


# LEADING ECONOMIC INDICATORS



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## **KEY HIGHLIGHTS**

### **OVERVIEW**

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators publication for June 2013 highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

### **MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS**

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased from 139.52 points in May 2013 to 139.59 points in June 2013. The overall rate of inflation rose from 4.05 per cent to 4.91 per cent during the period. The Kenyan Shilling depreciated against all major international currencies except the South African rand. The Kenyan shilling exchanged at an average of KSh 85.49, KSh 132.48, KSh 112.81, KSh 87.77, KSh 8.51, KSh 30.34 and KSh 19.13 against the US dollar, sterling pound, Euro, Japanese Yen, South African rand, the Ugandan and Tanzanian shilling respectively, as at the end of June 2013.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, decreased from 9.46 per cent in May 2013 to 6.21 in June 2013. The inter-bank rates increased from 7.15 per cent to 7.22 per cent during the period. The Nairobi Securities Exchange share index (NSE 20) declined by 8.15 per cent from 5,006 points in May 2013 to 4,598 points in June 2013, while the total number of shares traded decreased from 868 million shares to 728 million shares during the same period. The total value of shares traded at the NSE dropped from KSh 16.1 billion to KSh 13.0 billion. Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, decreased from KSh 1,823.1 billion in May 2013 to 1,820.6 billion in June 2013. Money and Quasi-money (M2) expanded from KSh 1,543.5 billion to KSh 1,547.6 billion over the same period. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves inflated from KSh 679,909 Million in May to KSh 687,405 Million in June 2013. On the contrary, Net Foreign Exchange Reserves declined to KSh 363.0 billion from KSh 376.0 billion over the same period.

## **A). AGRICULTURE**

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange declined from 6,038 MT in April 2013 to 4,483 MT in May 2013 while its average auction price fell from KSh 278.89 per kilogram to KSh 229.83 per kilogram in the same period. The quantity of processed tea increased from 38,230 MT in April 2013 to 39,600 MT in May 2013 while its average auction price went up from KSh 210.09 per kilogram to KSh 214.54 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize increased from KSh 36.37 per kilogram in April 2013 to KSh 38.29 per kilogram in May 2013 while the average price for dry beans averaged KSh 74.08 per Kilogram in May 2013.

## **B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE**

Quantity of coffee exported increased by 29.5 per cent from 3,986.1 MT in April 2013 to 5,163.8 MT in May 2013 while its value rose by 31.5 per cent from KSh 1,361.5 to KSh 1,789.8 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported rose by 21.6 per cent from 33,661.5 MT in April 2013 to 40,935.5 MT in May 2013, while its value increased by 18.1 per cent from KSh 8,011.9 million to KSh 9,462.9 million during the same period. Volume of trade declined by 9.7 per cent from KSh 161.3 billion in April 2013 to KSh 157.3 billion in May 2013. Similarly, total value of exports increased by 2.4 per cent from KSh 42.6 billion to KSh 43.6 billion during the same period. Value of imports fell by 4.2 per cent over the same period. Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages category continued to be the main export category in May 2013 and accounted for 43.89 per cent, while the value of Non-food industrial supplies and Consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered 26.89 and 24.14 per cent shares, respectively. All the other economic categories recorded less than 3.00 per cent shares. Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that industrial supplies (non-food) was the main import category in May 2013 with a share of 29.87 per cent, while the values of fuel and lubricants, machinery & other capital equipment and transport equipment registered shares of 26.19, 18.33 and 9.81 per cent respectively. Food and beverage realized a share of 7.26 per cent while Consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 6.69 per cent.

## **C). ENERGY**

Total electricity generation increased from 698.83 million KWh in May 2013 to 708.39 million KWh in June 2013. Domestic consumption of electricity rose from 549.67 million KWh in May 2013 to 610.20 million KWh in June 2013. The total consumption of petroleum products dropped to 278.53 thousand MT in June 2013 from 288.75 thousand MT realized in May 2013. Average national domestic average oil prices of motor gasoline premium decreased by 4.4 per cent to retail at an average of KSh 108.93 per litre in June 2013 from KSh 113.99 per litre retailed in May 2013. The price of light diesel oil fell by 1.9 per cent to KSh

100.01 in June 2013 from KSh 101.91 in May 2013. The average price for kerosene rose to retail at KSh 82.38 from KSh 80.32 during the same period. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,573.75 in June 2013. In Nairobi County, average retail prices for motor gasoline fell by 4.5 per cent from the retail price of KSh 113.24 per litre in May 2013 to retail at KSh 108.18 per litre in June 2013. The price of Kerosene increased to retail at KSh 81.52 while light diesel oil averaged KSh 99.16 per litre, during the same period.

The price of Murban crude oil dropped by 0.6 per cent from US Dollars 103.65 per barrel in May 2013 to US Dollars 103.00 per barrel in June 2013 in the international market.

#### **D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION**

Domestic production of sugar declined from 39,151 MT in April 2013 to 36,529 MT in May 2013. Production of soft drinks went up from 32,025.5 MT in Feb 2013 to 41,693.6 MT in March 2013. The production of new assembled vehicles fell from 437 vehicles in March 2013 to 297 vehicles in April 2013. The production of galvanized sheets declined from 25,122 MT in March 2013 to 22,080 MT in April 2013.

The quantity of cement produced went up from 351,178 MT in April 2013 to 382,217 MT in May 2013. The consumption of cement increased from 291,795 MT recorded in April 2013 to 305,922 MT in May 2013. Milk deliveries to the formal sector increased from 44.4 million litres in April 2013 to 50.6 million litres in May 2013.

#### **E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT**

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports increased from 74,523 persons in May 2013 to 97,775 persons in June 2013. The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) increased from 177,688 persons in April 2013 to 178,055 persons in May 2013, while passengers who landed increased from 177,471 persons to 177,815 persons in the same period. The total number of vehicles registered declined from 25,070 vehicles in May 2013 to 23,527 vehicles in June 2013. Motor cycles accounted for more than half (64.6 per cent) of the total in the month of June.

FIG. 1: INFLATION RATES





FIG 3: INTEREST RATES



FIG 4: NAIROBI STOCK EXCHANGE SHARES INDEX



FIG 5: MONEY SUPPLY (M3)



FIG 6: FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES



FIG.7: COFFEE SALES AT THE NAIROBI COFFEE EXCHANGE




FIG.8: TEA PRODUCTION

FIG 10: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE



FIG 11: ELECTRICITY GENERATION, CONSUMPTION AND POWER LOSSES





**FIG 12(B): AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA**



FIG 13: TRENDS FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES





FIG 14: MILK INTAKE IN THE FORMAL SECTOR





FIG 16: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF DESTINATION



FIG 17: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF ORIGIN


