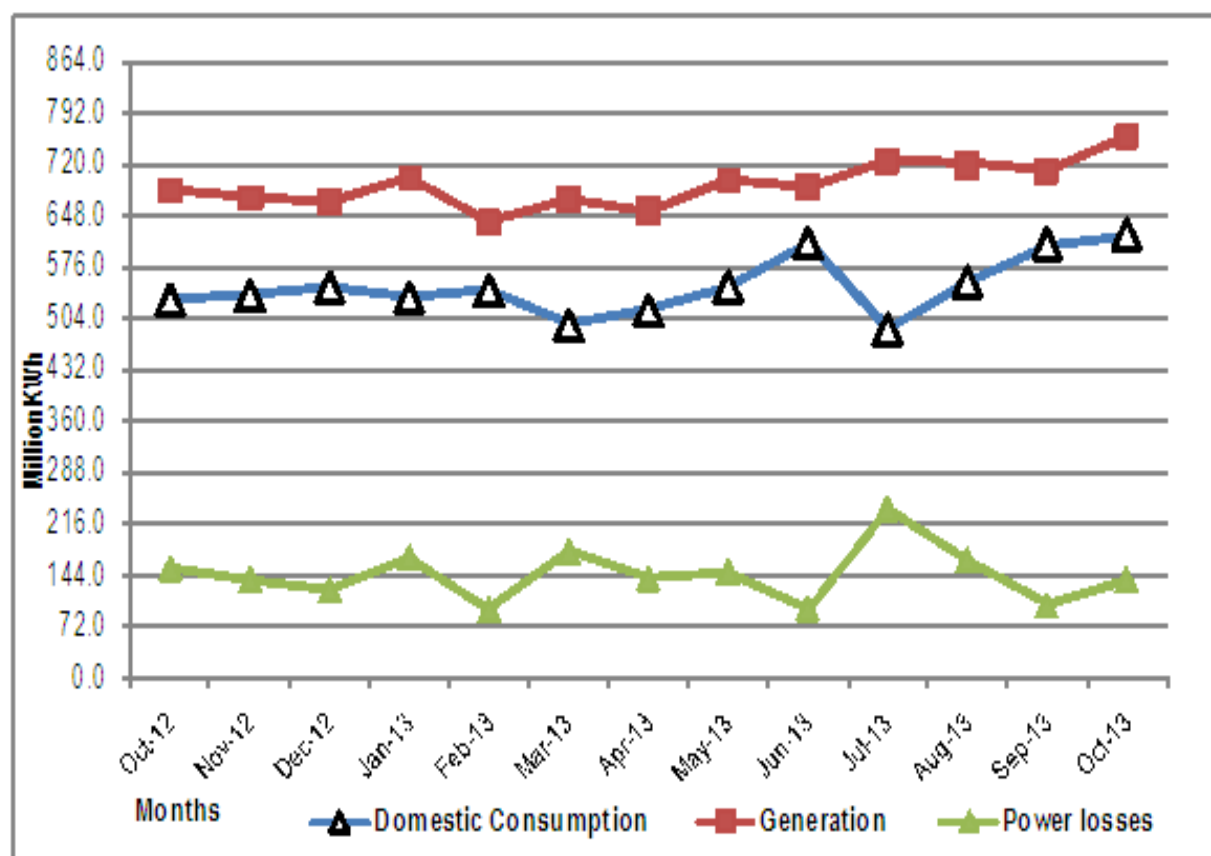

FIG 12(A): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

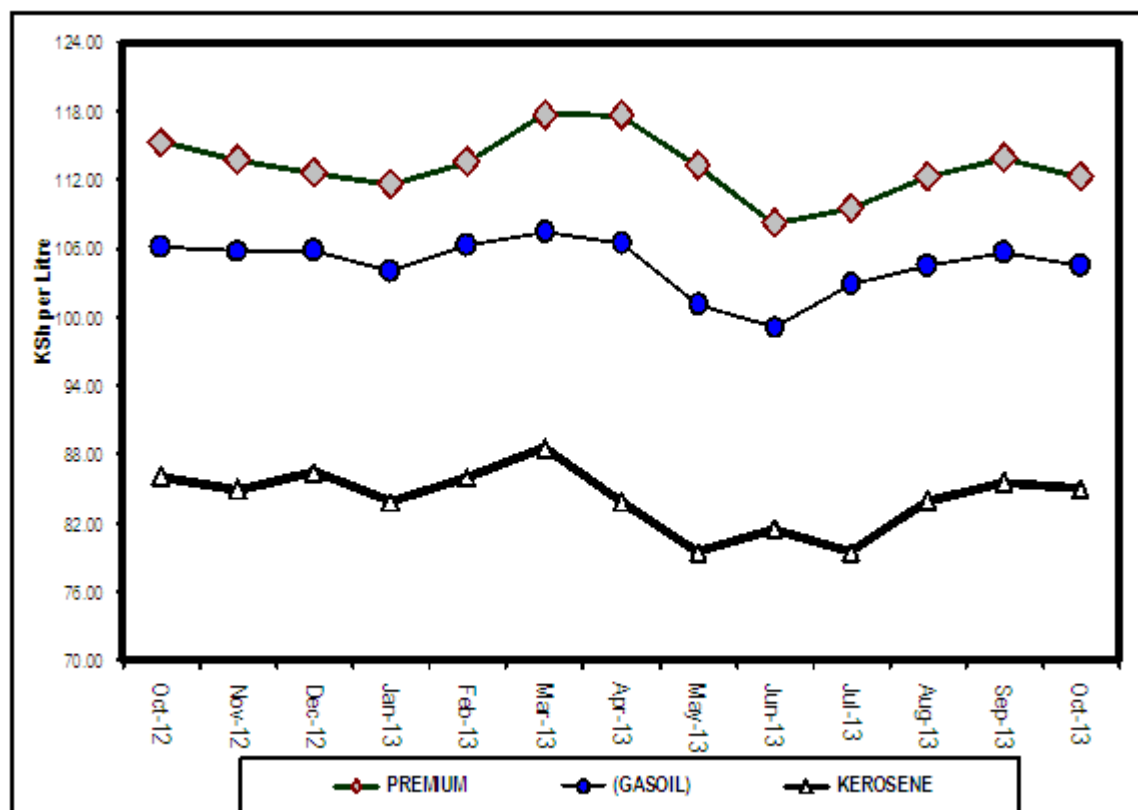

FIG 12(B): AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA

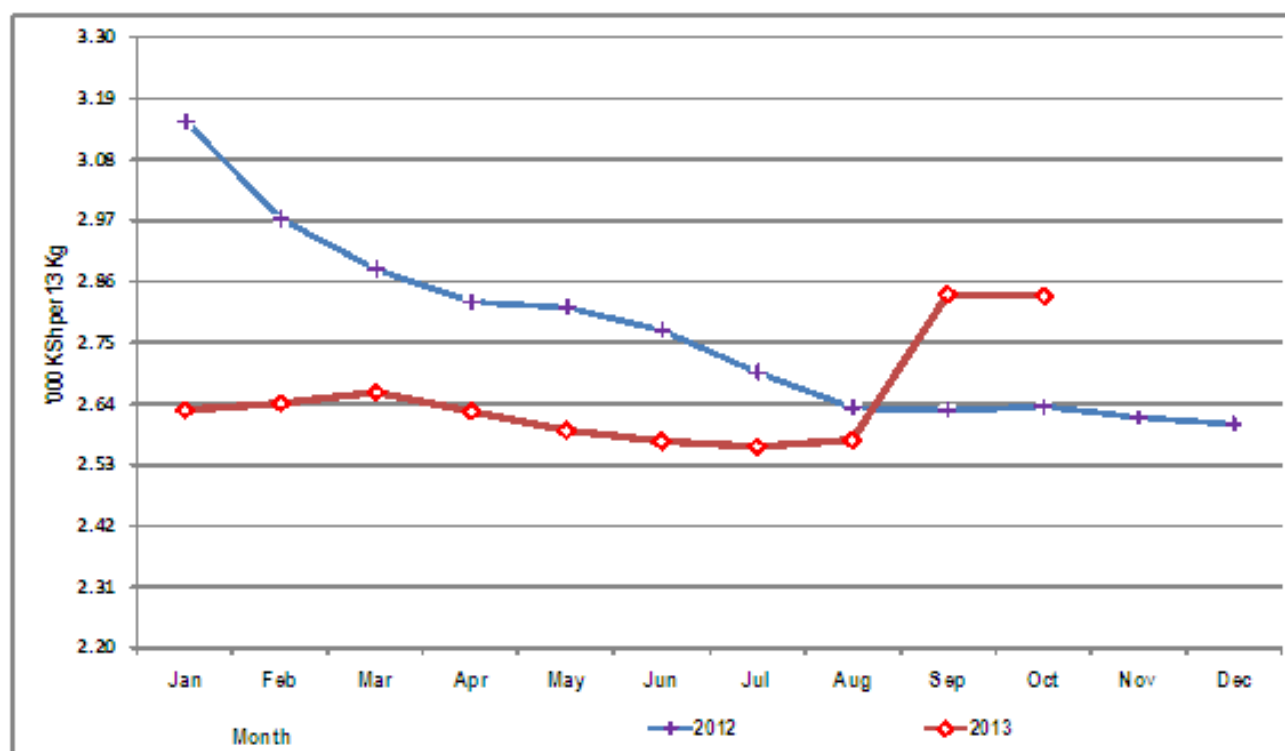

FIG 13: TRENDS FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES

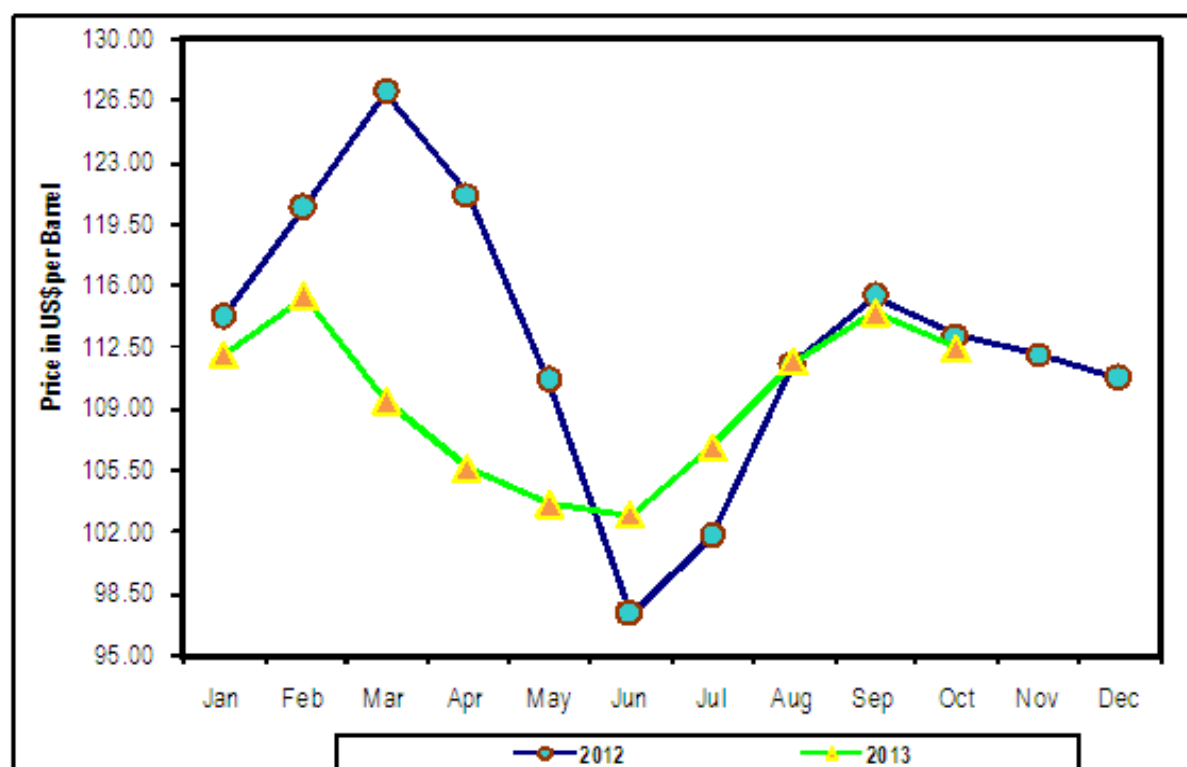

FIG 15: VISITORS ARRIVING IN KENYA THROUGH THE MAIN AIRPORTS

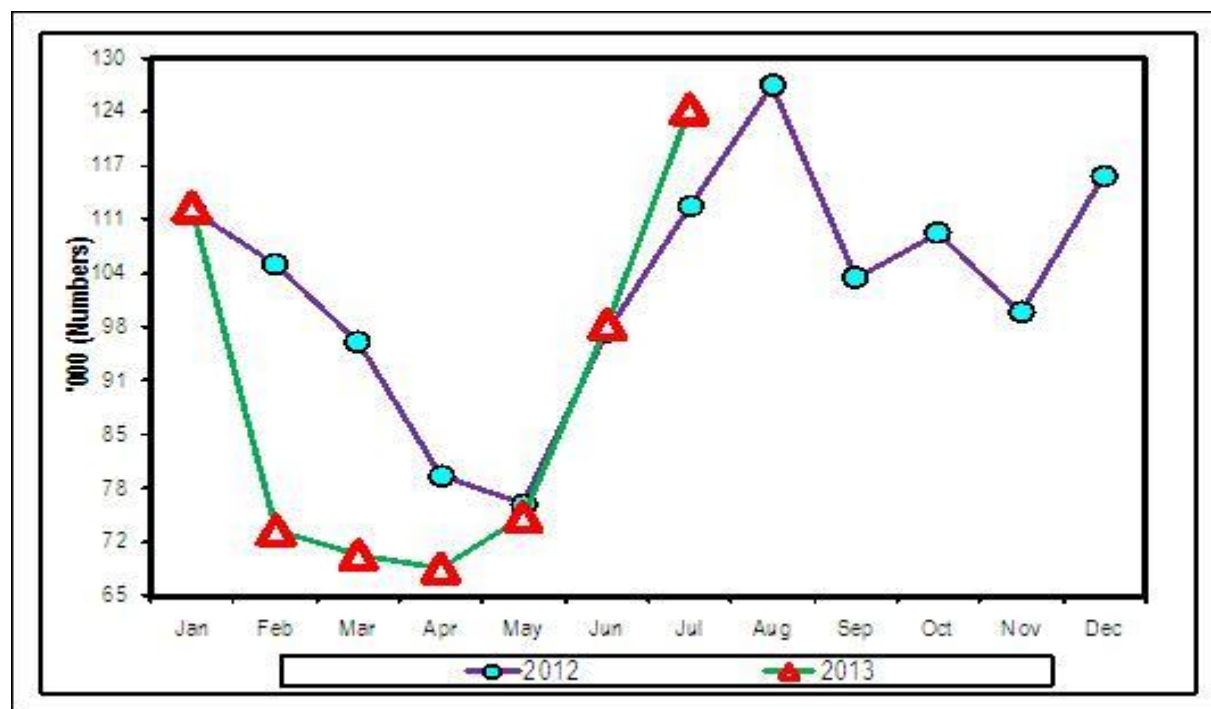

FIG 16: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF DESTINATION

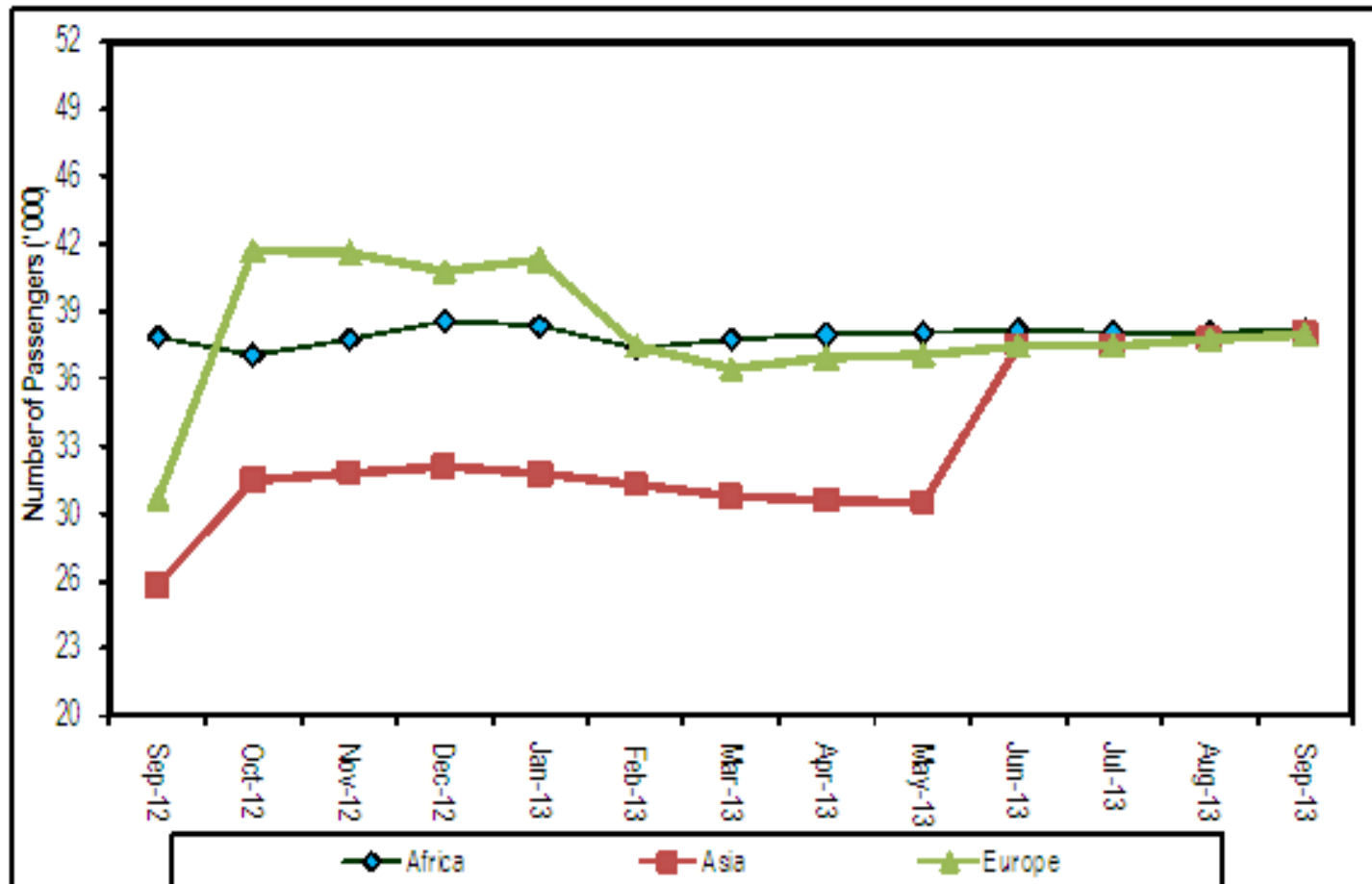

FIG 17: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF ORIGIN

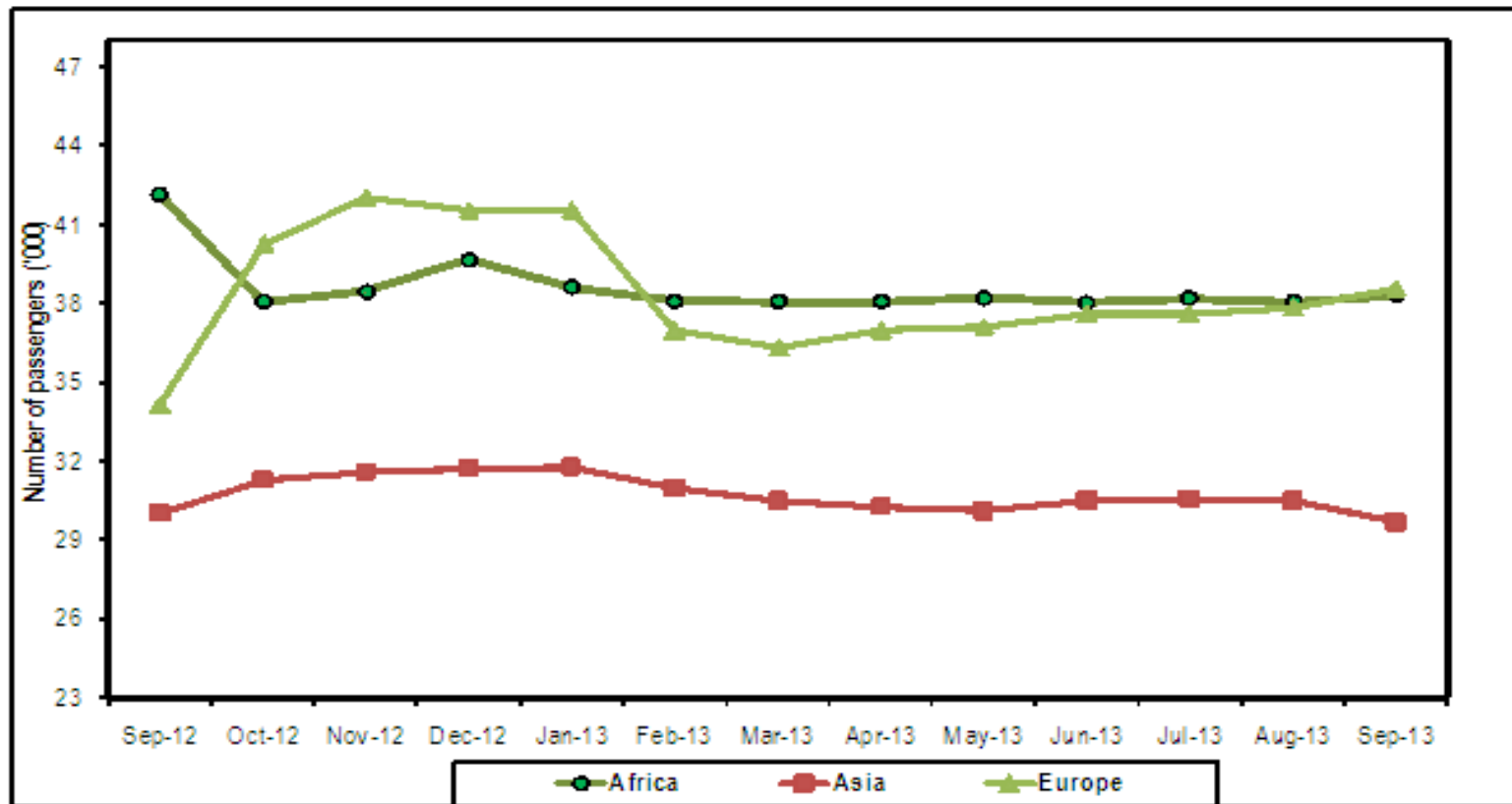
