


LEADING ECONOMIC INDICATORS



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KEY HIGHLIGHTS ON LEADING ECONOMIC INDICATORS

OVERVIEW

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators Publication for January 2011 highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS AND FINANCIAL INTERMEDIATION

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 1.3 per cent from 110.57 points in January 2011 to 112.05 points in February 2011. Kenya rate of inflation increased from 5.42 per cent in January 2011 to 6.54 per cent in February 2011.

The Kenyan Shilling depreciated against the world major currencies; US dollar, the Sterling pound, and the Euro at the end of January 2011 while appreciating against the other currencies in the same period by various margins. The Kenyan Shilling depreciated against the US dollar, the Sterling pound, and the Euro to exchange at an average of KSh 81.272, KSh 128.982, and KSh 110.610 at the end of January 2011, respectively. However, the Shilling appreciated against the Japanese Yen, the South African Rand, the Ugandan and the Tanzanian shilling to trade at an average of KSh 99.050, KSh 11.332, 28.362 and 18.494 in the same period compared to a trading of KSh 99.123, KSh 12.201, KSh 28.569 and KSh 18.514 as at the end of December 2010, respectively.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, rose from 2.276 per cent in December 2010 to 2.435 per cent in January 2011. The weighted average lending rate by Commercial banks for loans and advances increased from 13.87 per cent in December 2010 to 14.03 per cent in January 2011. Savings rate declined from 1.45 per cent in December 2010 to 1.25 per cent in January 2011.

The Nairobi Stock Exchange share index (NSE 20) increased by 0.7 per cent from 4432.6 points in December 2010 to 4464.9 points in January 2011. Total value of shares traded rose by 60.9 per cent from KSh 5.88 billion in December 2010 to KSh 9.46 billion in January 2011. Total number of shares traded increased significantly from 357.6 million shares traded in December 2010 to 725.0 million shares traded in January 2011.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, expanded from KSh 1,272.6 billion in December 2010 to KSh 1,288.9 billion in January 2011. Money and quasi-money (M2) expanded by 1.6 per cent from KSh 1100.30 billion to KSh 1117.5 billion over the same period.

Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves declined by 5.6 per cent in January 2011 from KSh 417.3 billion in December 2010 to stand at KSh 415.0 billion, while Net Foreign Exchange Reserves expanded by 2.5 per cent over the same period to stand at KSh 280.38 billion in January 2011.

SECTORAL PERFORMANCES

A). AGRICULTURE

Quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange decreased from 4,065 MT in November 2010 to 1,467 MT in December 2010. However, its average auction price increased from KSh 473.49 per kilogram to KSh 538.65 per kilogram in the same period.

Quantity of processed tea decreased by 6.1 per cent from 38,330 MT in December 2010 to 35,999 MT in January 2011 and its average auction price increased by 8.3 per cent from KSh 236.88 per kilogram to KSh 256.43 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize rose from KSh 17.99 per kilogram in November 2010 to KSh 18.63 per kilogram in December 2010 and average price for dry beans stood at KSh 62.23 per Kilogram in December 2010.

B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported decreased by 25.2 per cent from 3252.3 MT in November 2010 to 2,432.0 MT in December 2010 while its value decreased by 30.1 per cent from KSh 1,241.1 million to KSh 867.0 million over the same period.

Quantity of tea exported increased by 0.8 per cent from 35,137.4 MT in November 2010 to 35,409.6 MT in December 2010 while its value stood at KSh 8,021.8 million over the same period.

Quantity of horticultural produce exported declined by 73.4 per cent from 15,850 MT in November 2010 to 4,219 MT in December 2010 and its export value declined from KSh 4.279 billion to KSh 1.824 billion over the same period.

Volume of trade decreased by 5.9 per cent from KSh 142.0 billion in November 2010 to KSh 133.6 billion in December 2010, while total exports increased by 2.4 per cent and imports declined by 9.1 per cent over the same period.

Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that food and beverages were the main export category in December 2010 with a share of 39.71 per cent, while Non-food industrial supplies and consumer

goods not elsewhere specified indicated a share of 33.58 per cent and 21.77 per cent, respectively. All the other economic categories recorded less than 5 per cent shares in total export.

Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that imports shares of Industrial supplies (non-food), Fuel and lubricants, Consumer goods not elsewhere specified increased in December 2010 compared to the month of November, 2010. Food and beverages, Machinery and other capital equipments, Transport equipment, and goods not elsewhere specified registered declines during the same period. Industrial supplies (non-food), Fuel and lubricants, Machinery and other Capital equipment, and Transport equipment, indicated import shares of 30.42, 23.27, 18.62, and 13.59 per cent, respectively. Food and Beverages, consumer goods not elsewhere specified and goods not else where specified had shares of 6.10, 7.96 and 0.03 per cent of the import bill respectively.

C). ENERGY

Total electricity generation increased by 3.6 per cent from 603.4 million KWh in December 2010 to 625.2 million KWh in January 2011. Domestic consumption of electricity rose by 2.2 per cent from 513.3 million KWh in December 2010 to 524.8 million KWh in January 2011.

Total consumption of petroleum products increased by 13.7 per cent from 263.1 thousand MT in November 2010 to 299.1 thousand MT in December 2010.

Domestic oil prices of motor gasoline declined to retail at KSh 95.37 per litre in January 2011 from KSh 95.65 per litre retailed in December 2010 while the price of kerosene increased to retail at KSh 78.45 per litre during the same period. Light diesel retailed at KSh 89.47 per litre during the same period. In Nairobi, average retail prices for motor gasoline increased from the retail price of KSh 94.05 per litre in December 2010 to retail at KSh 95.67 per litre in January 2011 while the price of kerosene increased to retail at KSh 77.51 per litre during the same period. Light diesel retailed at KSh 88.7 during the same period.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil increased by 4.0 per cent per barrel from US Dollars 91.85 per barrel in December 2010 to US Dollars 95.55 per barrel in January 2011.

D). MANUFACTURING AND, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION

Domestic production of sugar increased by 9.0 per cent from 50,822 MT in November 2010 to 55,414 MT in December 2010, while production of soft drinks rose by 6.2 per cent from 29,333 MT in November 2010 to 31,163 in MT December 2010.

Production of new assembled vehicles increased by 12 vehicles from 490 vehicles in November 2010 to 502 assembled vehicles in December 2010, while production of galvanized sheets declined from 16,439 MT in November 2010 to 15,331 MT in December 2010.

Quantity of cement produced decreased by 5.3 per cent from 319,331 MT in November 2010 to 302,526 MT in December 2010. Consumption of cement declined by 10.7 per cent from 277,448 MT in November 2010 to 247,867 MT in December 2010.

Milk deliveries in the formal milk sector decreased by 0.9 per cent from 43.37 million litres in November 2010 to 43.00 million litres reported in December 2010.

E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT

Number of visitors who arrived through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Moi International Airports decreased by 8.3 per cent from 98,934 visitors recorded in October of 2010 to 90,672 visitors in November 2010.

The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) increased by 17.7 per cent from 125,408 persons in November 2010 to 147,572 persons in December 2010, while passengers who landed rose by 5.0 per cent from 145,450 persons in November 2010 to 152,746 persons in December 2010.

Total number of vehicles registered a decrease of 14.7 per cent from 20,596 vehicles in November 2010 to 17,571 vehicles in December 2010. Motor cycles remained the main vehicles registered in December 2010.

FIG. 1: INFLATION RATES





FIG 3: INTEREST RATES



FIG 4: NAIROBI STOCK EXCHANGE SHARES INDEX



FIG 5: MONEY SUPPLY (M3)




FIG 6: FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

FIG.7: COFFEE SALES AT THE NAIROBI COFFEE EXCHANGE



FIG.8: TEA PRODUCTION



FIG 9: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE



FIG 10: ELECTRICITY GENERATION CONSUMPTION AND POWER LOSSES



FIG 11(A): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS



FIG 11(B): AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA



FIG 12: TRENDS FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES



FIG 13: MILK INTAKE IN THE FORMAL SECTOR



FIG 14: VISITORS ARRIVING IN KENYA THROUGH THE MAIN AIRPORTS



FIG 15: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF DESTINATION



FIG 16: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF ORIGIN


