CONSUMER PRICE INDICES AND INFLATION RATES FOR MAY 2014

Kenya National Bureau of Statistics hereby releases Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and rates of inflation for May 2014. These numbers have been generated using data collected during the second and third weeks of the month under review. The prices were obtained from selected retail outlets in 25 data collection zones located in 13 urban centers.

As shown in Tables 1 and 2, the CPI increased by 1.01 per cent from 148.20 in April 2014 to 149.70 in May 2014. The overall inflation rate stood at 7.30 per cent in May 2014.

During the review period, Food and Non-Alcoholic Drinks' Index increased by 1.25 per cent. There were significant rises in the prices of several food items including Maize Flour, Potatoes and Sukuma Wiki among other food items. These price increases, outweighed falls in the prices of Sugar, Milk and a few other items thereby resulting in an aggregate rise in the food index.

Due to higher costs of common cooking fuels, the Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' Index, increased by 1.76 per cent between April and May 2014. In this regard, price increases were recorded in respect of Electricity, Charcoal and Firewood. The cost of electricity in consumption increased mainly on account of fuel cost adjustment which rose from 599 cents in April 2014 to 722 cents per KWh in May 2014. For example, the cost of 50 KWh of electricity increased by 21.71 per cent mainly due to this fuel cost adjustment.

Similarly, over the same period, the Transport Index increased by 1.43 per cent mainly as a result of higher costs of Diesel, Petrol and, Matatu/Bus fares.
