## CPI AND INFLATION RATES FOR JULY 2013

Kenya National Bureau of Statistics hereby releases Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and rates of inflation for July 2013. These numbers have been generated using data collected during the second and third weeks of the month under review. The prices were obtained from selected retail outlets in 25 data collection zones located in 13 urban centers.

As shown in Tables 1 and 2, the CPI increased by 0.2 per cent from 139.59 in June 2013 to 139.87 in July 2013. The overall inflation rate stood at 6.02 per cent in July 2013.

Between June and July 2013, Food and Non Alcoholic drinks' Index decreased

by 0.10 per cent. As shown in Table 3, this marginal decline in the Index was a result of aggregate falls that outweighed rises in the average prices of various food items.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other fuels' index, rose by 0.13 per cent between June and July 2013, mainly due to increases in house rent and charcoal.

The Transport Index increased by 0.98 per cent over the review period mainly due to increases on the pump prices of petrol and diesel; and public transport fares while health index rose by 0.95 per cent due to increase in doctor's charges and some medicine.
