CONSUMER PRICE INDICES AND INFLATION RATES FOR SEPTEMBER 2014

Kenya National Bureau of Statistics hereby releases Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation rates for September 2014. These numbers have been generated using data collected during the second and third weeks of the month under review. The prices were obtained from selected retail outlets in 25 data collection zones located in 13 urban centers.

As shown in Tables 1 and 2, the CPI increased by 0.15 per cent from 152.02 in August to 152.24 in September 2014. The overall inflation rate stood at 6.60 per cent in September 2014.

Between August and September 2014, Food and Non-Alcoholic Drinks' Index increased by 0.58 per cent. The aggregate rise resulted from observed increases in the prices of several food commodities outweighing notable falls in the prices of others as shown in Table 3.

Over the same period, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' Index, decreased by 0.52 per cent. This decline was attributed to notable falls in the cost of kerosene and electricity. Electricity prices were lower in September 2014 compared with August 2014 due to reduction in fuel cost and forex adjustment charges.

During the same review period, the Transport Index decreased by 0.41 per cent mainly due to reduction of pump prices of petrol and diesel in September 2014 compared to August 2014.
