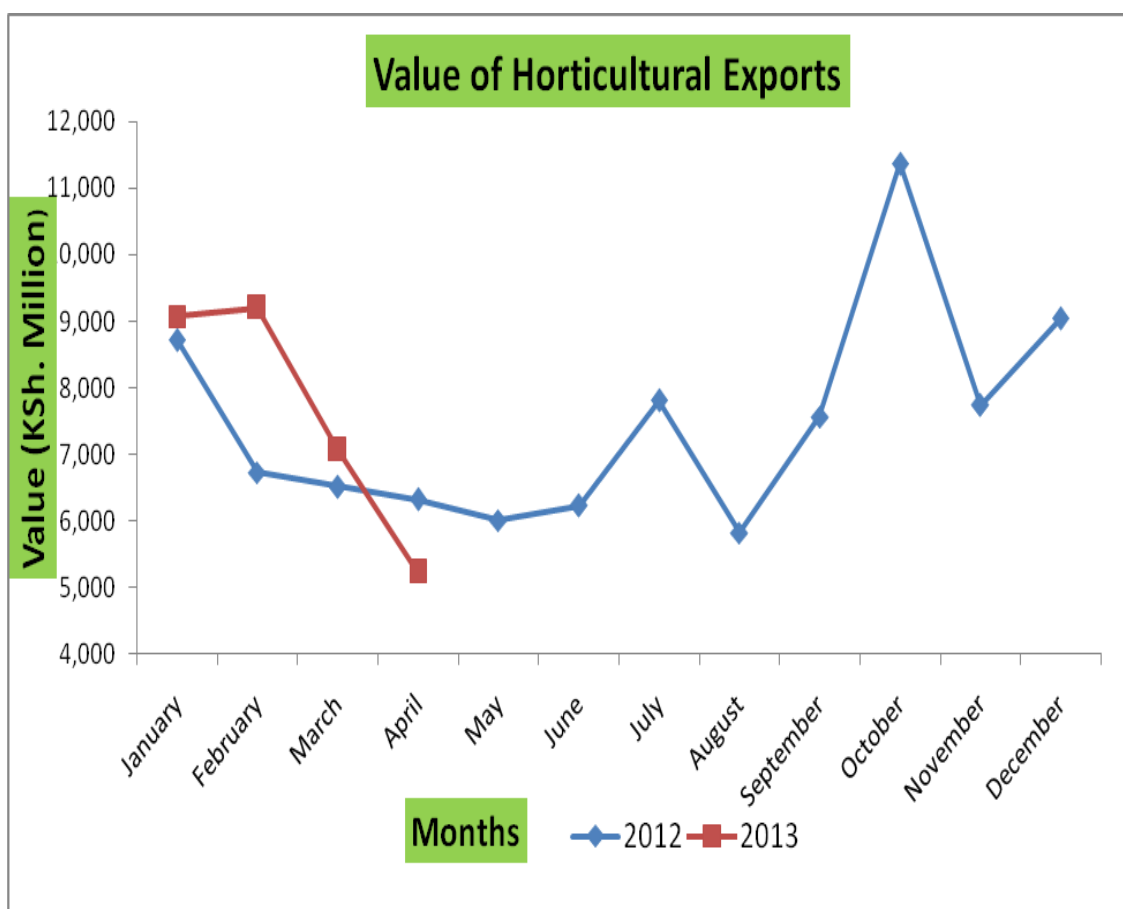

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators publication for April 2013 highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 0.95 per cent from 137.96 points in March 2013 to 139.28 points in April 2013. The overall rate of inflation increased to 4.14 per cent from 4.11 per cent in the same period. The Kenyan Shilling appreciated against worlds' major currencies; the US dollar, Japanese Yen, the Ugandan and Tanzanian shilling to exchange at an average of KSh 83.8208, 85.7501, 31.1618, and 19.4225, respectively, as at the end of April 2013. However, the shilling depreciated against the sterling pound, the Euro and the South African rand to trade at 129.997, 109.948 and 9.3243; respectively.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, increased from 9.88 per cent in March 2013 to 10.38 in April 2013. The inter-bank rates declined to 7.87 during the period. The Nairobi Stock Exchange share index (NSE 20) decreased by 1.97 per cent from 4,861 points in March 2013 to 4,765 points in April 2013, while the total number of shares traded increased from 571 million shares to 597 million shares during the same period. The total value of shares traded at the NSE dropped from KSh 11.2 billion to KSh 9.9 billion. Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, expanded from KSh 1,755.5 billion in March 2013 to 1,802.0 billion in April 2013. In contrast, Money and Quasi-money (M2) increased from KSh 1,477.4 billion to KSh 1,532.4 billion over the same period. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves and Net Foreign Exchange Reserves increased to stand at 643.5 billion and KSh 354.3 billion respectively, over the same period.

A). AGRICULTURE

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange increased substantially by 48.2 per cent from 4,074 MT in February 2013 to 6,038 MT in March 2013 while its average auction price fell from KSh 326.60 per kilogram to KSh 278.89 per kilogram in the same period. The quantity of processed tea fell from 33,368 MT in March 2013 to 45,390 MT in April 2013 while its average auction price rose from KSh 240.73 per kilogram to KSh 284.11 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize rose from KSh 44.30 per kilogram in February 2013 to KSh 47.50 per kilogram in March 2013 while the average price for dry beans in March 2013 averaged KSh 73.73 per Kilogram.

B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported decreased by 19.6 per cent from 3,955.3 MT in February 2013 to 3,179.2 MT in March 2013 and its value dropped from KSh 1,429.4 to KSh 1,187.8 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported fell from 34,584.7 MT in February 2013 to 32,533.6 MT in March 2013, while its value fell from KSh 10,070.7 million to KSh 8,618.8 million during the same period. Volume of trade declined by 9.9 per cent from KSh 163.1 billion in February 2013 to KSh 147.0 billion in March 2013. Similarly, total value of exports declined by 18.3 per cent from 46.7 billion to 38.2 billion during the same period. Value of imports fell by 6.5 per cent over the same period. Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages category was the main export category in March 2013 accounting for 43.17 per cent, while the value of Non-food industrial supplies and Consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered 27.18 and 25.14 per cent shares, respectively. All the other economic categories recorded less than 5.00 per cent shares. Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that fuel & lubricants was the main import category in March 2013 with a share of 31.91 per cent, while the values of non-food industrial supplies, machinery & other capital equipment and transport equipment registered shares of 31.91, 13.83 and 9.89 per cent respectively. Food and beverage realized a share of 6.72 per cent while Consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 5.67 per cent.

C). ENERGY

Total electricity generation decreased from 672.72 million KWh in March 2013 to 655.39 million KWh in April 2013. Domestic consumption of electricity went up from 495.50 million KWh in March 2013 to 516.50 million KWh in April 2013. The total consumption of petroleum products fell to 285.10 thousand MT in March 2013 from 292.28 thousand MT realized in February 2013. National domestic average oil prices of motor gasoline premium decreased to retail at an average of KSh 118.38 per litre in April 2013 from KSh 118.41 per litre retailed in March 2012. The price of light diesel oil fell to KSh 107.29 in April 2013 from KSh 108.21 in March 2012. The average price for kerosene dropped to retail at KSh 84.68 from KSh 89.39 during the same period. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,626.37. In Nairobi County,

average retail prices for motor gasoline fell from the retail price of KSh 117.69 per litre in March 2013 to retail at KSh 117.65 per litre in April 2013. The price of Kerosene declined to retail at KSh 83.83 while light diesel oil retailed at 106.44 per litre, during the same period.

The price of Murban crude oil fell by 8.4 per cent per barrel from US Dollars 115.40 per barrel in March 2013 to US Dollars 105.65 per barrel in April 2013 in the international market.

D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION

Domestic production of sugar fell from 50,036 MT in February 2013 to 43,047 MT in March 2013. Production of soft drinks went up from 33,067 MT in December 2012 to 34,246 MT in January 2013. The production of new assembled vehicles declined from 545 vehicles in February 2013 to 470 vehicles in March 2013. The quantity of cement produced dropped from 377,561 MT in February 2013 to 373,337 MT in March 2013. Similarly, the consumption of cement fell from 334,285 MT recorded in February 2012 to 284,794 MT in March 2012. Milk deliveries to the formal sector declined by 11.8 per cent from 42.5 million litres in February 2013 to 37.5 million litres in March 2013.

E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Moi International Airports declined from 73,001 persons recorded in February 2013 to 69,953 persons in February 2013. The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) declined from 178,220 persons in February 2013 to 176,991 persons in March 2013, while passengers who landed fell from 178,202 persons to 176,895 persons in the same period. The total number of vehicles registered increased from 17,061 vehicles in March 2013 to 20,203 vehicles in March 2013. Motor cycles remained the leading category of vehicles registered during the month of April 2013 accounting for 69.6 per cent of the total.

FIG. 1: INFLATION RATES

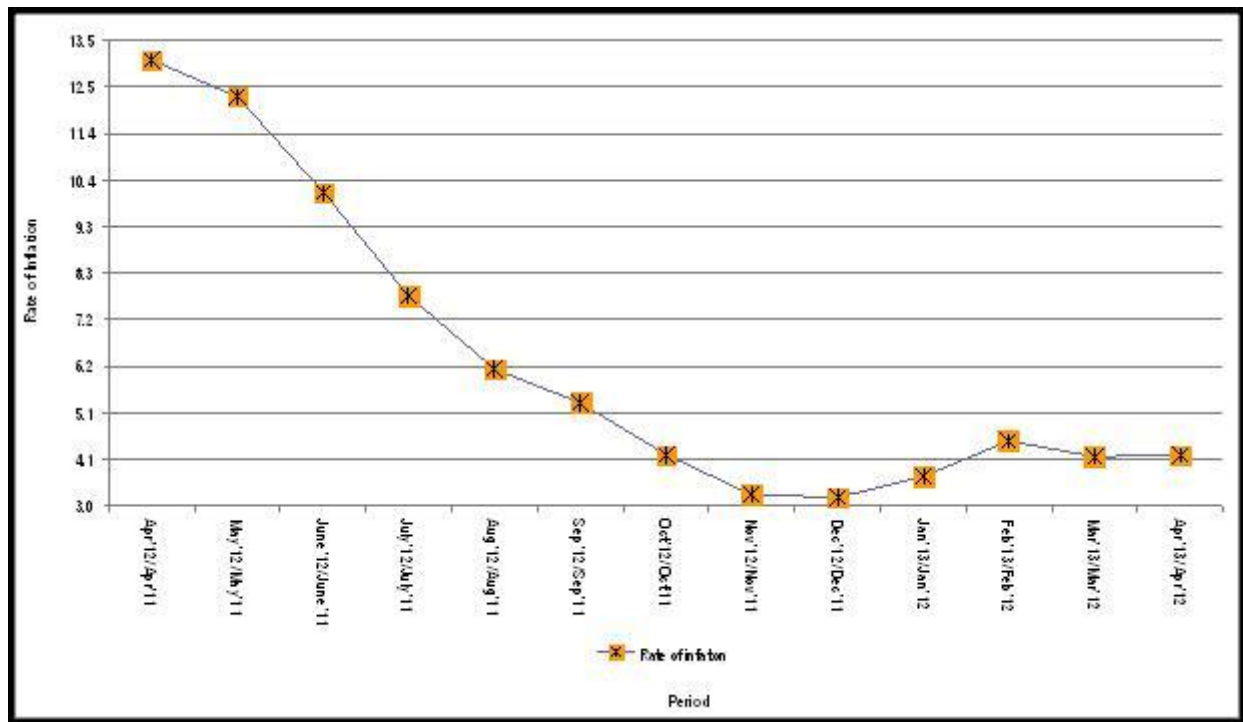

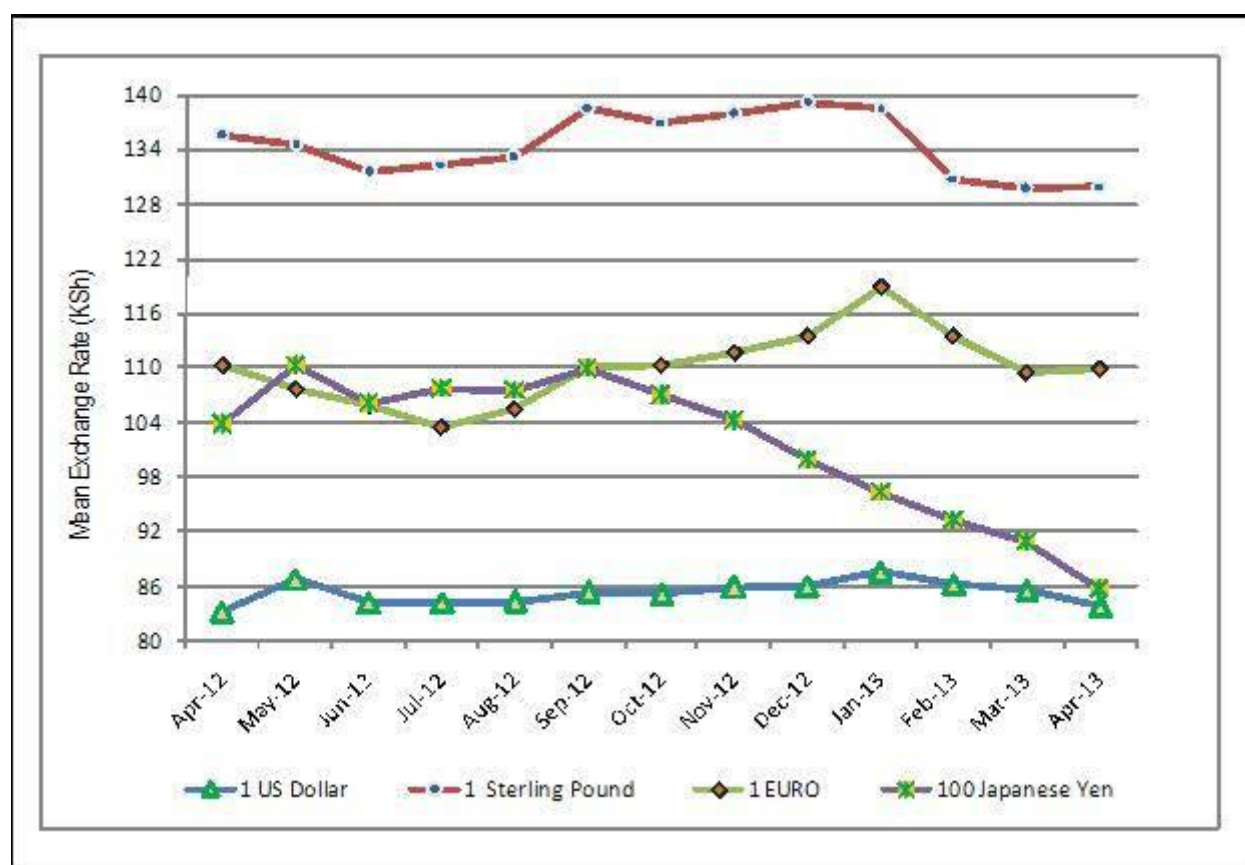

FIG 3: INTEREST RATES

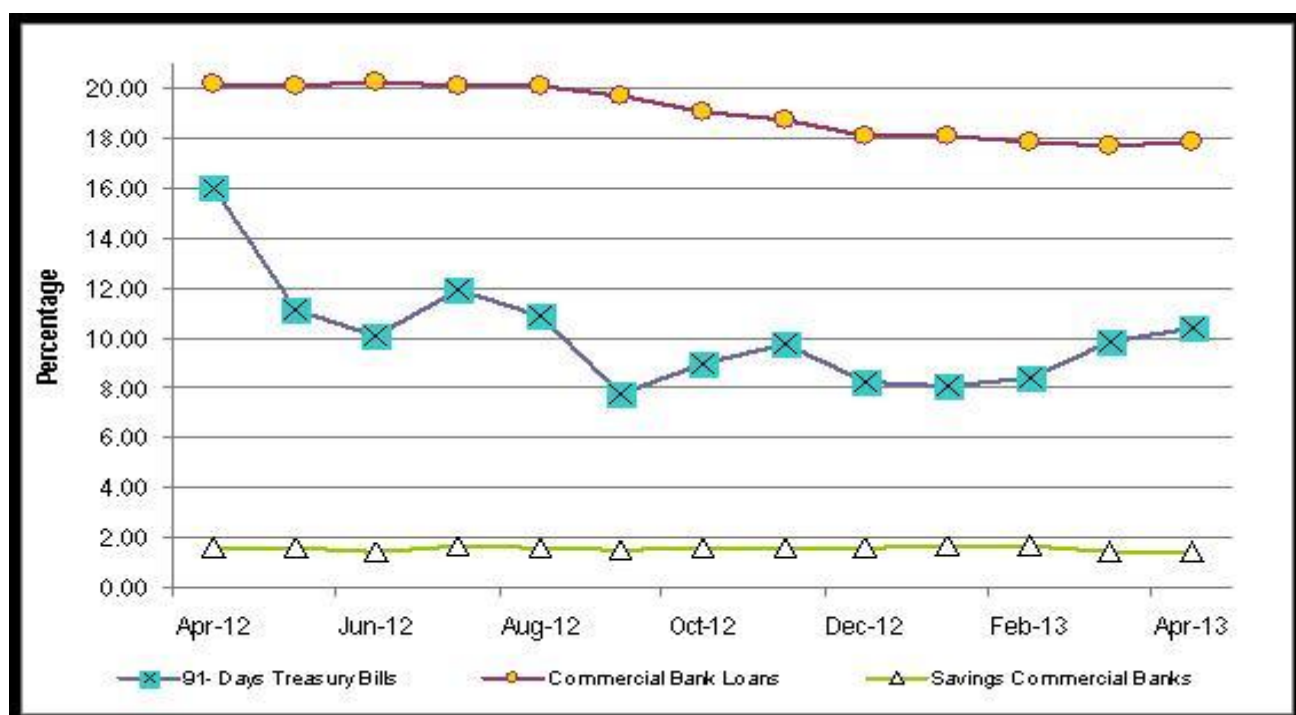

FIG 4: NAIROBI STOCK EXCHANGE SHARES INDEX

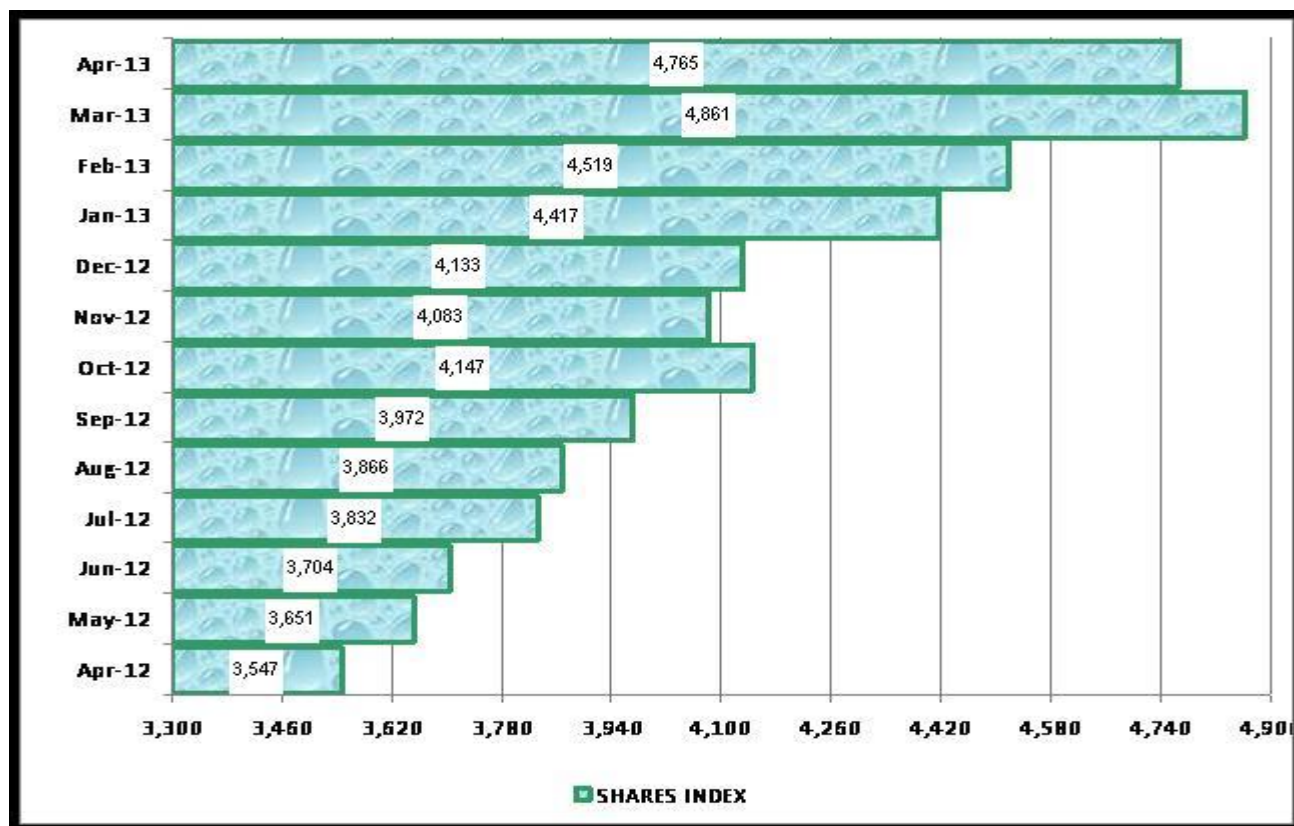

FIG 5: MONEY SUPPLY (M3)

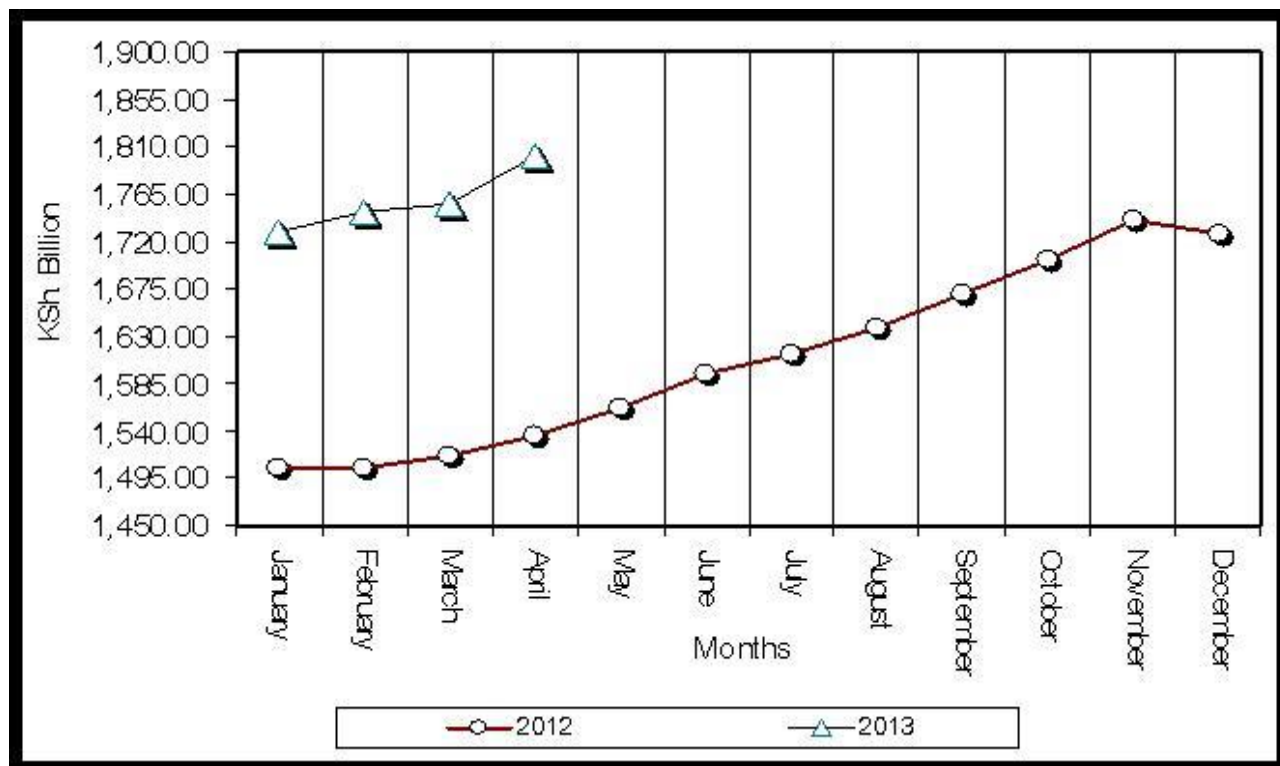

FIG 6: FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

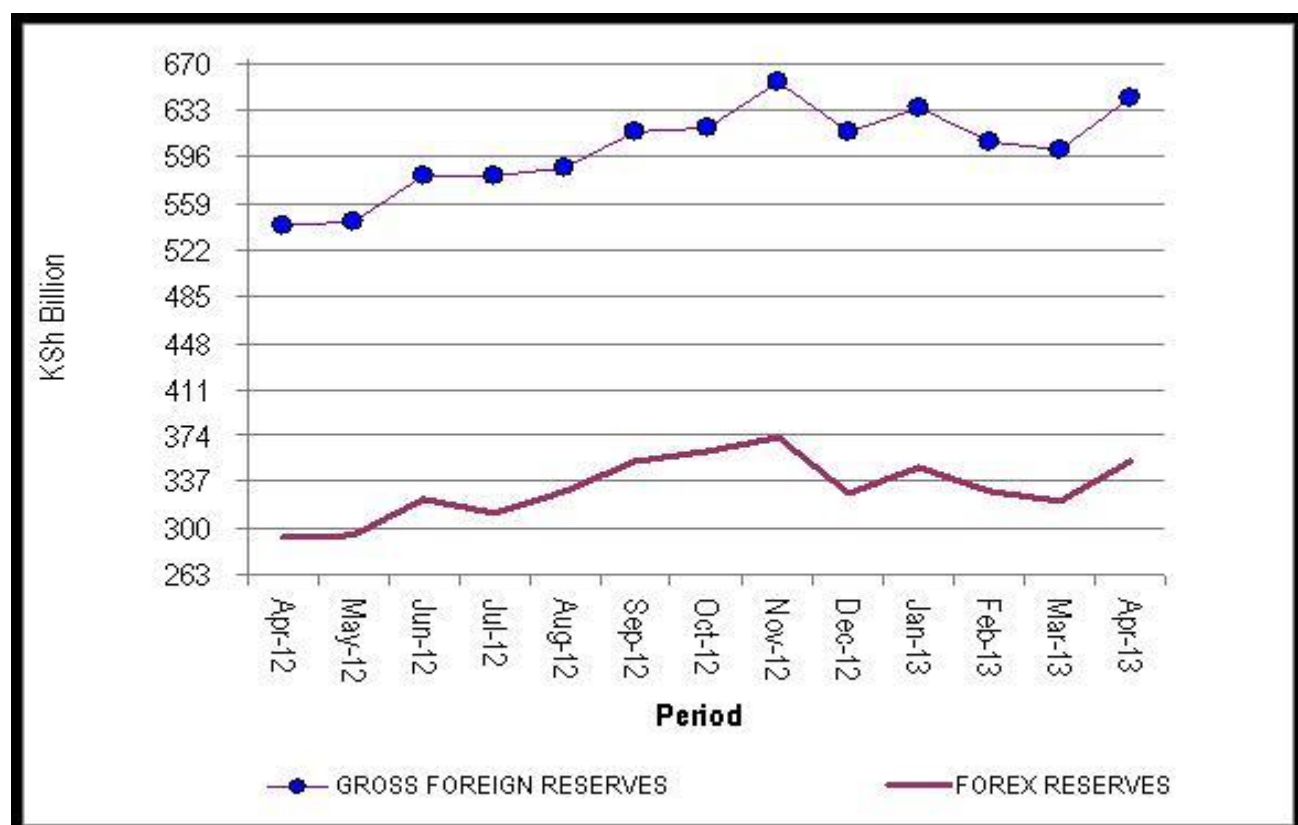

FIG.7: COFFEE SALES AT THE NAIROBI COFFEE EXCHANGE

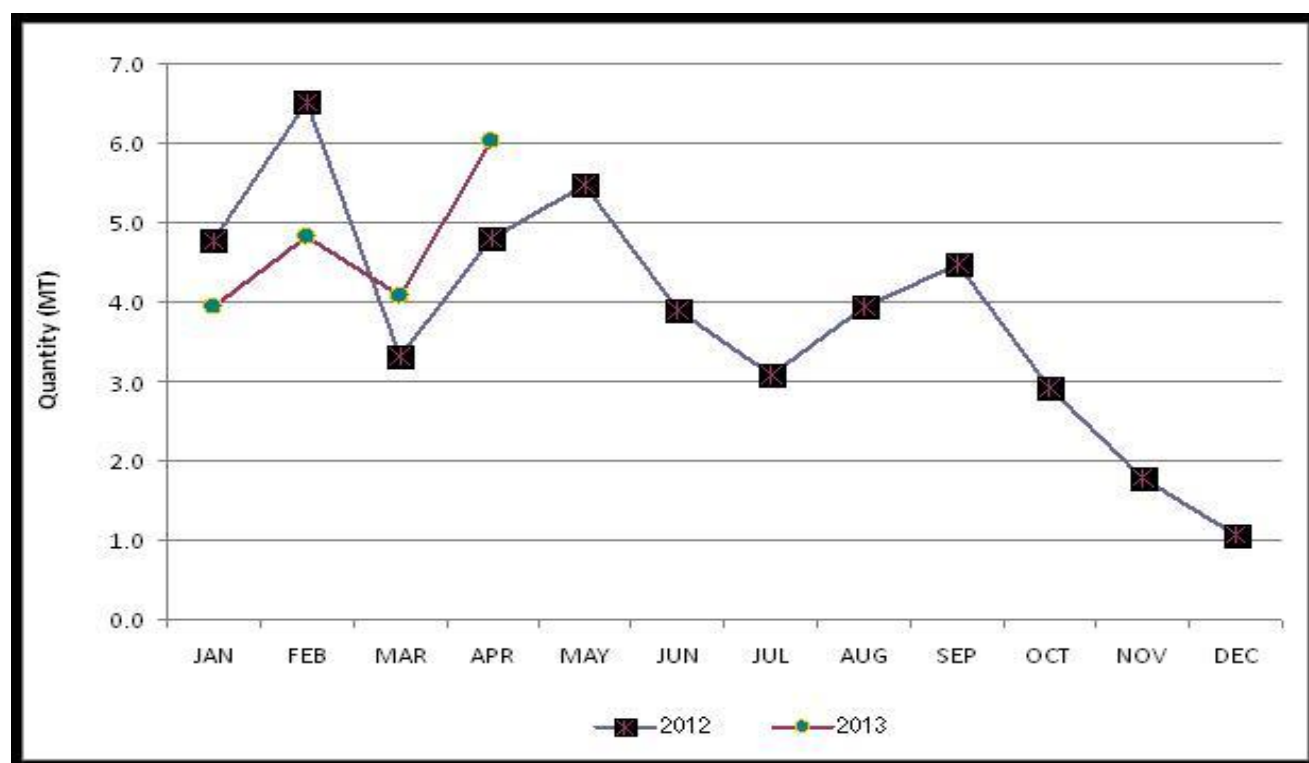

FIG.8: TEA PRODUCTION

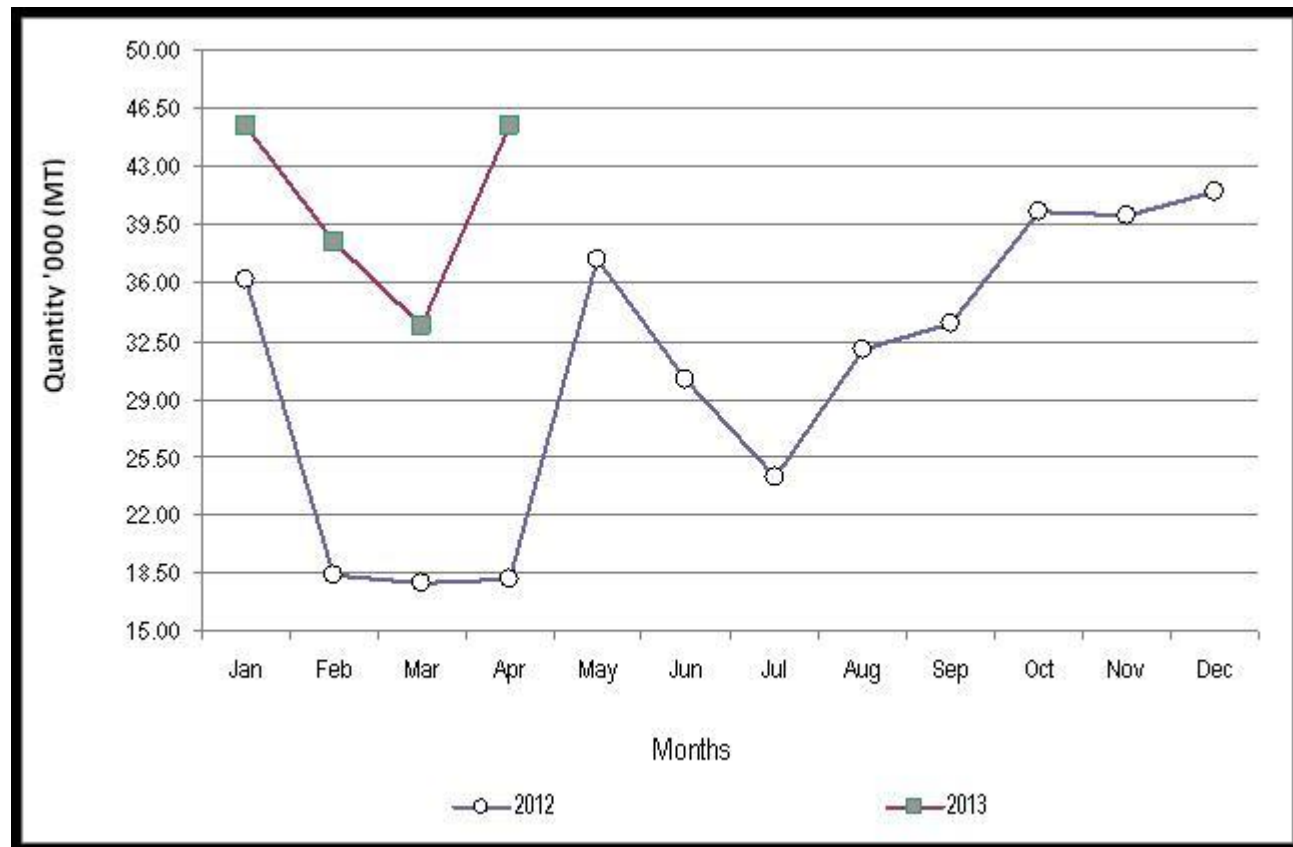

FIG.9: CANE DELIVERIES

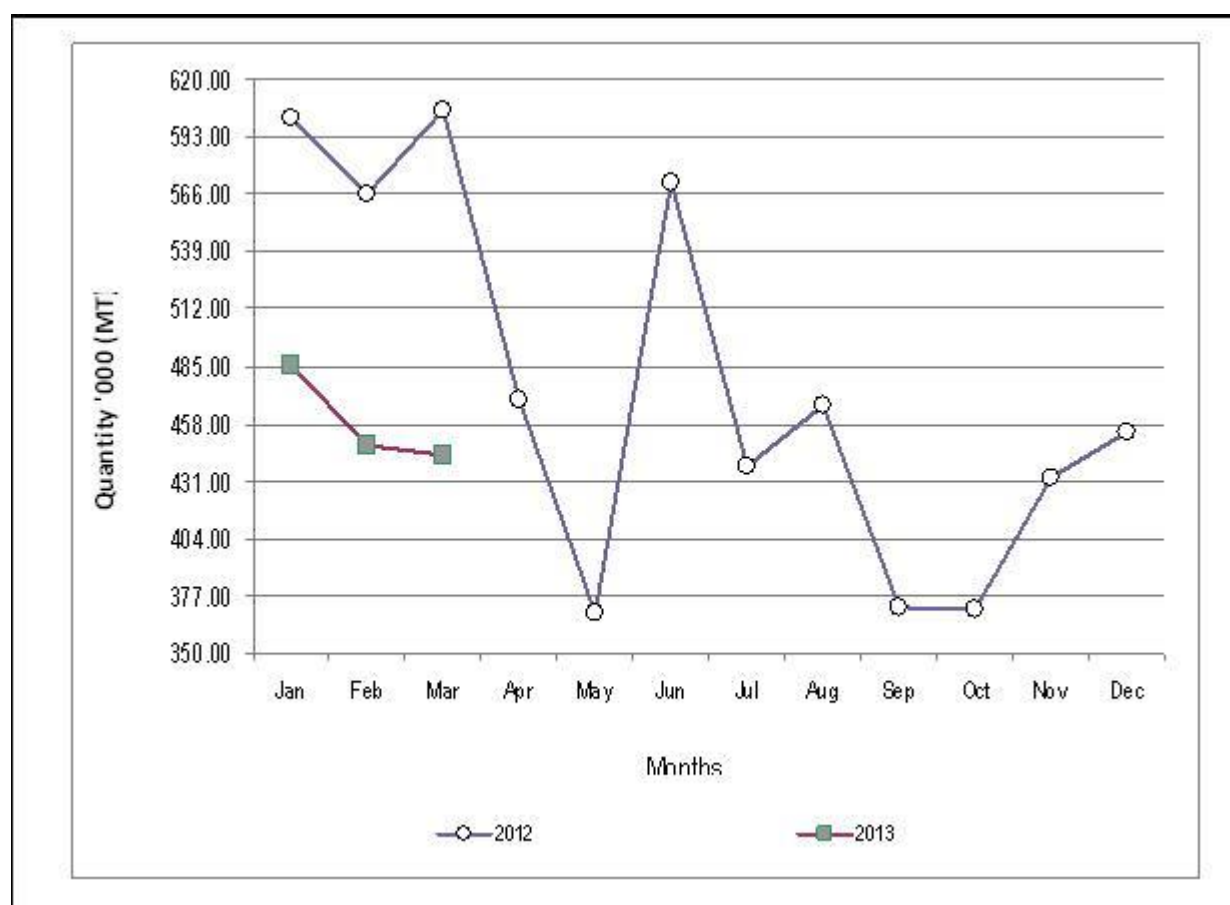

FIG 10: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE

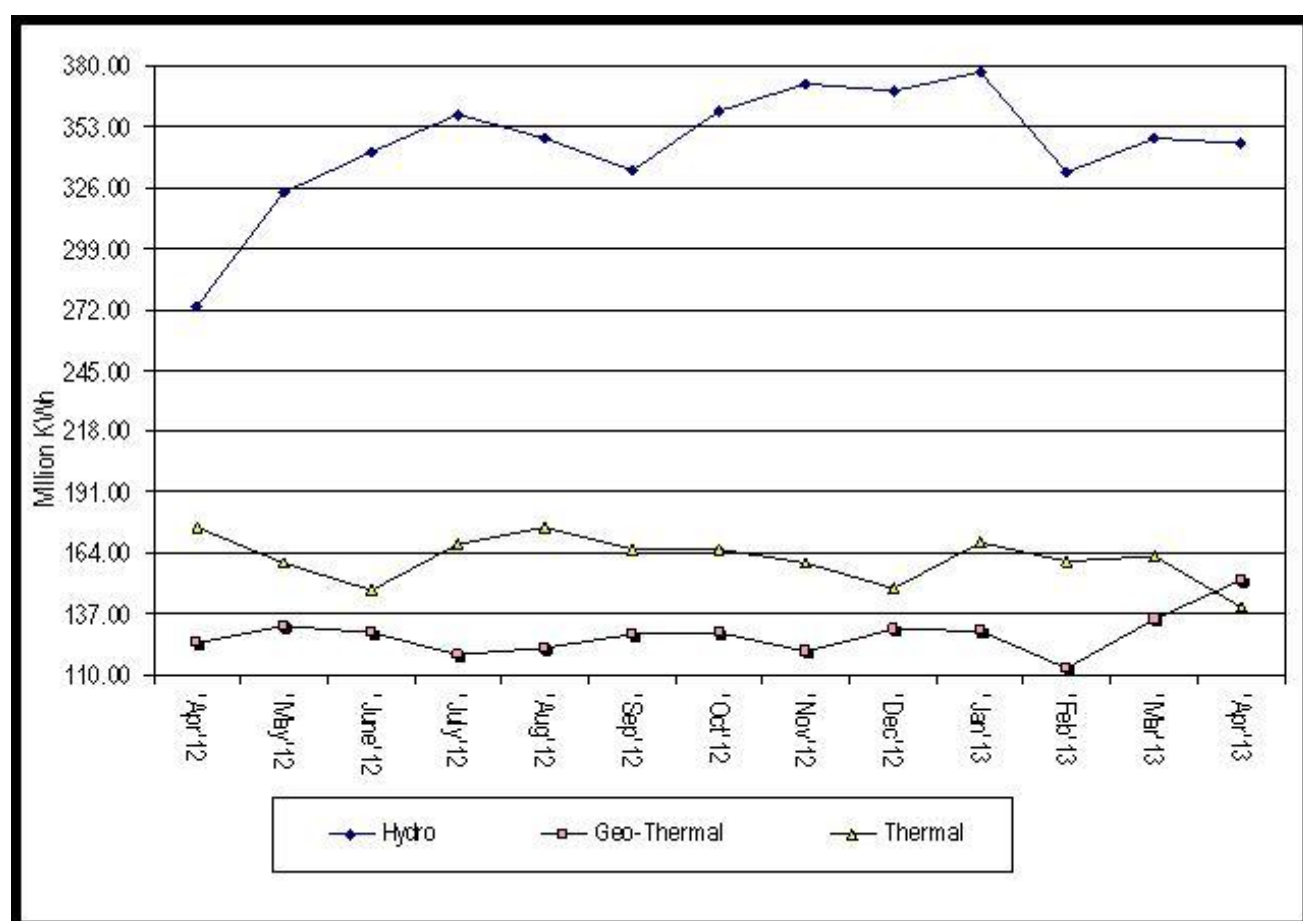

FIG 11: ELECTRICITY GENERATION, CONSUMPTION AND POWER LOSSES

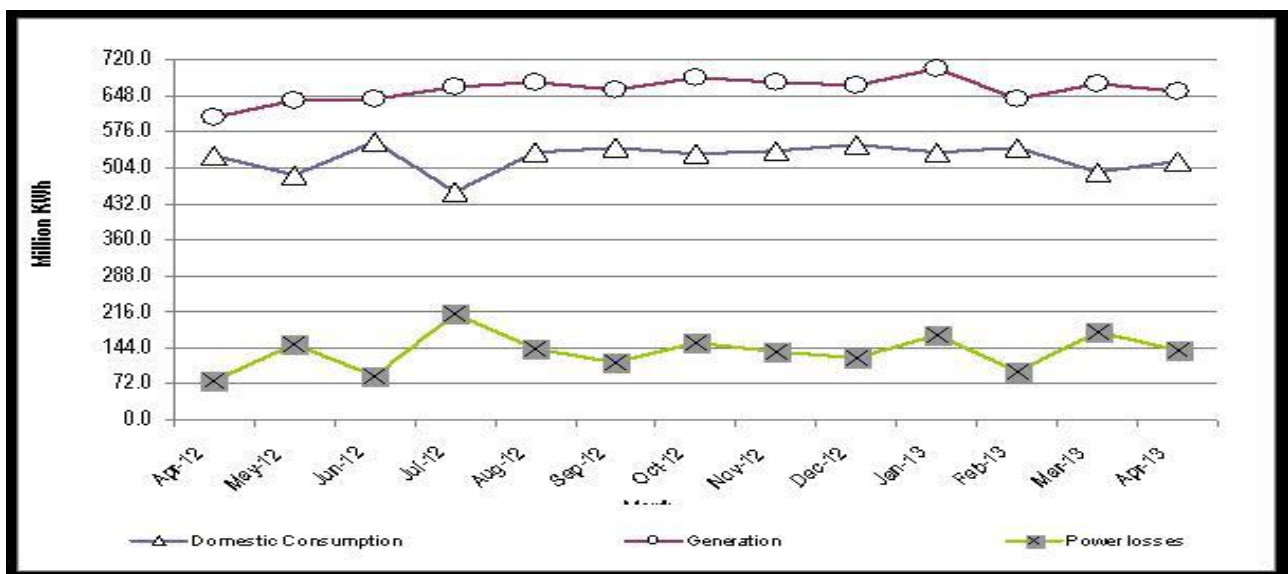

FIG 12(A): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

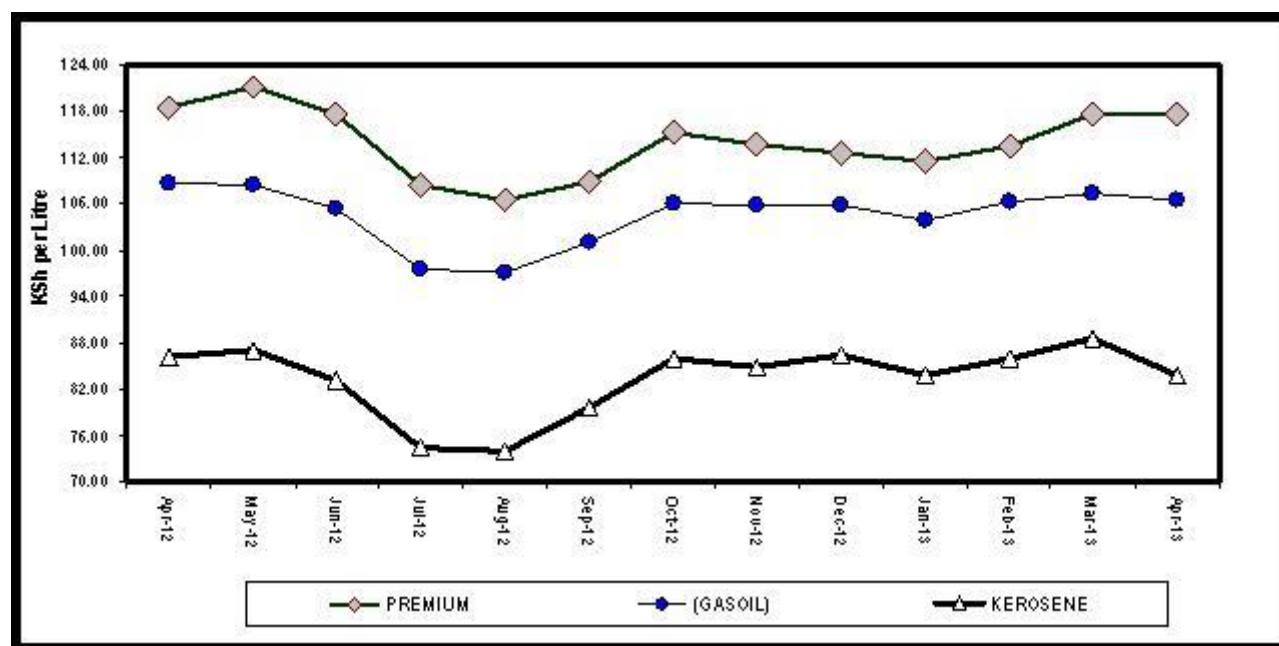

FIG 12(B): AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA

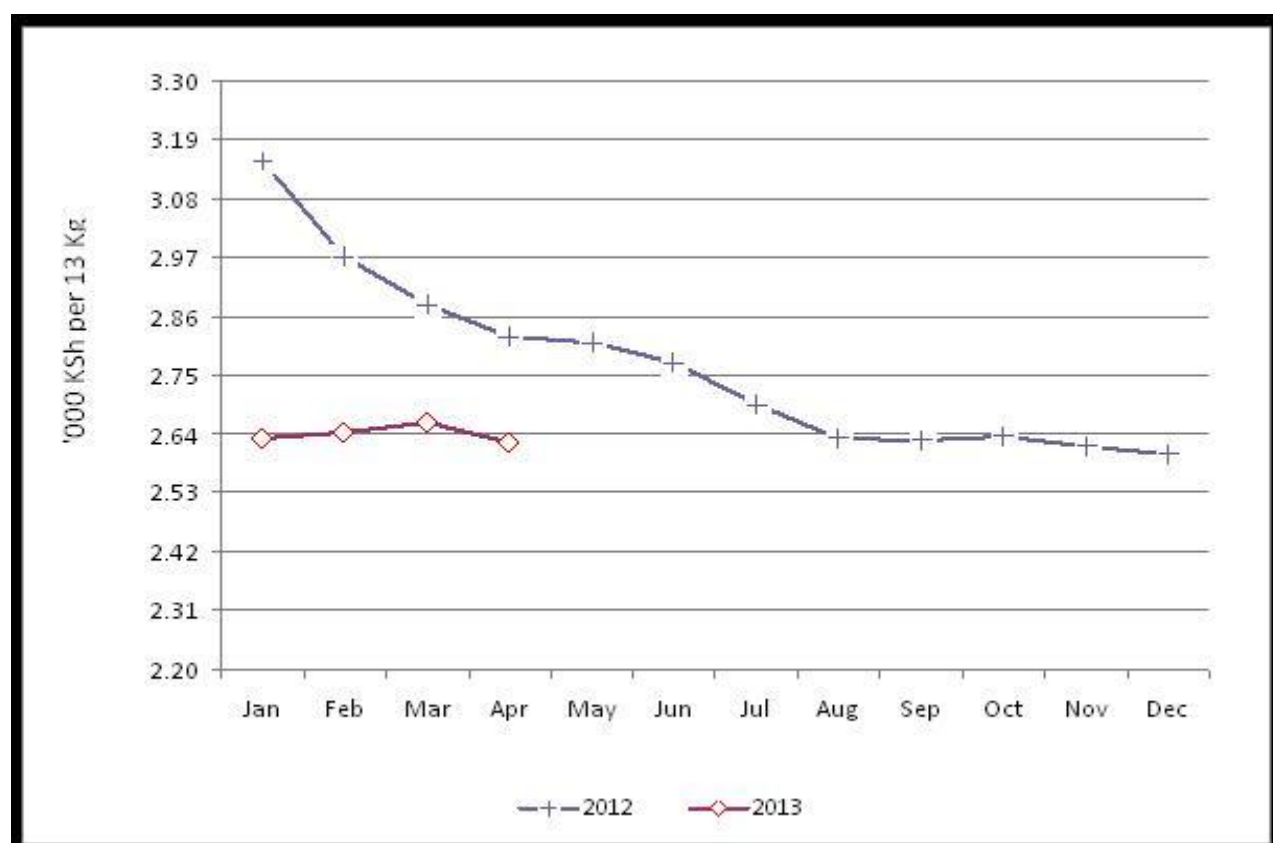

FIG 13: TRENDS FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES

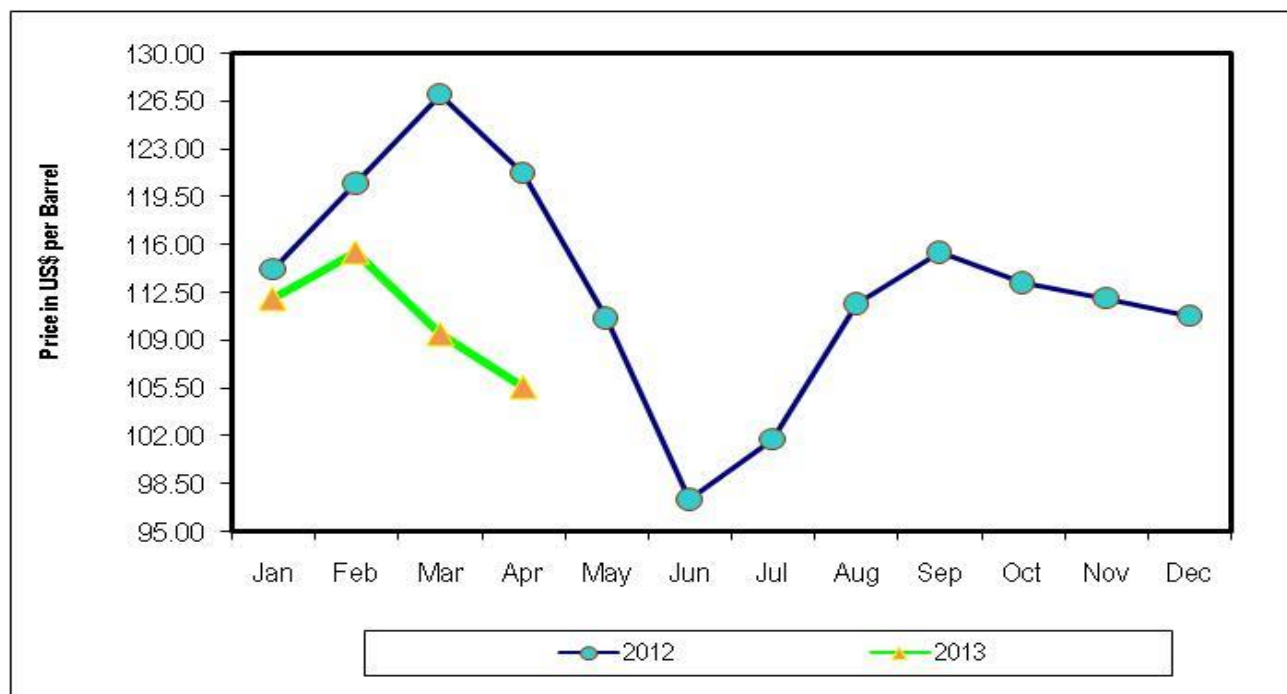

FIG 14: MILK INTAKE IN THE FORMAL SECTOR

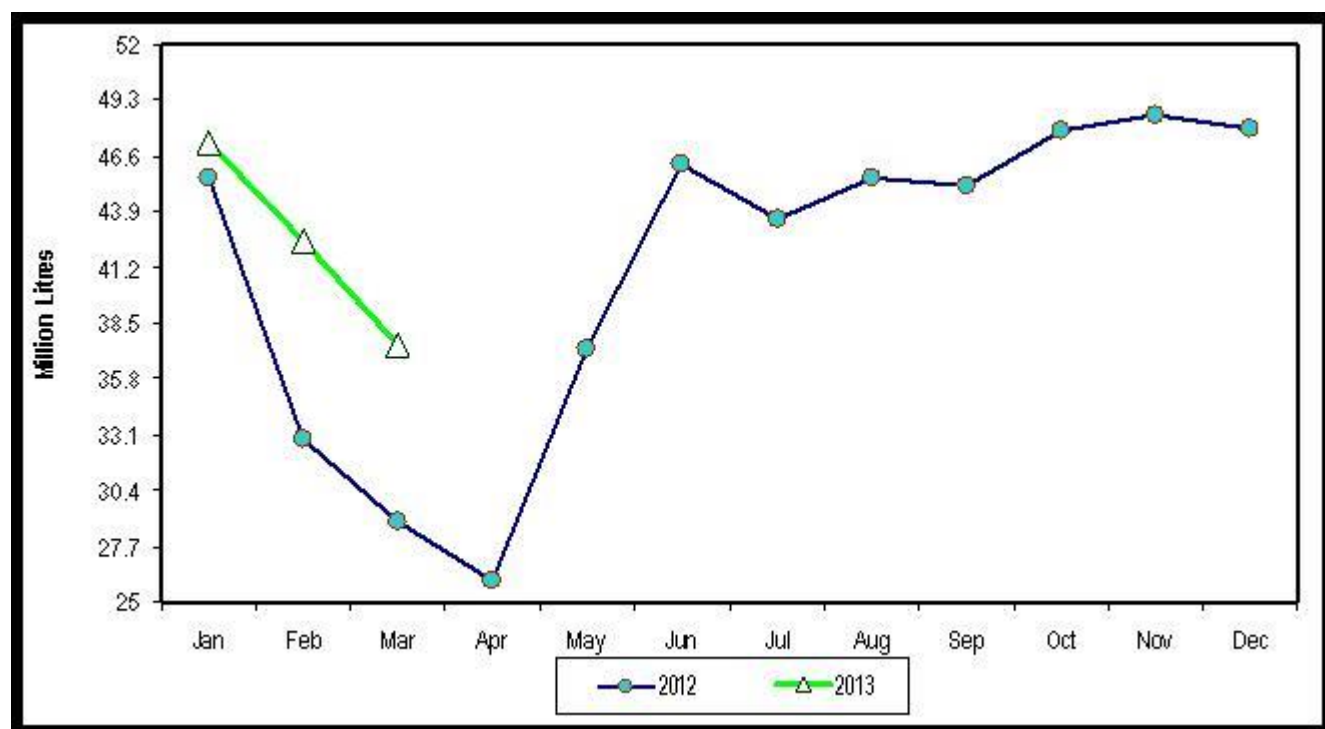

FIG 15: VISITORS ARRIVING IN KENYA THROUGH THE MAIN AIRPORTS

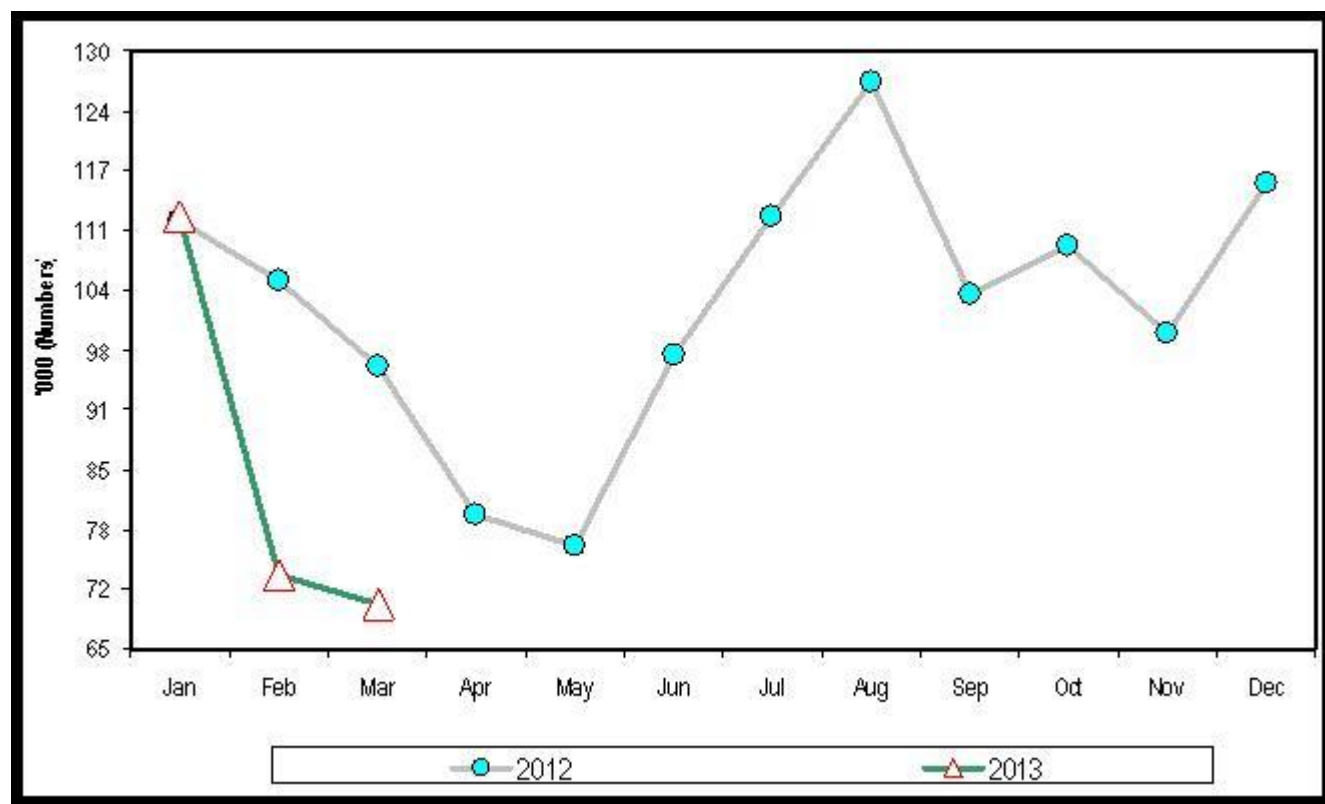

FIG 16: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF DESTINATION

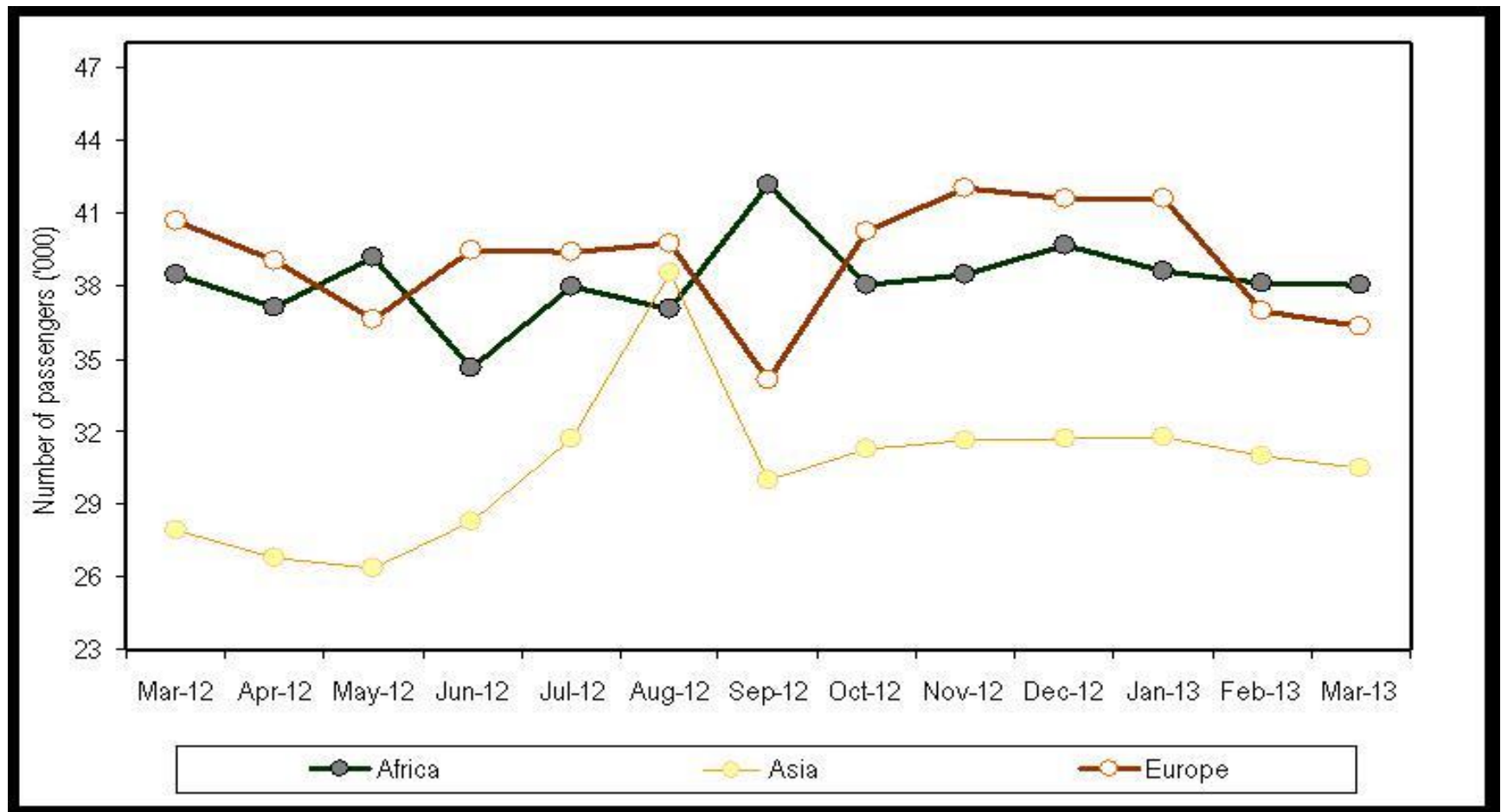

FIG 17: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF ORIGIN

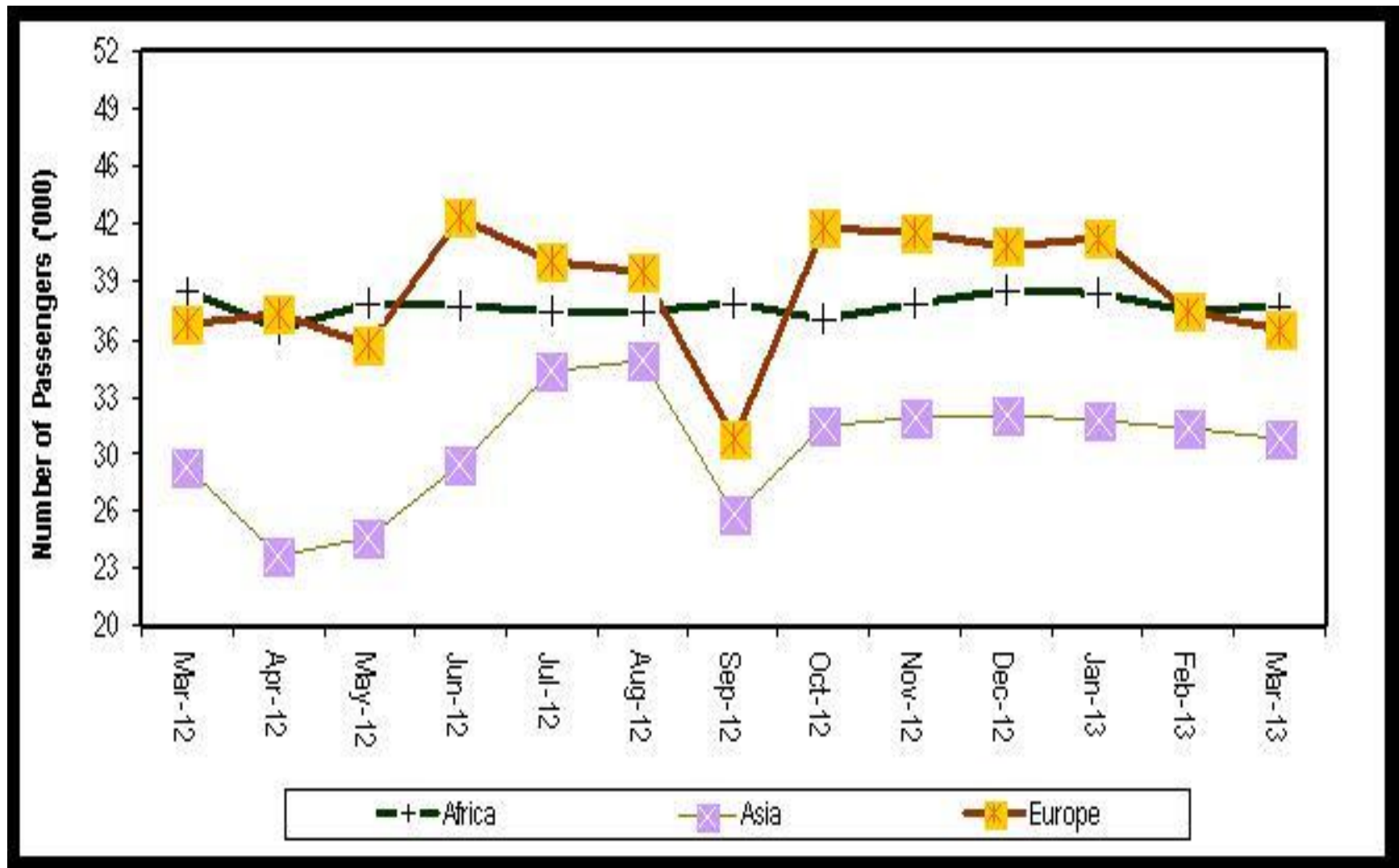
