## CONSUMER PRICE INDICES AND INFLATION RATES FOR NOVEMBER 2014

Kenya National Bureau of Statistics hereby releases Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation rates for November 2014. These numbers have been generated using data collected during the second and third weeks of the month under review. The prices were obtained from selected retail outlets in 25 data collection zones located in 13 urban centers.

As shown in Tables 1 and 2, the CPI decreased by 0.05 per cent from 151.92 in September to 151.85 in November 2014. The overall inflation rate stood at 6.09 per cent in November 2014.

Between October and November 2014, Food and Non-Alcoholic Drinks' Index decreased by 0.18 per cent. The decline in food inflation resulted from observed falls in the prices of several food commodities which outweighed notable rises in the prices of others as indicated in Table 3.

Over the same period, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' Index, decreased by 0.34 per cent. This was mainly attributed to falls in the cost electricity and kerosene. For instance, consumption of 50KWh of electricity declined by 11.56 per cent from KSh 627.10 in October to KSh 554.60 in November 2014.

During the same review period, the Transport Index decreased by 0.57 per cent mainly due to reduction of pump prices of petrol and diesel in November 2014 compared to October 2014.
