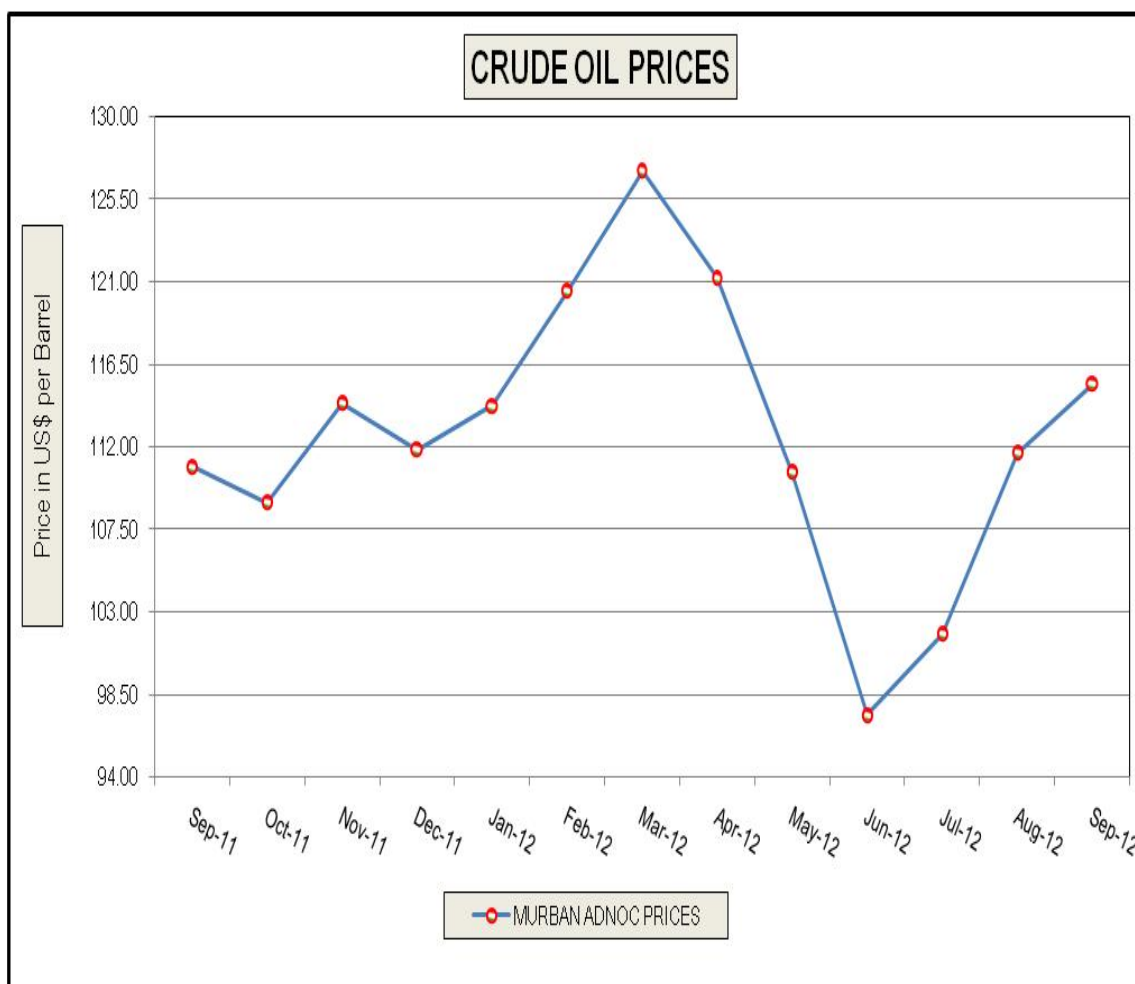

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KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators publication for September 2012 highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased slightly from 131.51 points in August 2012 to 131.89 points in September 2012. The overall rate of inflation decreased from 6.09 per cent to 5.32 per cent in the same period. The Kenyan Shilling depreciated against worlds' major currencies; the US dollar, the Sterling Pound, the Euro, the Japanese Yen, the South African Rand and the Tanzanian to exchange at an average of KSh 85.2833, 138.5665, 110.1465, 109.9756, 10.3825 and 18.4797 respectively, as at the end of September 2012. However, the shilling appreciated against the Ugandan shilling.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, declined from 10.93 per cent in August 2012 to 7.77 in September 2012. The inter-bank rates decreased from 9.088 per cent to 7.009 during the same period.

The Nairobi Stock Exchange share index (NSE 20) increased by 2.75 per cent from 3,866 points in August 2012 to 3,972 points in September 2012, while the total number of shares traded rose from 339 million shares traded to 470 million shares traded during the same period. The total value of shares traded at the NSE went up from KSh 5,681 to KSh 9,781 billion. Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, expanded from KSh 1,638.4 billion in August 2012 to 1670.4 billion in September 2012. Similarly, Money and quasi-money (M2) increased from KSh 1364.2 billion to KSh 1,409.0 billion over the same period. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves and Net Foreign Exchange Reserves expanded to 616.5 billion and KSh 353.1 billion respectively over the same period.

A). AGRICULTURE

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange increased from 3,948 MT in August 2012 to 4,474 MT in September 2012 while its average auction price fell from KSh 277.28 per kilogram to KSh 265.25 per kilogram in the same period. The quantity of processed tea increased from 24,306 MT in August 2012 to 31,920 MT in September

2012 while its average auction price rose from KSh 287.79 per kilogram to KSh 287.71 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize decreased from KSh 46.20 per kilogram in July 2012 to KSh 46.00 per kilogram in August 2012 while the average price for dry beans in August 2012 fell to an average of KSh 71.50 per Kilogram.

B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported increased by 17.2 per cent from 4,887.2 MT in June 2012 to 5,727.3 MT in July 2012 while its value went up by 14.2 per cent from KSh 2,098.2 million to KSh 2,396.9 million over the same period. In contrast, the quantity of tea exported declined by 16.3 per cent from 29,147.6 MT in June 2012 to 28,054.4 MT in July 2012, while its value went up marginally from KSh 7,770.2 million in June 2012 to KSh 7,812.6 million in July 2012.

Volume of trade rose by 8.5 per cent from KSh 153.3 billion in June 2012 to KSh 166.3 billion in July 2012. Similarly, total value of exports increased by 4.0 per cent, while the value of imports went up by 10.1 per cent over the same period. Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that food and beverages category was the main export category in July 2012 with a share of 40.80 per cent, while the value of Non-food industrial supplies and Consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered a share of 31.35 and 22.61 per cent, respectively. All the other economic categories recorded less than 5.0 per cent shares.

Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicate that non-food industrial supplies was the main import category in July 2012 with a share of 28.23 per cent, while the values of fuel & lubricants, machinery & other capital equipment and transport equipment registered shares of 24.55, 20.45 and 9.53 per cent respectively. Consumer goods not elsewhere specified realized a share of 9.01 per cent while Food and beverage realized a share of 7.12 per cent.

C). ENERGY

Total electricity generation increased slightly from 675.6 million KWh in August 2012 to 677.0 million KWh in September 2012. Domestic consumption of electricity went up by 1.8 per cent from 534.4 million KWh in August 2012 to 544.2 million KWh in September 2012. The total consumption of petroleum products fell from 410.9 thousand MT in August 2012 to 399.75 thousand MT in September 2012.

National domestic average oil prices of motor gasoline premium increased to retail at an average of KSh 107.25 per litre in August 2012 from KSh 109.70 per litre retailed in September 2012. The price of light diesel oil went up to KSh 101.92 in September 2012 from KSh 97.94 in August 2012. The average price for kerosene increased to retail at KSh 80.51 in September 2012 from KSh 74.84 in August 2012. In Nairobi, average retail prices for motor gasoline increased from the retail price of KSh 106.48 per litre in August 2012 to retail at KSh

108.95 per litre in September 2012. Similarly, the price of kerosene and light diesel oil went up to retail at KSh 79.65 and 101.07 per litre respectively, during the same period.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil rose by 3.4 per cent per barrel from US Dollars 111.65 per barrel in August 2012 to US Dollars 115.40 per barrel in September 2012.

D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION

. Domestic production of sugar declined from 45,111 MT in June 2012 to 41,607 MT in July 2012. Production of soft drinks rose by 4.4 per cent from 22,073 MT in July 2012 to 23,045 MT in August 2012 while production of new assembled vehicles increased from 554 vehicles as recorded in July 2012 to 588 vehicles in August 2012.

The production of galvanized sheets went up by 1.3 per cent from 23,482 MT in July 2012 to 23,777 MT in August 2012. The quantity of cement produced declined by 2.1 per cent from 360,389 in August 2012 to 352,800 MT in September 2012. Consumption of cement rose by 1.1 per cent from 290,136 MT recorded in June 2012 to 293,290 MT in July 2012. Milk deliveries to the formal sector increased by 3.0 per cent from 43.5 million litres in July 2012 to 44.8 million litres in August 2012.

E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT

The number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Moi International Airports went up by 13.0 per cent from 112,030 persons recorded in July 2012 to 126,640 persons in August 2012. The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) increased by 1.5 per cent from 182,657 persons in July 2012 to 185,351 persons in August 2012, while passengers who landed increased marginally from 183,562 persons to 184,054 persons during the same period.

The total number of vehicles registered decreased from 22,577 vehicles in July 2012 to 16,970 vehicles in August 2012. Motor cycles remained the leading category of vehicles registered during the month of August 2012 accounting for 58.9 per cent of the total.

FIG. 1: INFLATION RATES

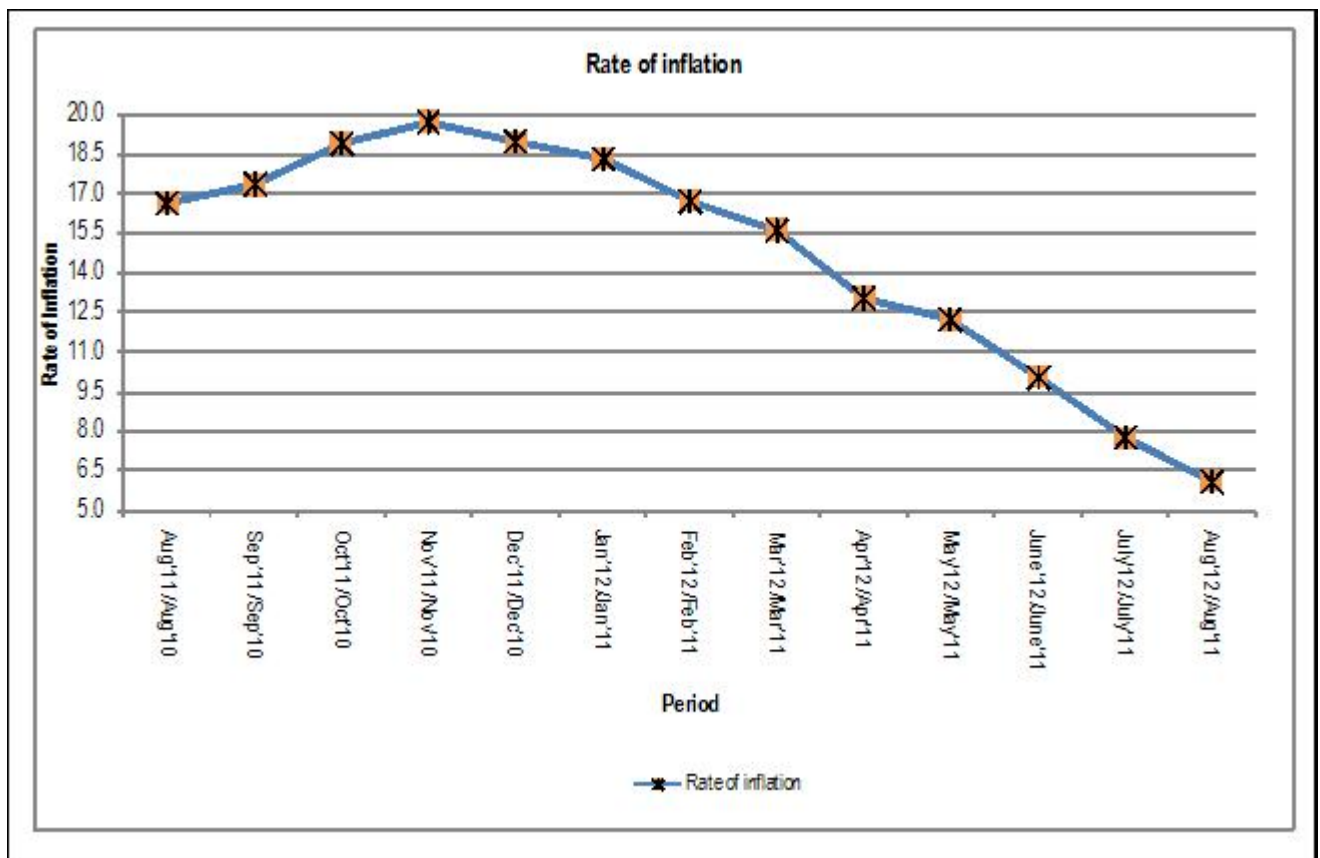

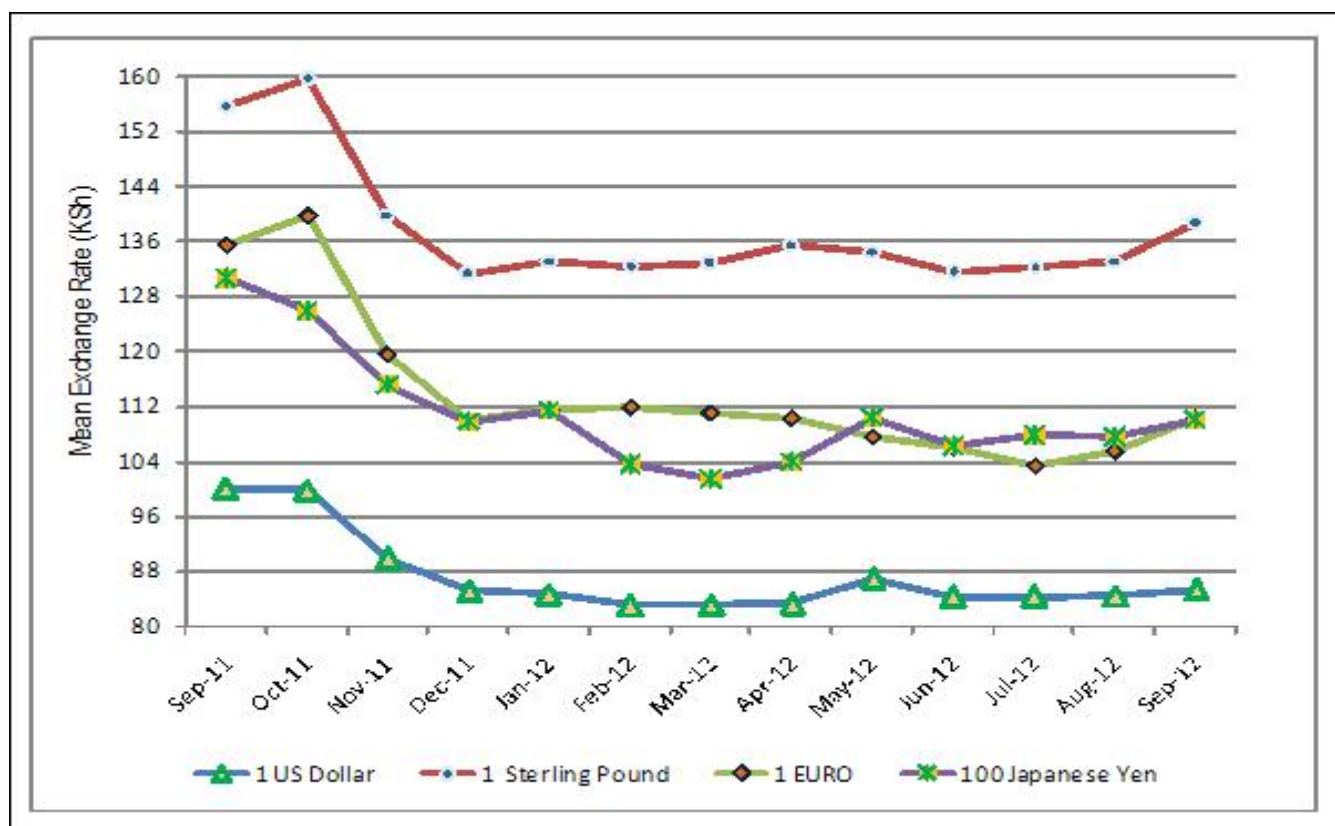

FIG 3: INTEREST RATES

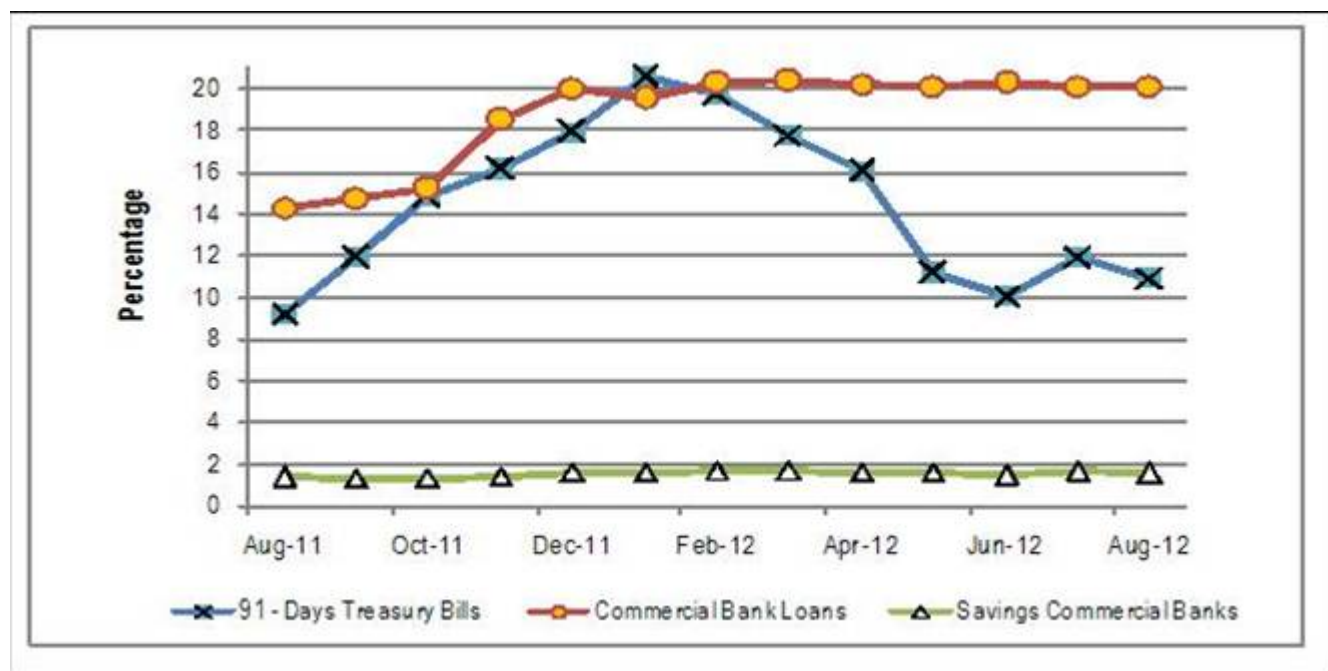

FIG 4: NAIROBI STOCK EXCHANGE SHARES INDEX

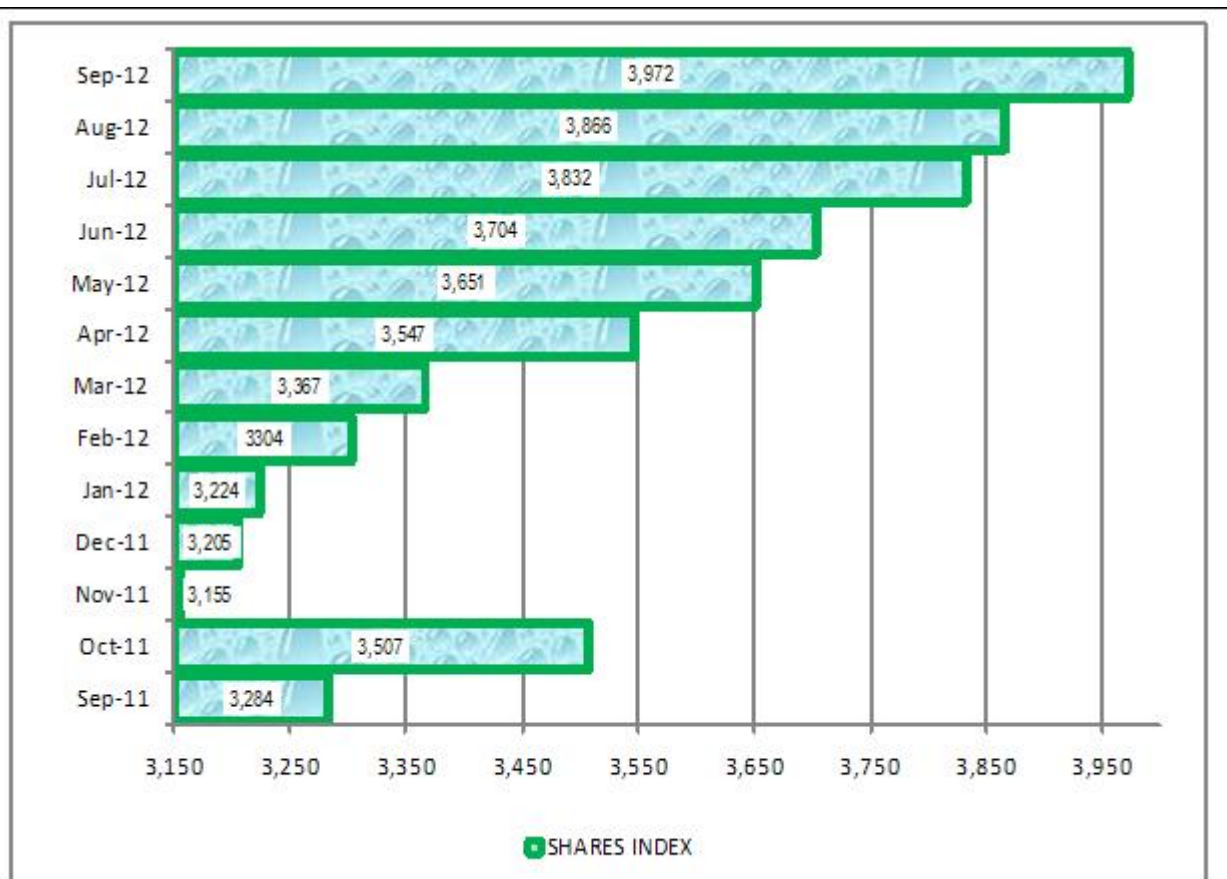

FIG 5: MONEY SUPPLY (M3)

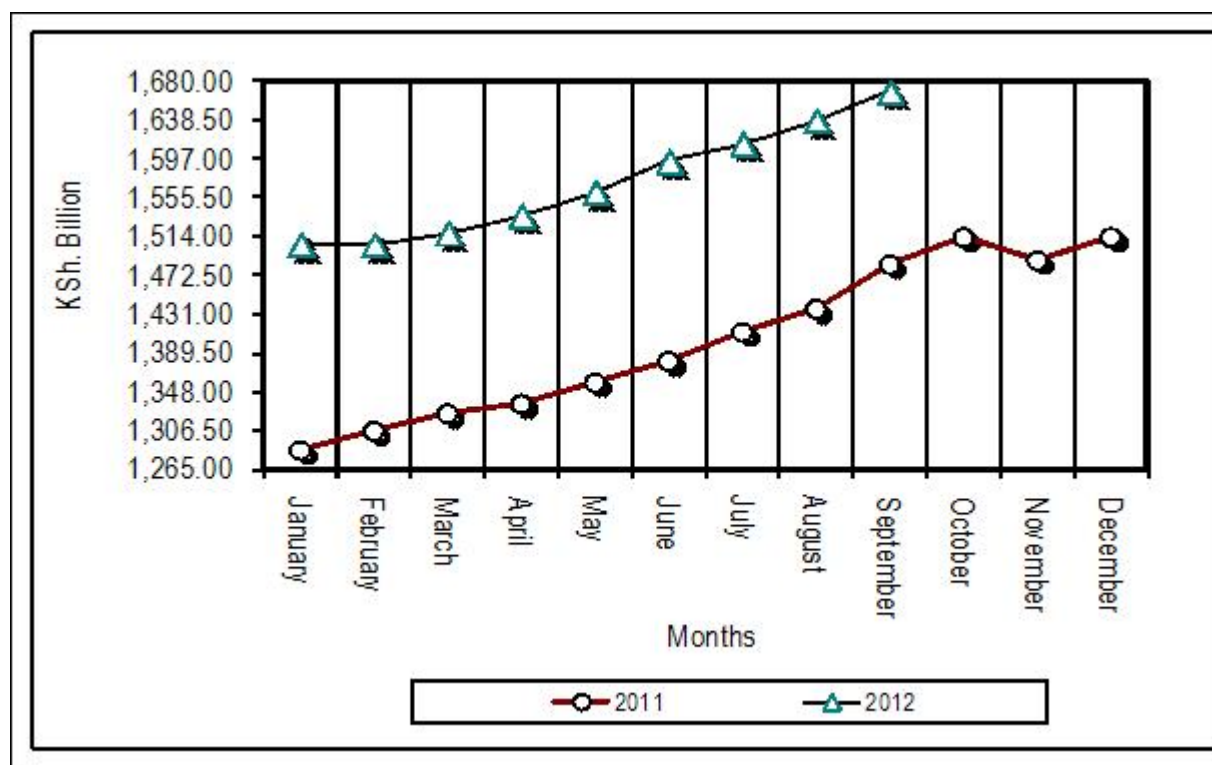

FIG 6: FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

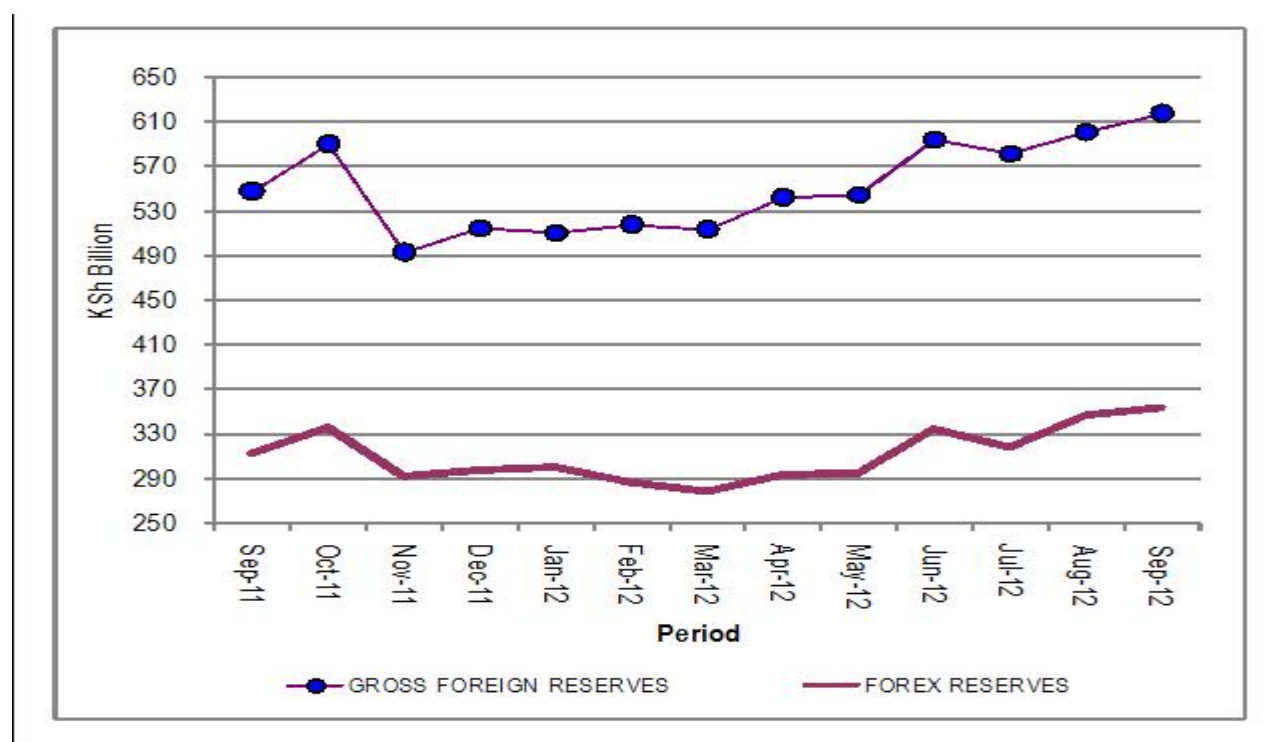

FIG.7: COFFEE SALES AT THE NAIROBI COFFEE EXCHANGE

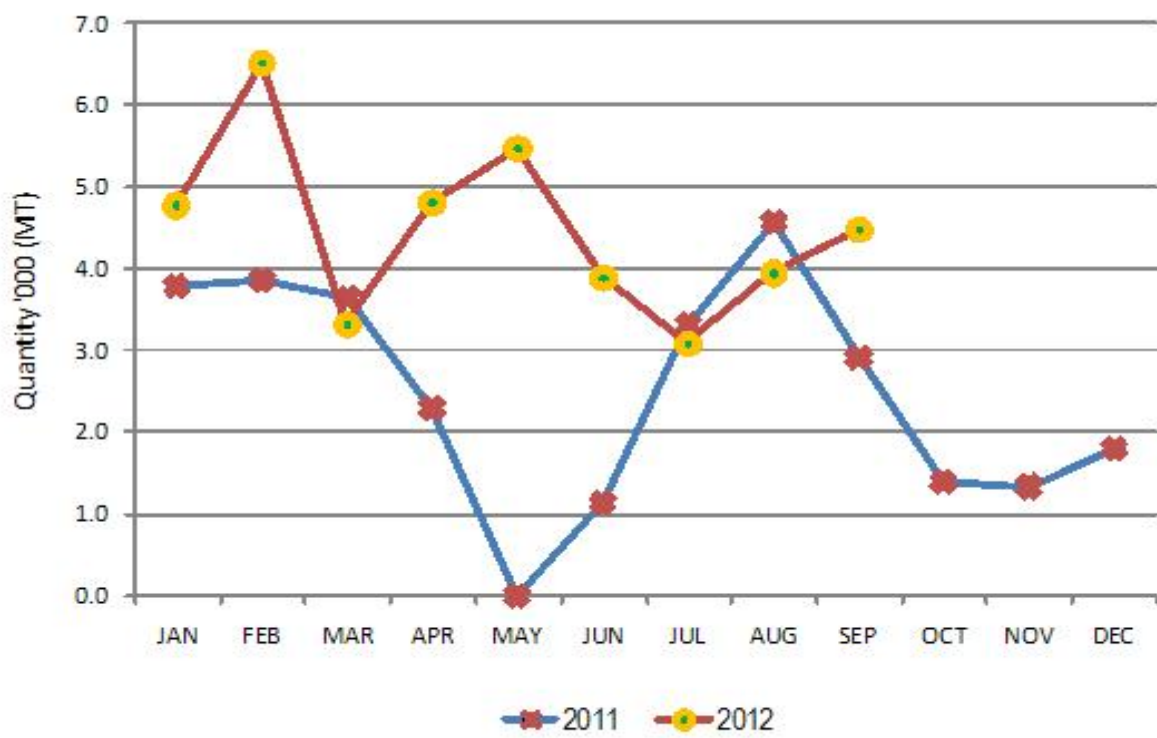

FIG.8: TEA PRODUCTION

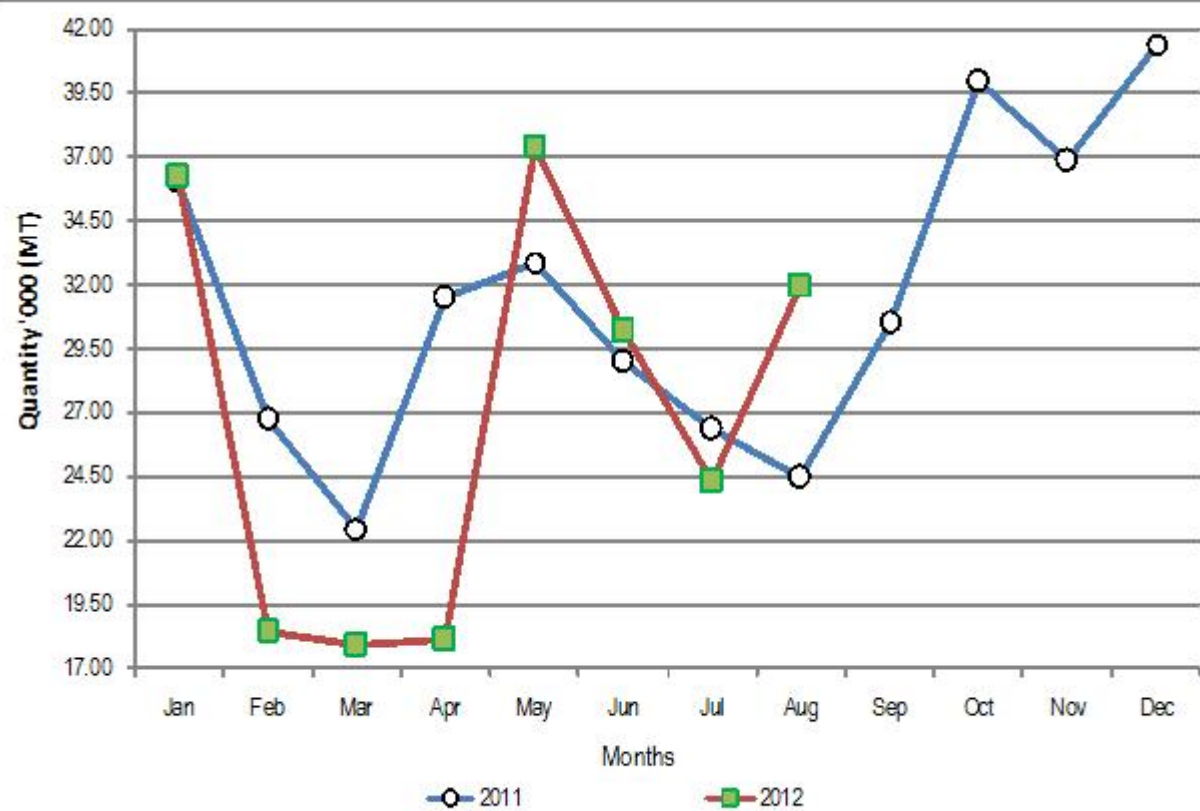

FIG.9: CANE DELIVERIES

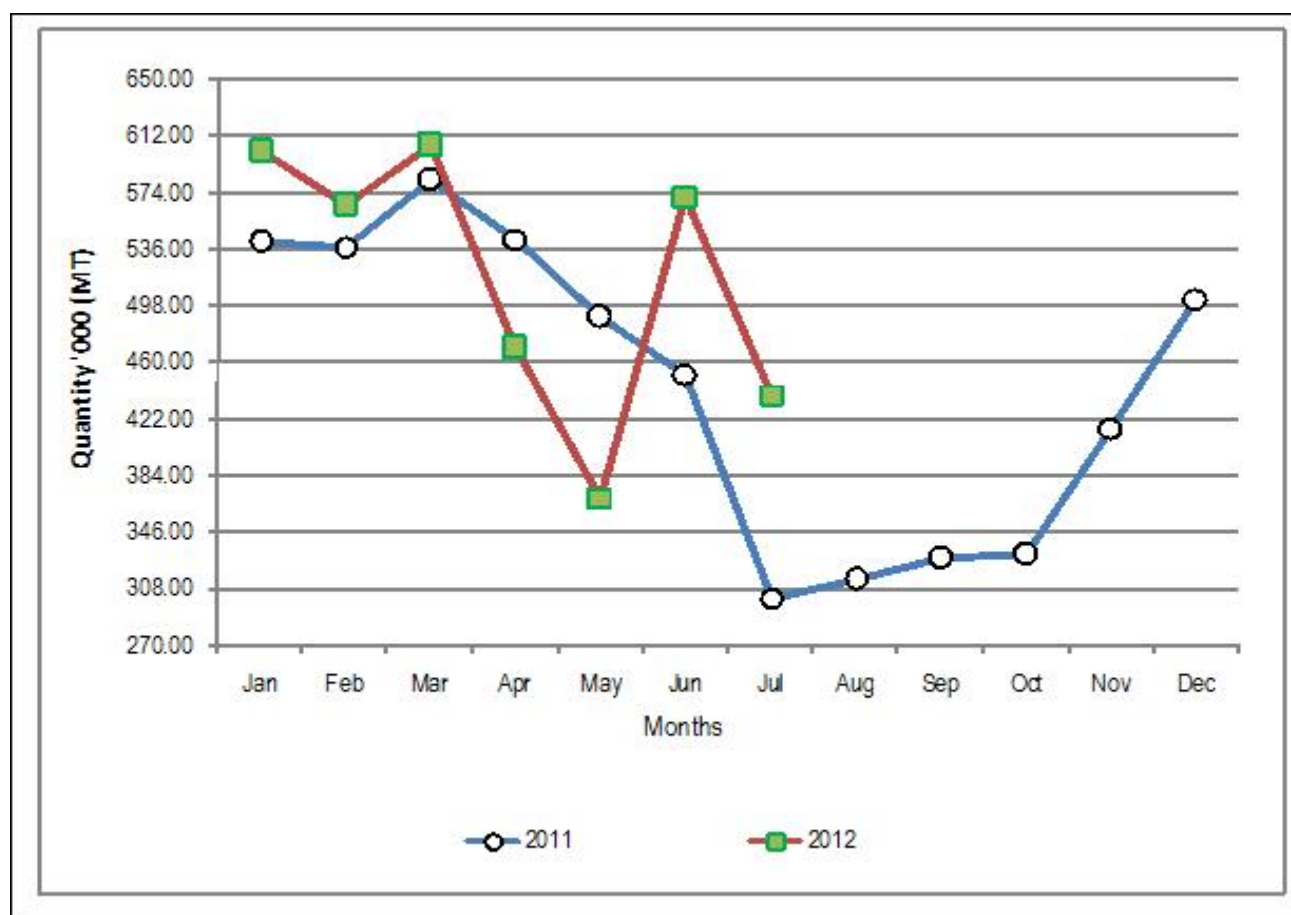

FIG 10: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE

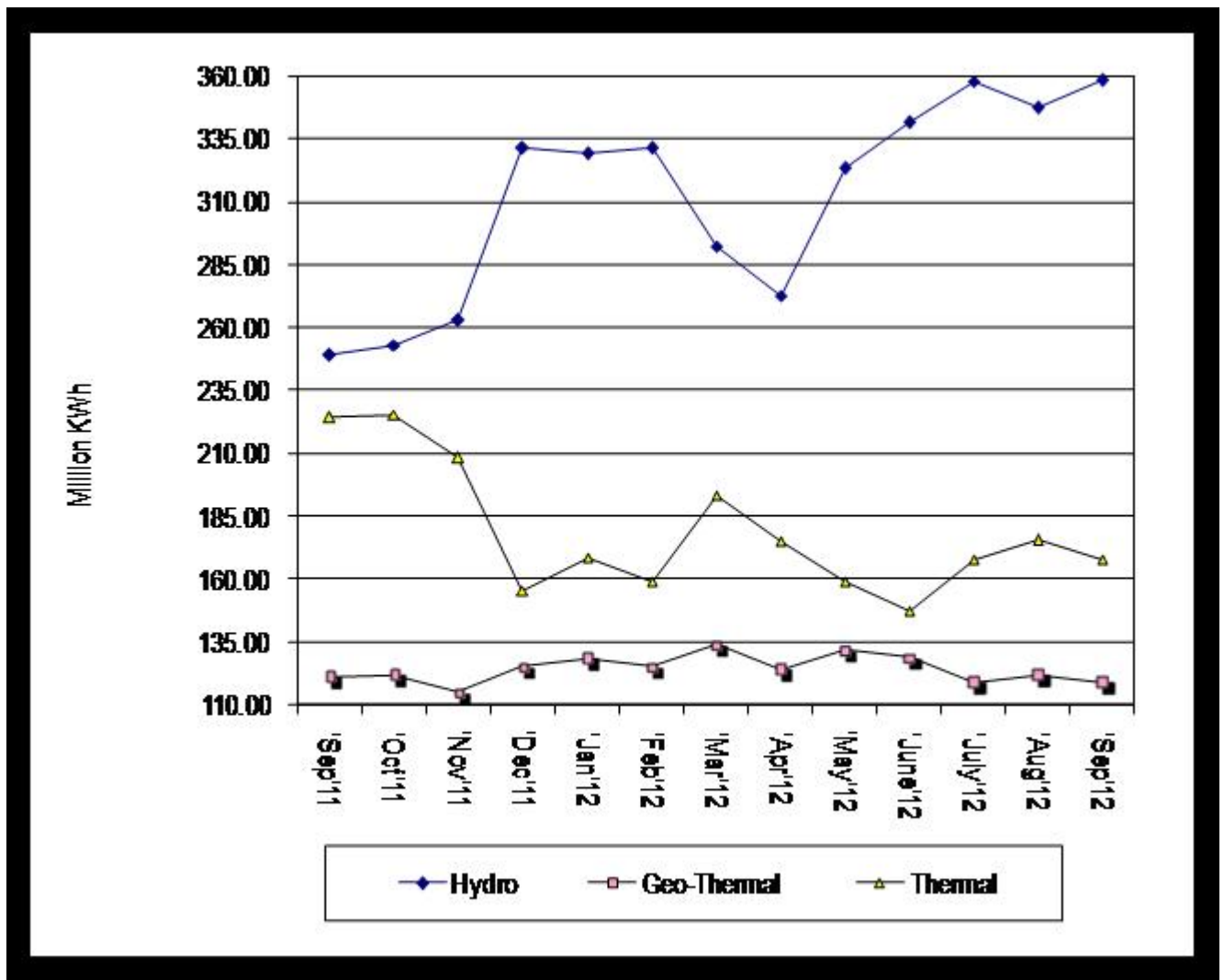

FIG 11: ELECTRICITY GENERATION, CONSUMPTION AND POWER LOSSES

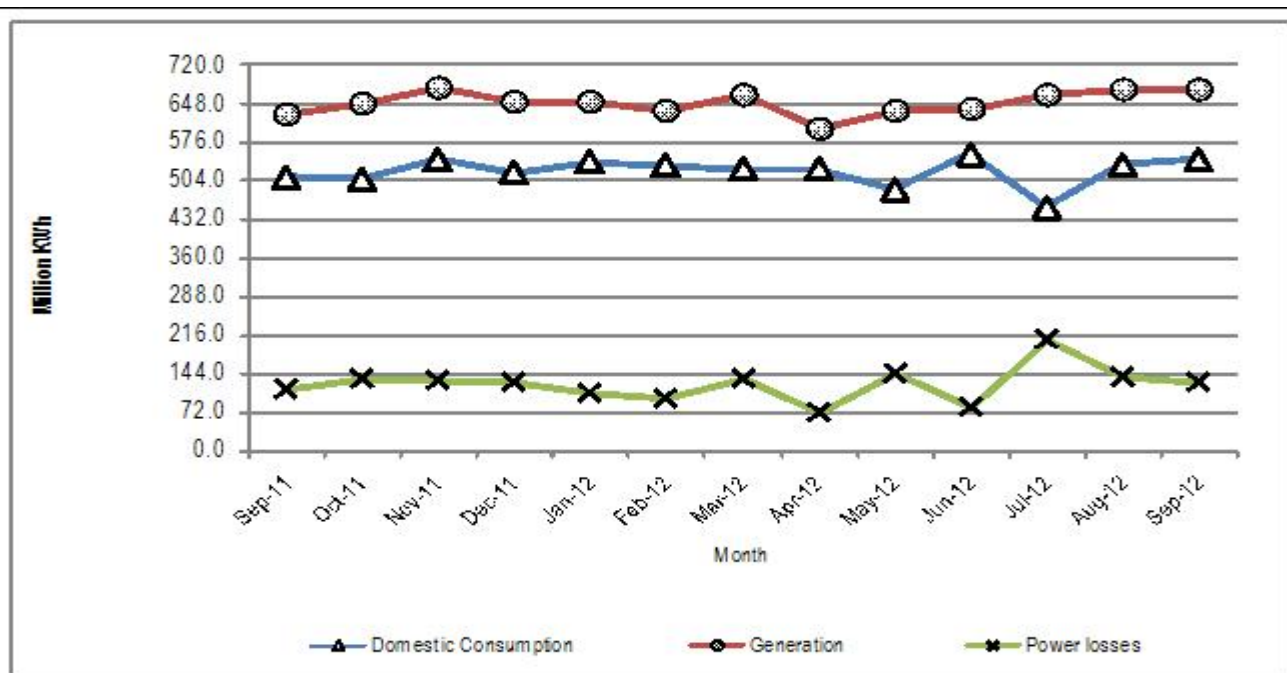

FIG 12(A): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

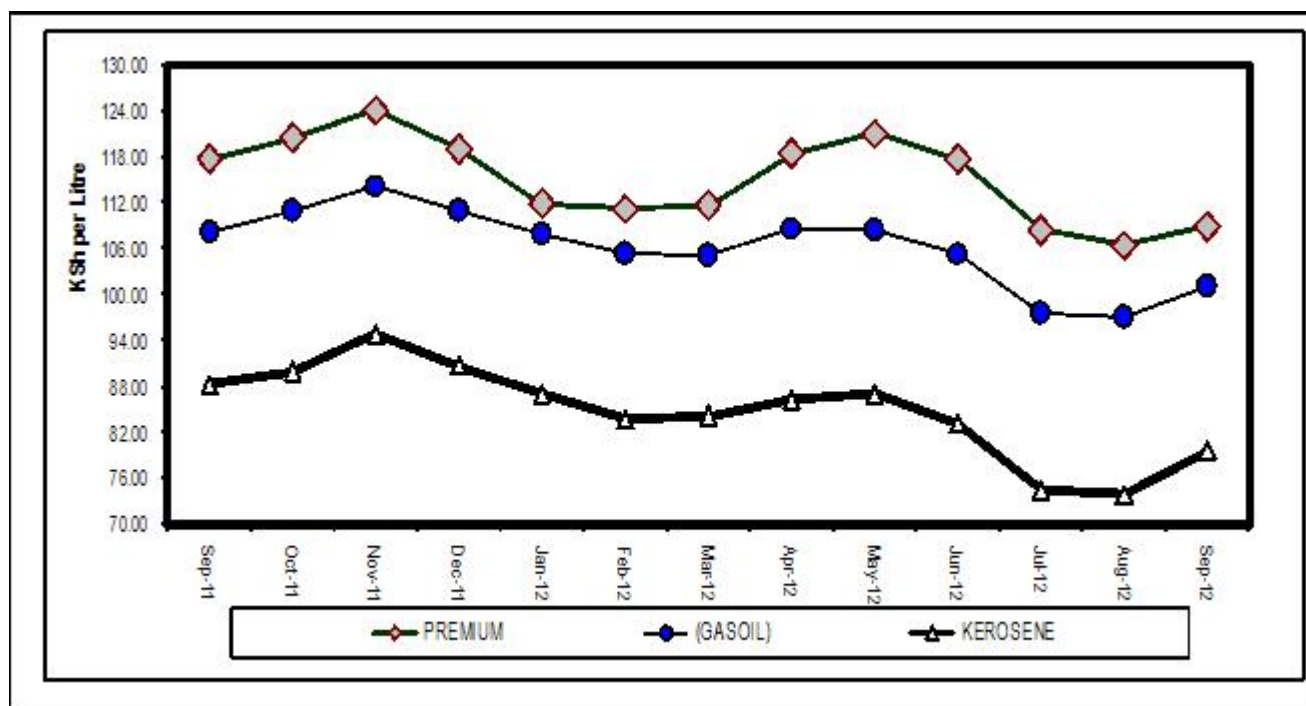

FIG 12(B): AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA

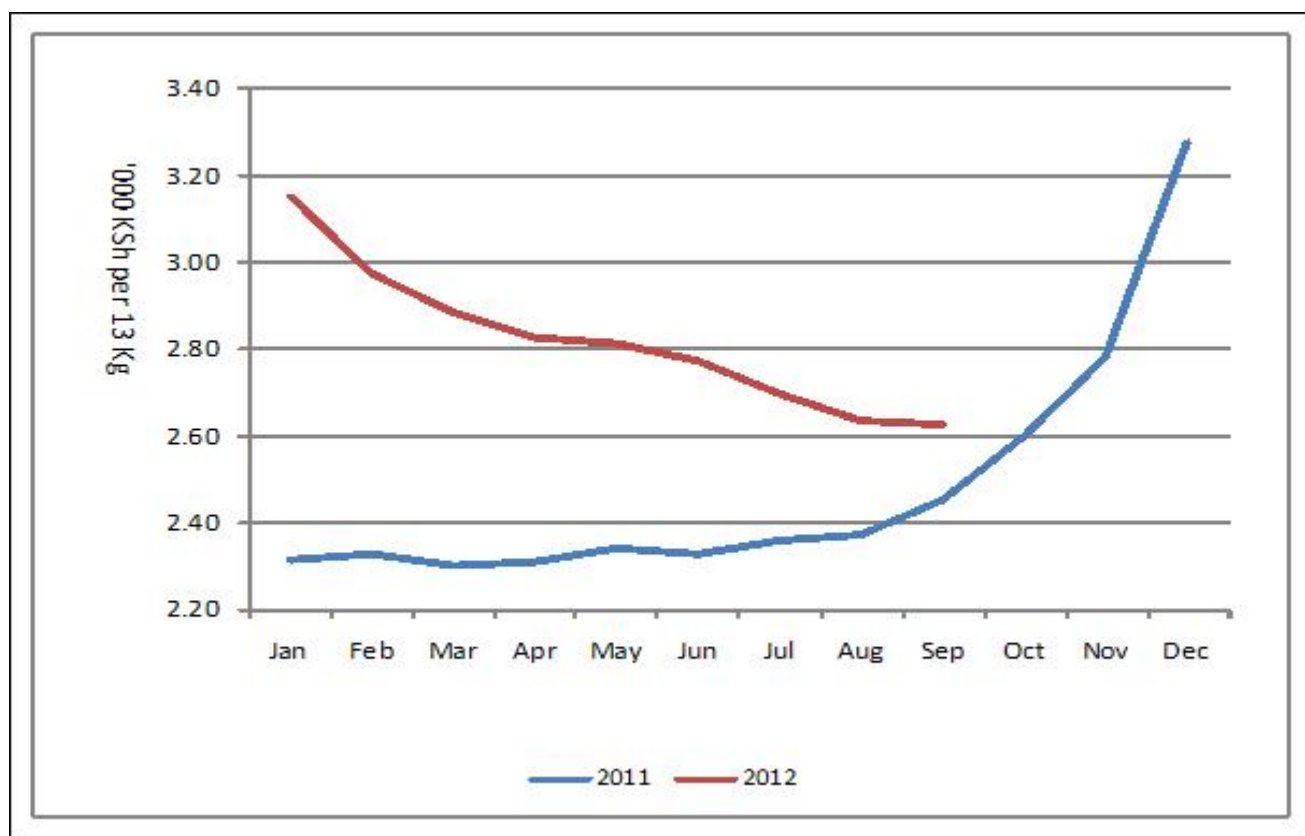

FIG 13: TRENDS FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES

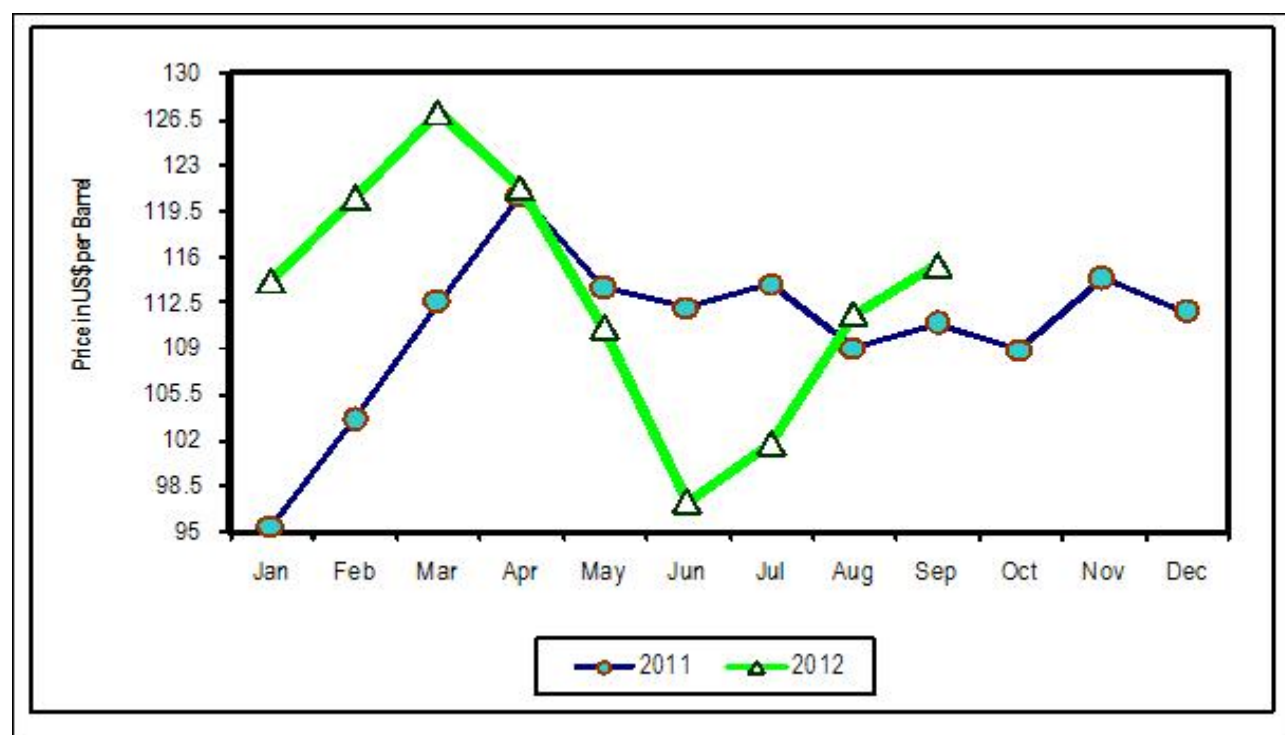

FIG 15: VISITORS ARRIVING IN KENYA THROUGH THE MAIN AIRPORTS

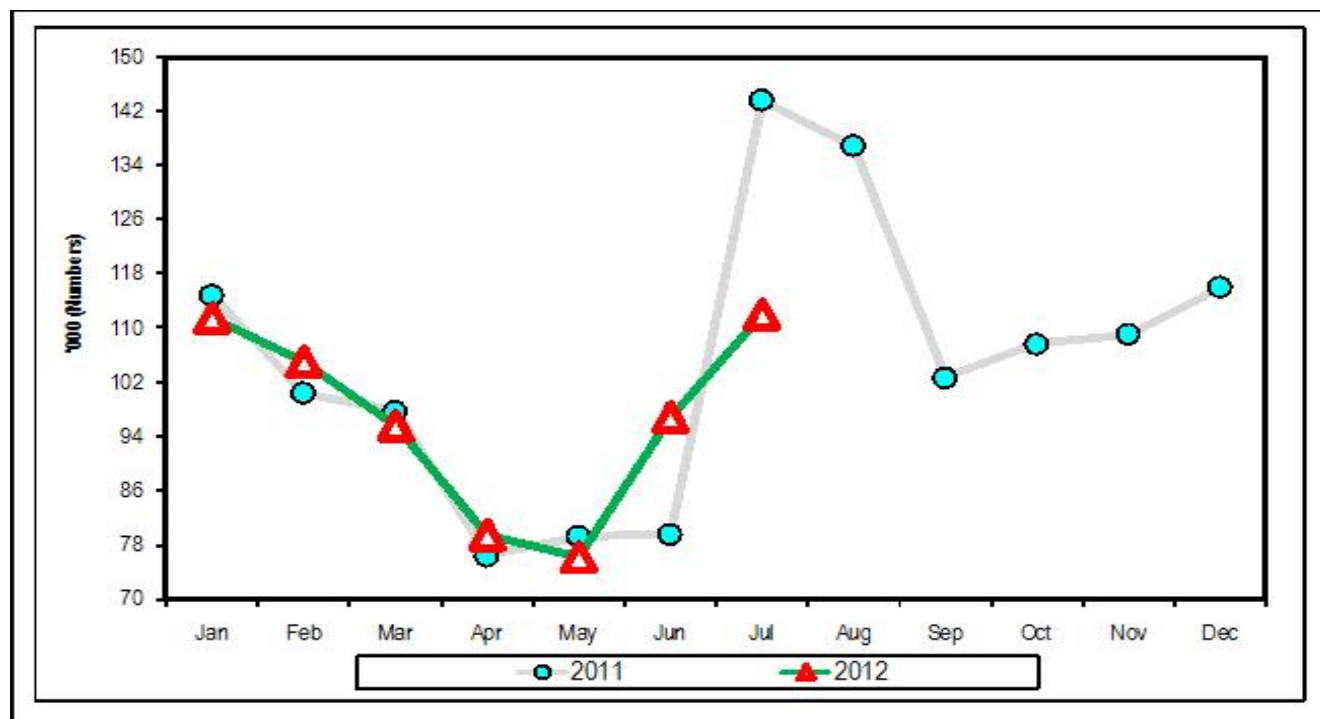

FIG 16: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF DESTINATION

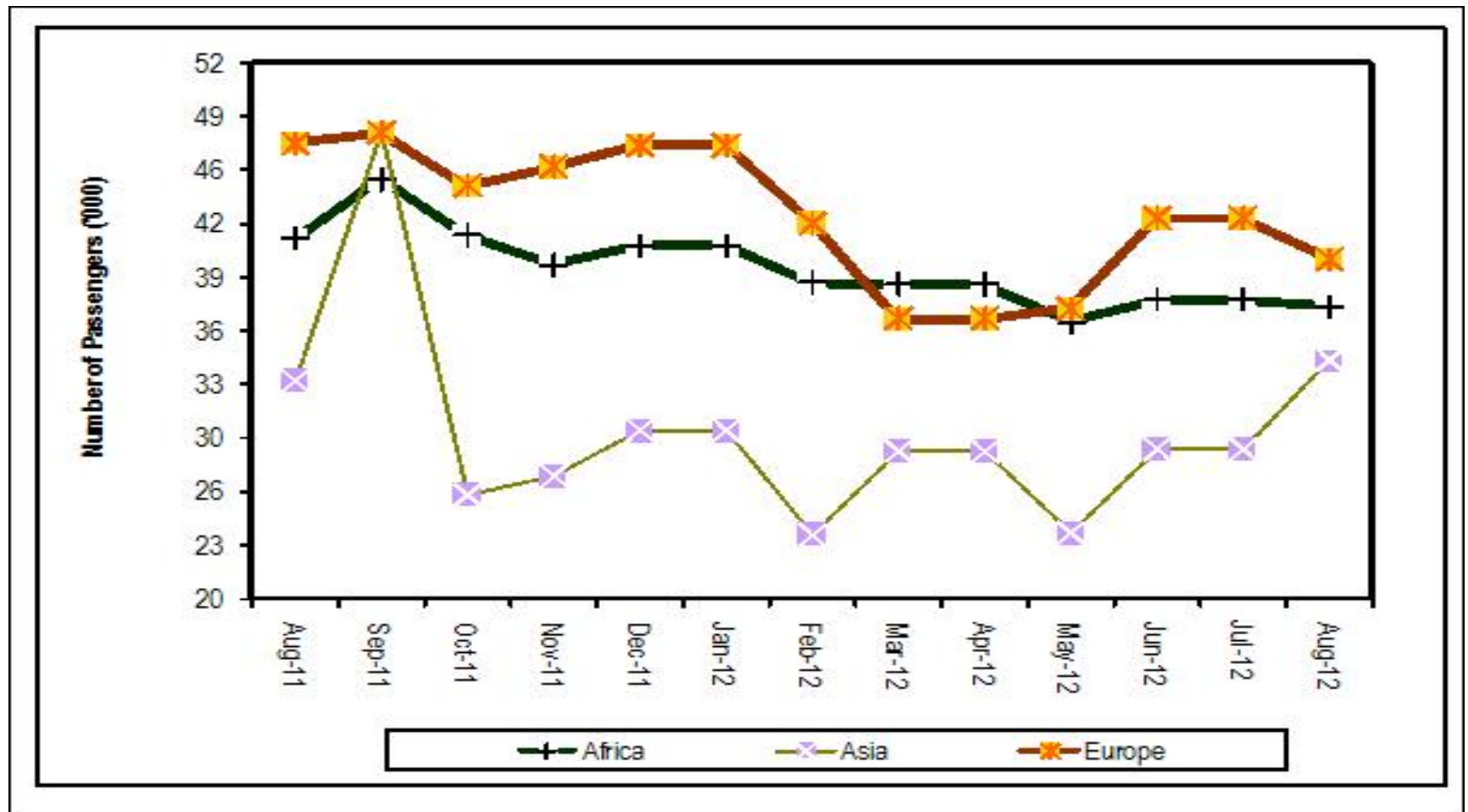

FIG 17: J.K.I.A. PASSENGERS BY REGION OF ORIGIN

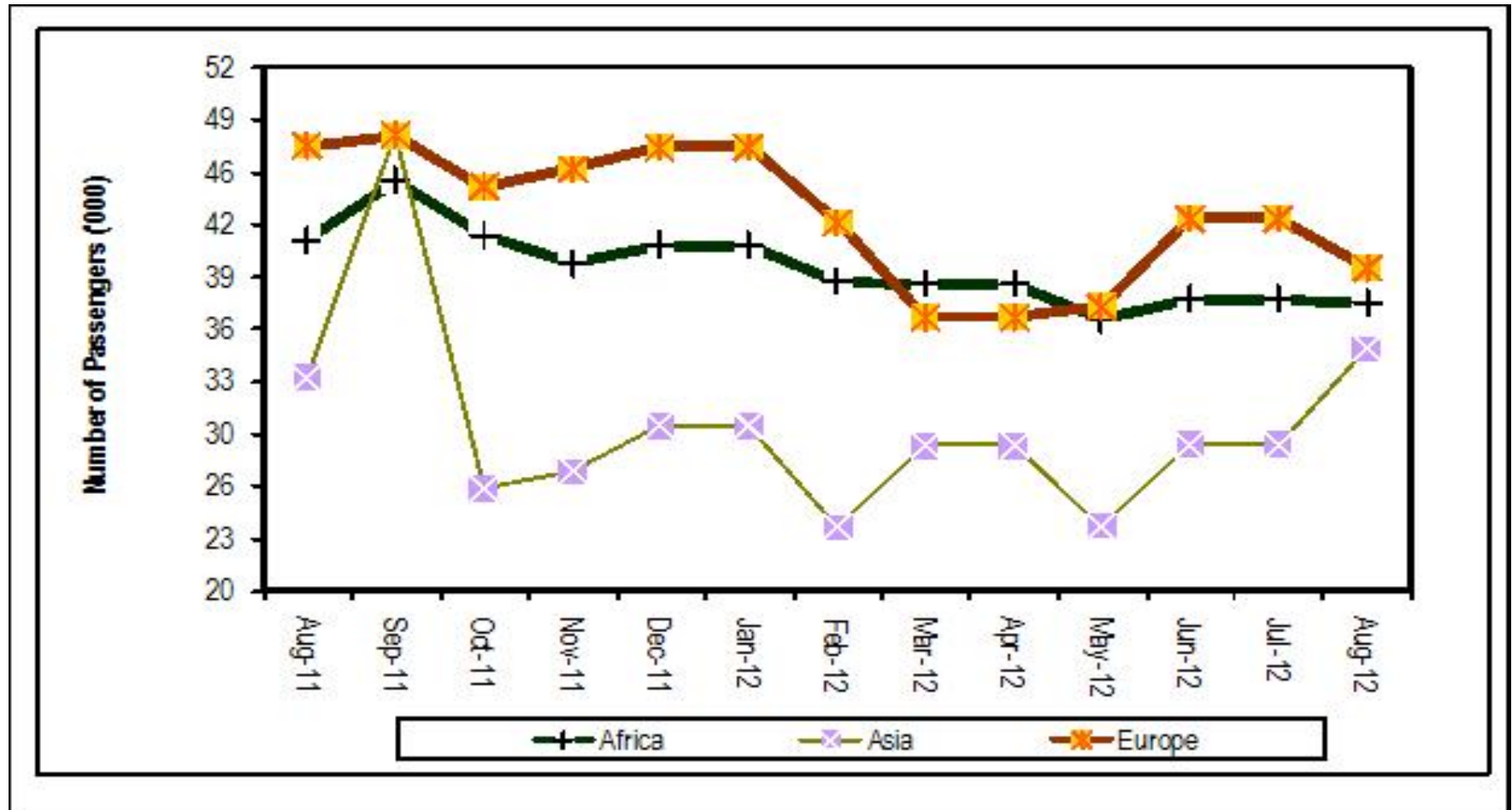
