

# LEADING ECONOMIC INDICATORS



**SEPTEMBER 2016**

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## **KEY HIGHLIGHTS**

### **OVERVIEW**

The Leading Economic Indicators highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

### **MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS**

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased from 170.97 points in August 2016 to 171.56 points in September 2016. The overall rate of inflation rose from 6.26 per cent to 6.34 per cent during the same period. In September, 2016 the Kenyan Shilling appreciated against all the major currencies while depreciating against the Tanzanian shilling and the Sterling Pound.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, decreased from 8.48 per cent in August 2016 to 8.06 per cent in September 2016 while the inter-bank rate declined to 4.87 in September 2016 from 4.96 per cent in August 2016.

The Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE) 20 share index expanded from 3,179 points in August 2016 to 3,243 points in September 2016, while the total number of shares traded increased from 708 million shares to 746 million shares during the same period. The total value of NSE shares traded decreased from KSh 17.66 billion in August 2016 to KSh 16.87 billion in September 2016.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation expanded from KSh 2,739.94 billion in August 2016 to KSh 2,761.84 billion in September 2016. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves increased from KSh 1,046.28 billion in August 2016 to KSh 1,070.31 billion in September 2016. Net Foreign Exchange Reserves increased from KSh 579.21 billion in August 2016 to KSh 593.88 billion in September 2016.

## **A). AGRICULTURE**

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange declined from 3,723.02 MT in August 2016 to 3,284.28 in September 2016 while the average auction price increased from KSh 430.63 per kilogram to KSh 437.46 per Kilogram over the same period. The quantity of processed tea increased from 29,285 MT in July 2016 to 29,462 MT in August 2016. The price of the processed tea decreased from KSh 246.44 to KSh 234.27 per kilogram over the same period.

The amount of cane deliveries increased from 632.54 thousand tonnes in June 2016 to 638.34 thousand tonnes in July 2016. Average price for dry maize rose from KSh 34.65 per kilogram in July 2016 to KSh 35.33 per kilogram in August 2016. The average price per Kilogram for dry beans in the month of August 2016 was KSh 73.37. Milk deliveries to formal processors declined from 58.5 million litres in July 2016 to 56.1 million litres in August 2016.

The quantity of cutflower horticultural exports went up from 9,284.47 tonnes in August 2016 to 10,605.34 tonnes in September 2016 while the value of exports decreased from KSh 4,909.50 million to KSh 4,465.33 million during the period. The volume of Vegetable exports increased from 6,242.02 tonnes in August 2016 to 8,040.16 tonnes in September 2016. Similarly, the value in KSh million of vegetable exports expanded from 1,636.52 to 1,822.79 in the same period.

## **B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE**

Quantity of coffee exported decreased from 3,986.9 MT in July 2016 to 3,718.7 MT in August 2016 while its value declined from KSh 1,797.7 million to KSh 1,636.9 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported contracted from 42,751.1 MT in July 2016 to 39,672.6 MT in August 2016, while its value fell from KSh 10,679.3 million to KSh 9,993.4 million over the same period.

Volume of trade contracted from KSh 180.0 billion in August 2016 to KSh 170.6 billion in September 2016. The total value of exports fell to KSh 46.20 billion while the value of imports decreased from KSh 133.0 billion in August 2016 to KSh 124.4 billion in September 2016.

Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages was the main export category in August 2016 accounting for 41.4 per cent of exports, while the value of non-food industrial supplies and consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered 25.5 and 26.9 per cent shares, respectively. BEC imports indicate that non-food industrial supplies was the main import category in August 2016 with a share of 36.0 per cent, while the values

of machinery & other capital equipment, fuel and lubricants and transport registered shares of 21.7, 15.3 and 9.8 per cent, respectively. Food and beverage recorded a share of 8.1 per cent while consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 9.0 per cent.

#### **C). ENERGY**

Total electricity generation contracted to 827.93 million KWh in September 2016 from 853.55 million KWh in August 2016. Domestic consumption of electricity dropped from 728.72 million KWh in August 2016 to 679.87 million KWh in September 2016.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil decreased from an average of US Dollars 45.75 per barrel in August, 2016 to US Dollars 45.64 per barrel in September 2016. The national average domestic retail oil prices of motor gasoline premium dropped from KSh 96.01 per litre in August, 2016 to KSh 92.28 per litre retailed in September, 2016. The price of light diesel oil fell to retail at KSh 83.42 in September 2016 from KSh 85.47 in August, 2016. The average price for Kerosene fell to retail at KSh 60.08 in September 2016. Charcoal prices averaged KSh 79.39 for 4 kg tin during the period. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,029.12 in September, 2016.

#### **D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION**

The quantity of cement produced increased from 540,192 MT in July 2016 to 552,559 MT in August 2016. Consumption of cement contracted from 509,895 MT in July 2016 to 520,713 MT in August 2016. Sugar production increased from 53,843 Metric tonnes in June 2016 to 56,861 Metric tonnes in July 2016. Production of assembled vehicles increased from 491 units in July 2016 to 605 units in August 2016.

#### **E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT**

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports (MIA) decreased from 96,958 in August 2016 to 75,630 in September 2016. The number of passengers who landed at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) decreased from 179,551 in August 2016 to 179,210 in September 2016, while passengers who embarked increased from 180,007 persons to 180,395 persons in the same period. The total number of vehicles registered increased to 18,527 in September 2016 from 18,288 in August 2016. Motorcycles and station wagons accounted for 42.9 per cent and 30.6 per cent, of total motor vehicles registered in September 2016, respectively.



**Fig. 1: Inflation rates**













**Fig.6: Tea Production**















Fig. 12: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector




