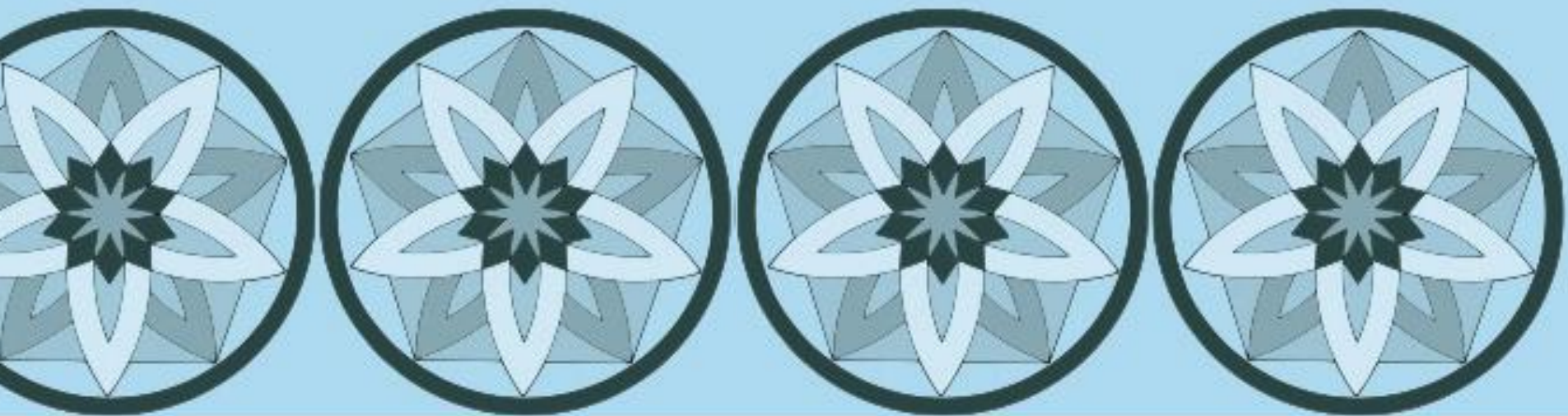

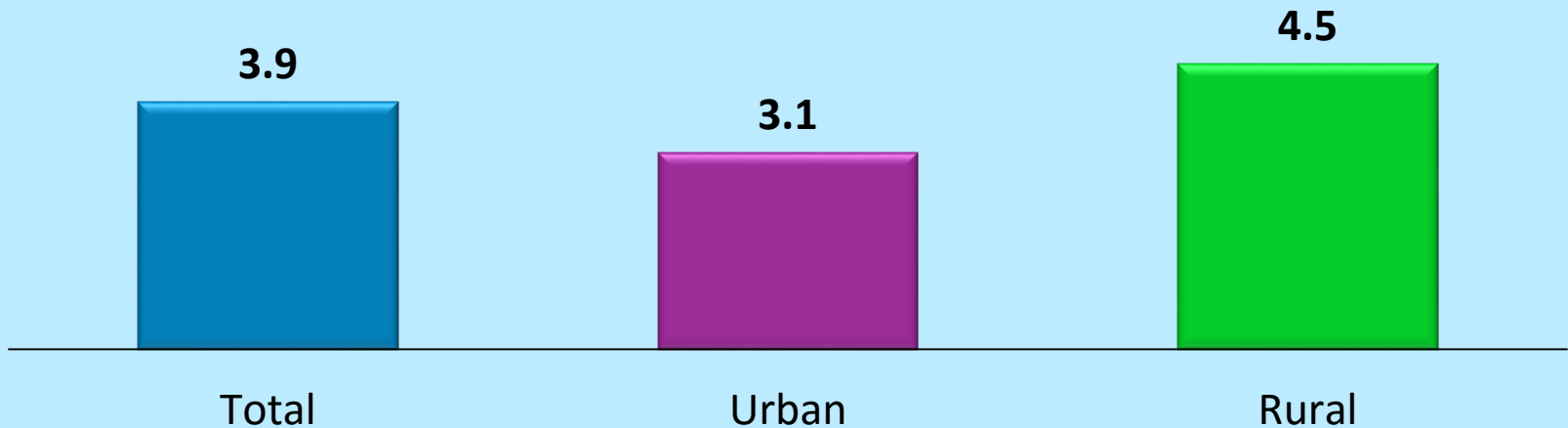

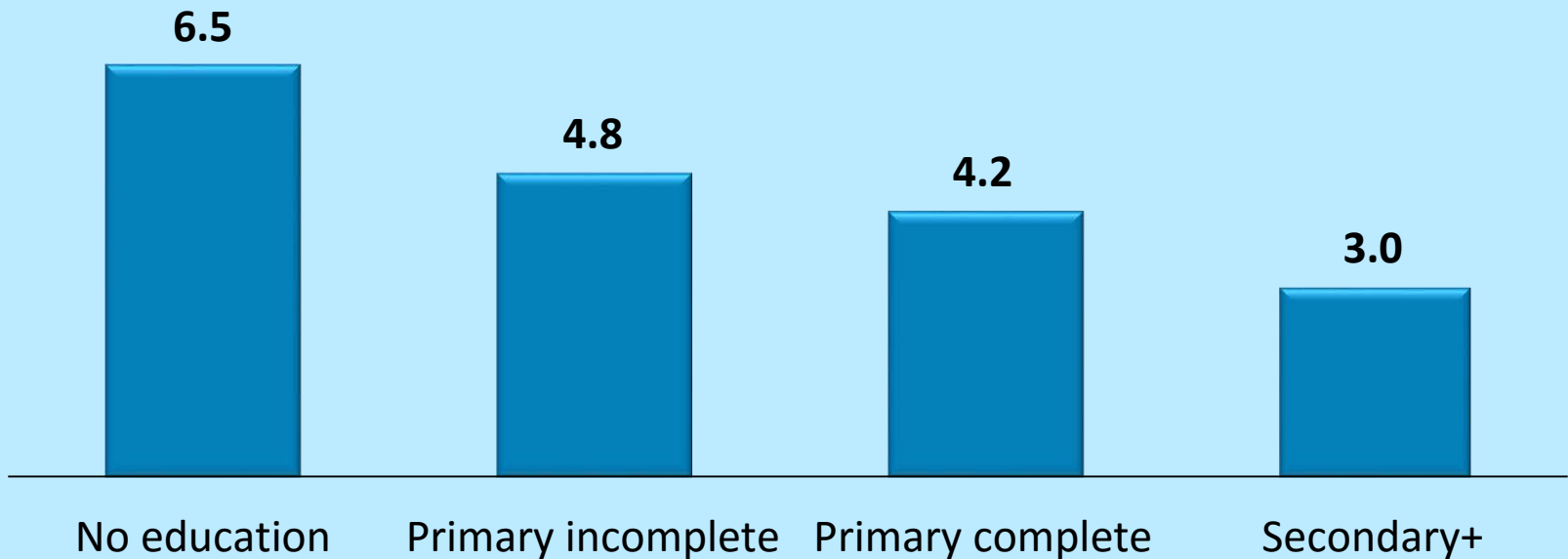
Fertility Differentials

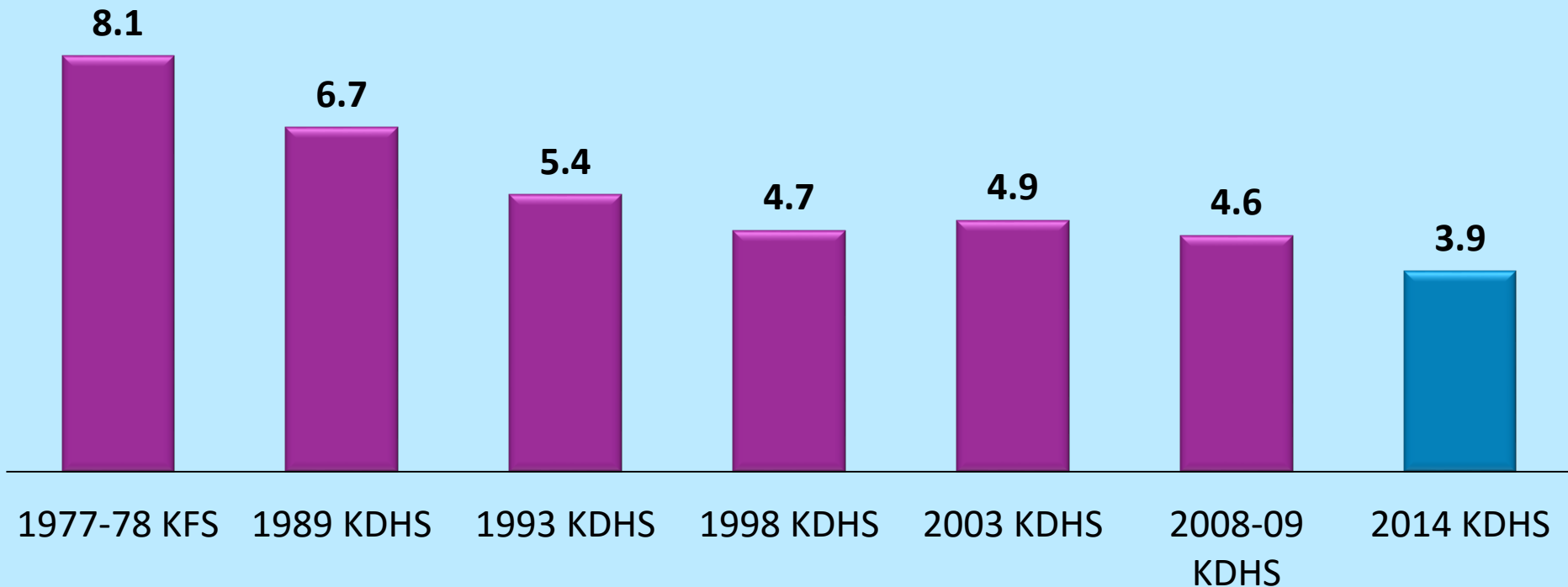

Births per woman for the three-year period before the survey



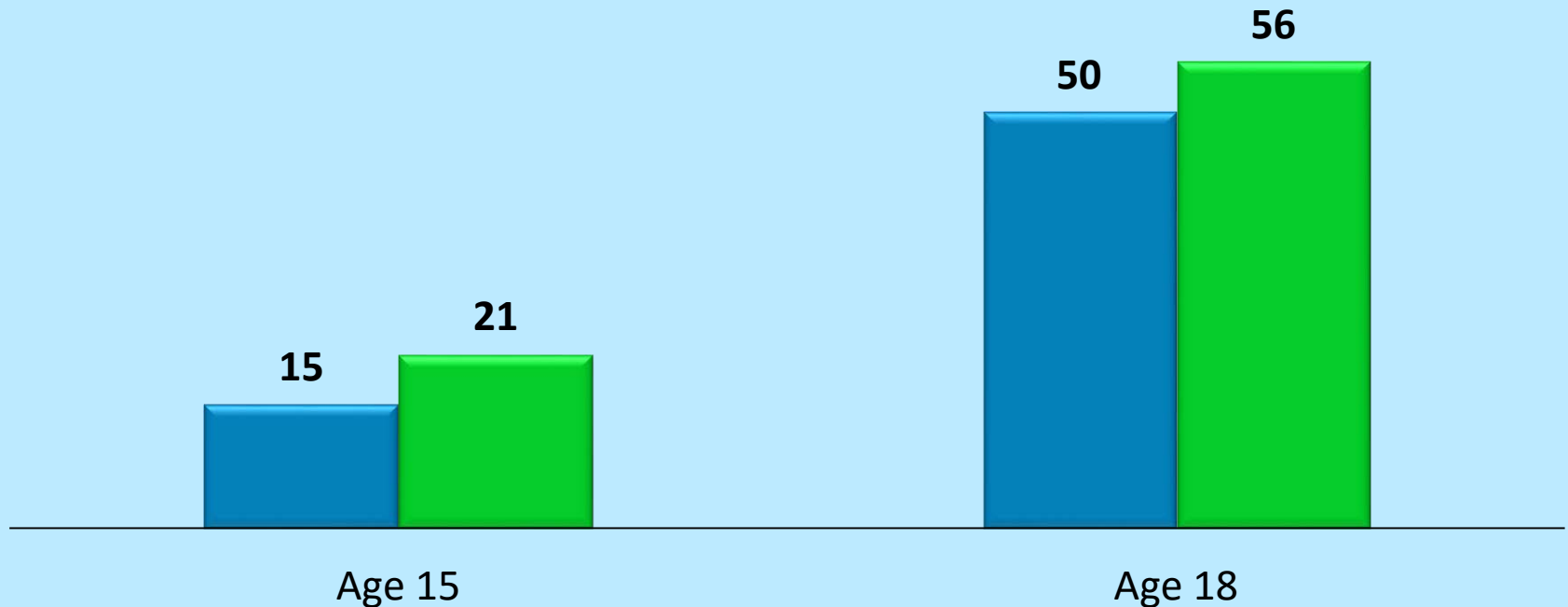
Teenage Childbearing

Age at First Sexual Intercourse

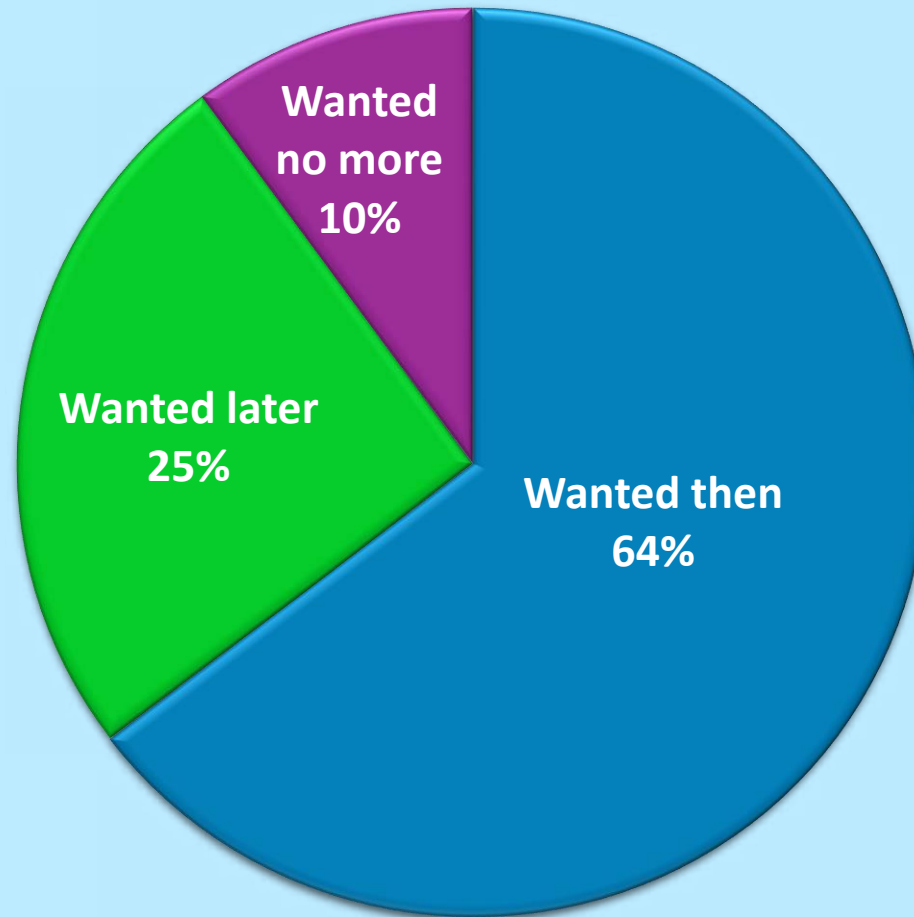
Percent of women and men age 25-49 who had sexual intercourse by:

■ Women ■ Men

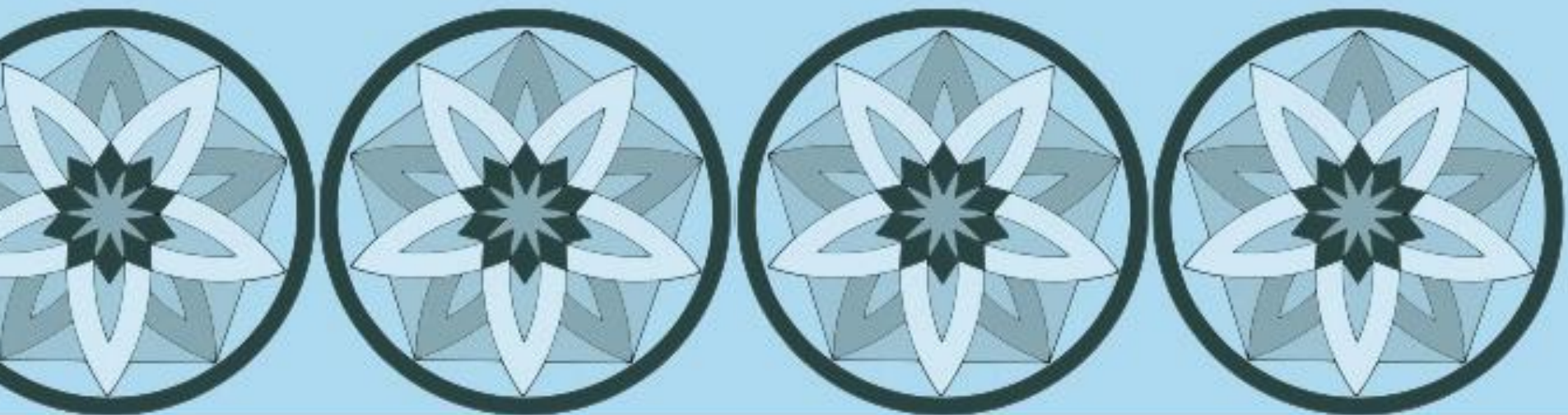


Birth Planning

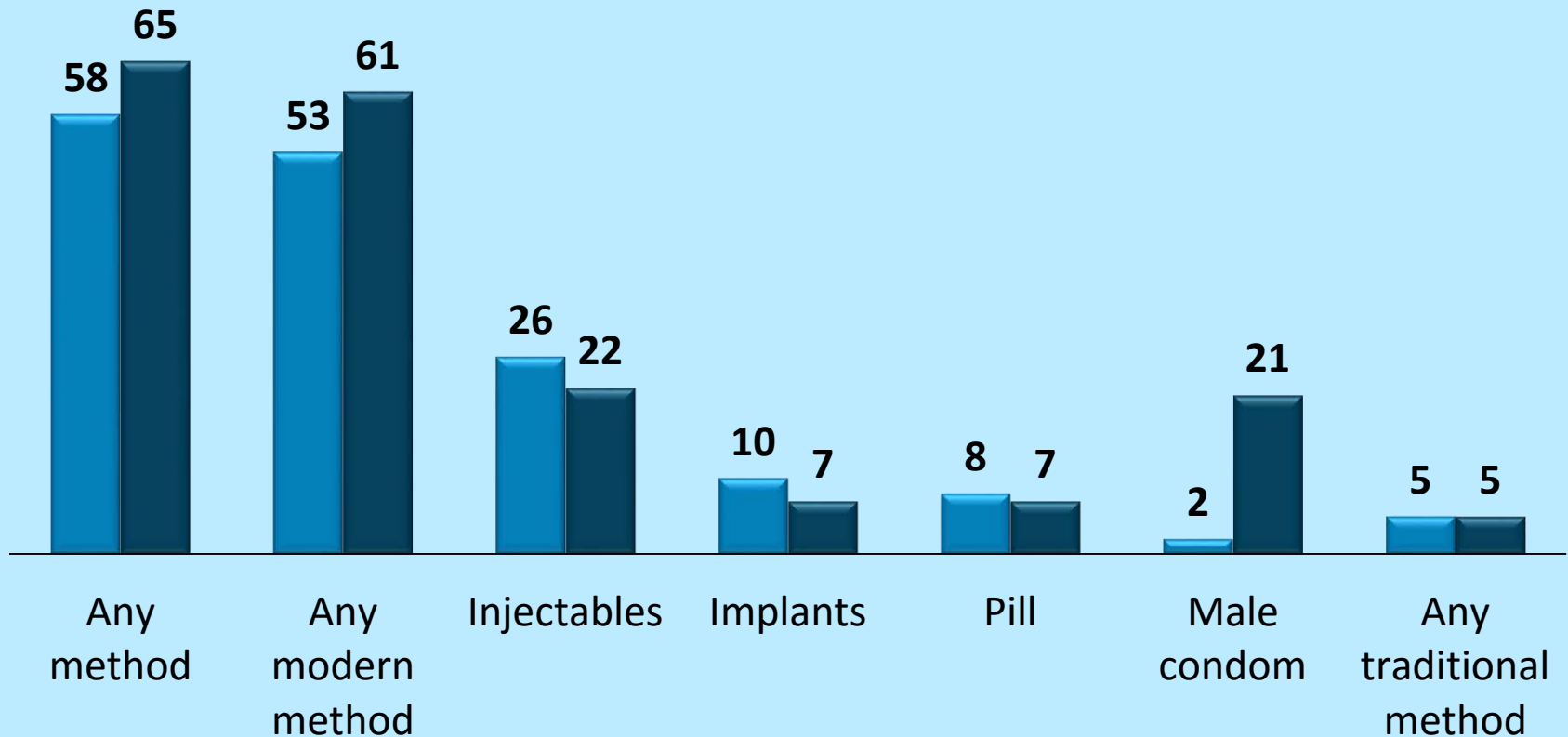

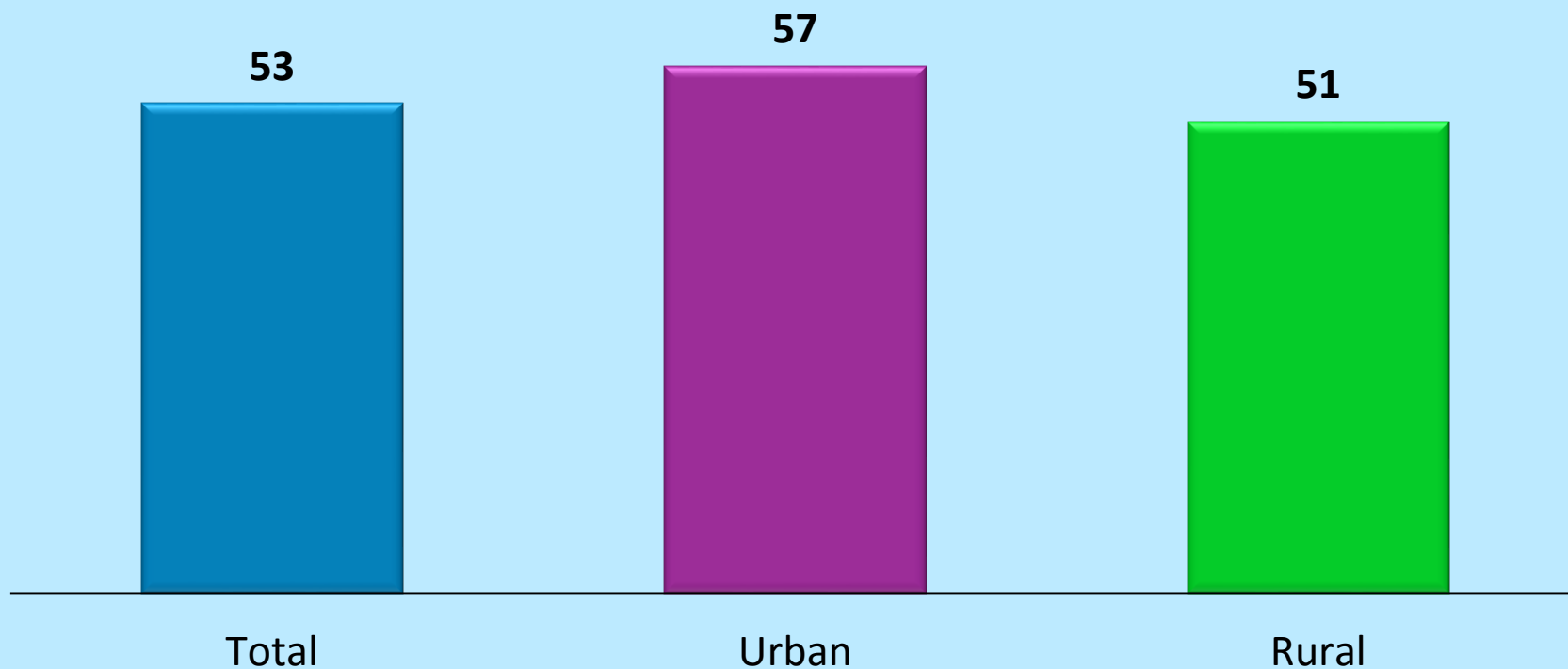
Percent of women age 15-49

■ Currently married women ■ Sexually active, unmarried women



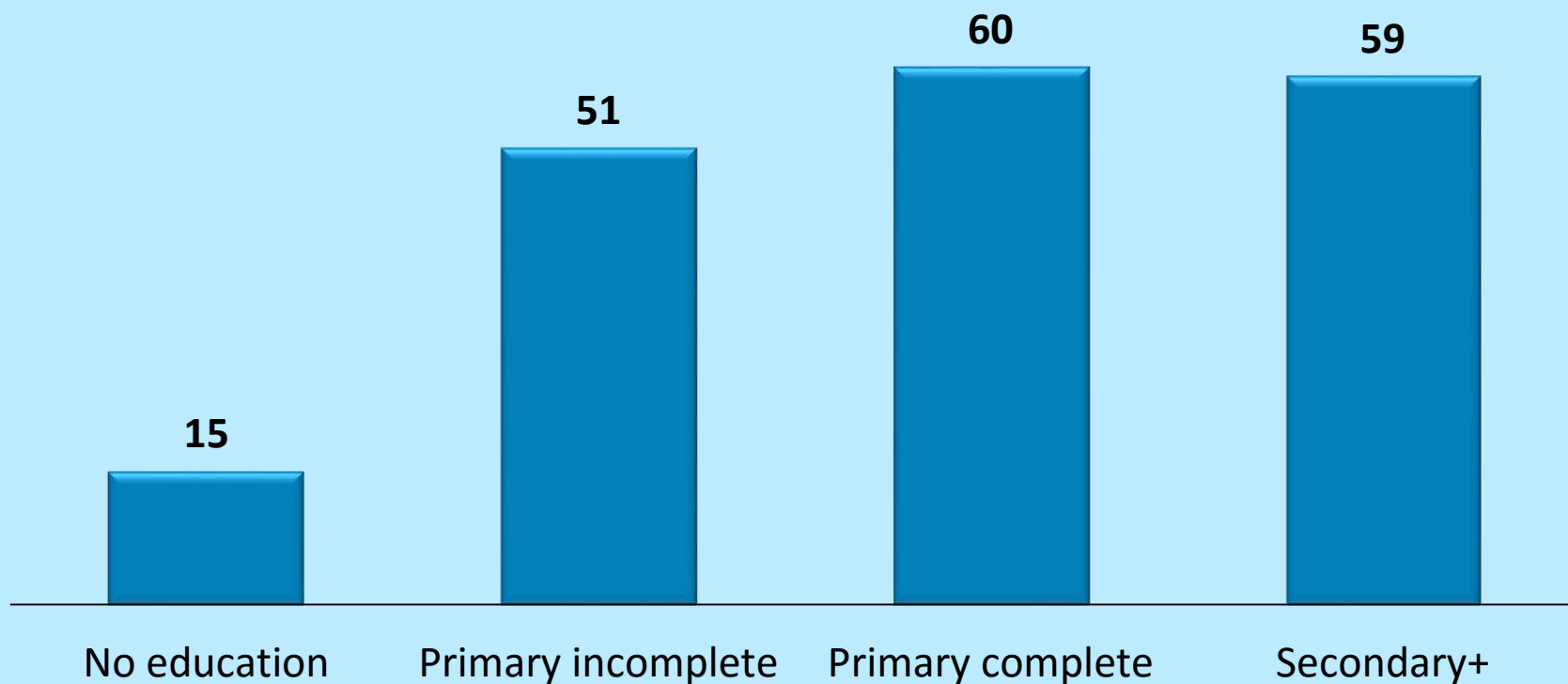
Current Use of Modern Contraception by Residence

Current Use of Modern Contraception by County

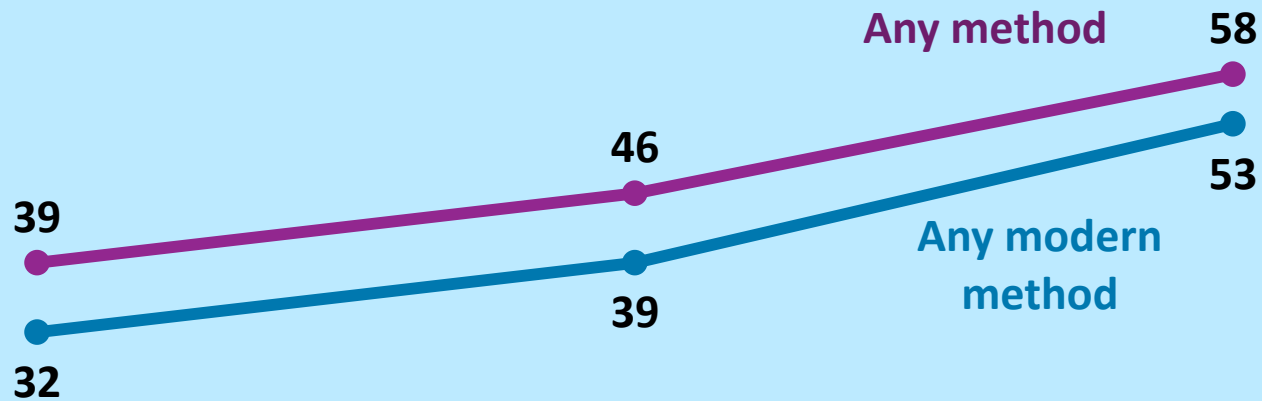

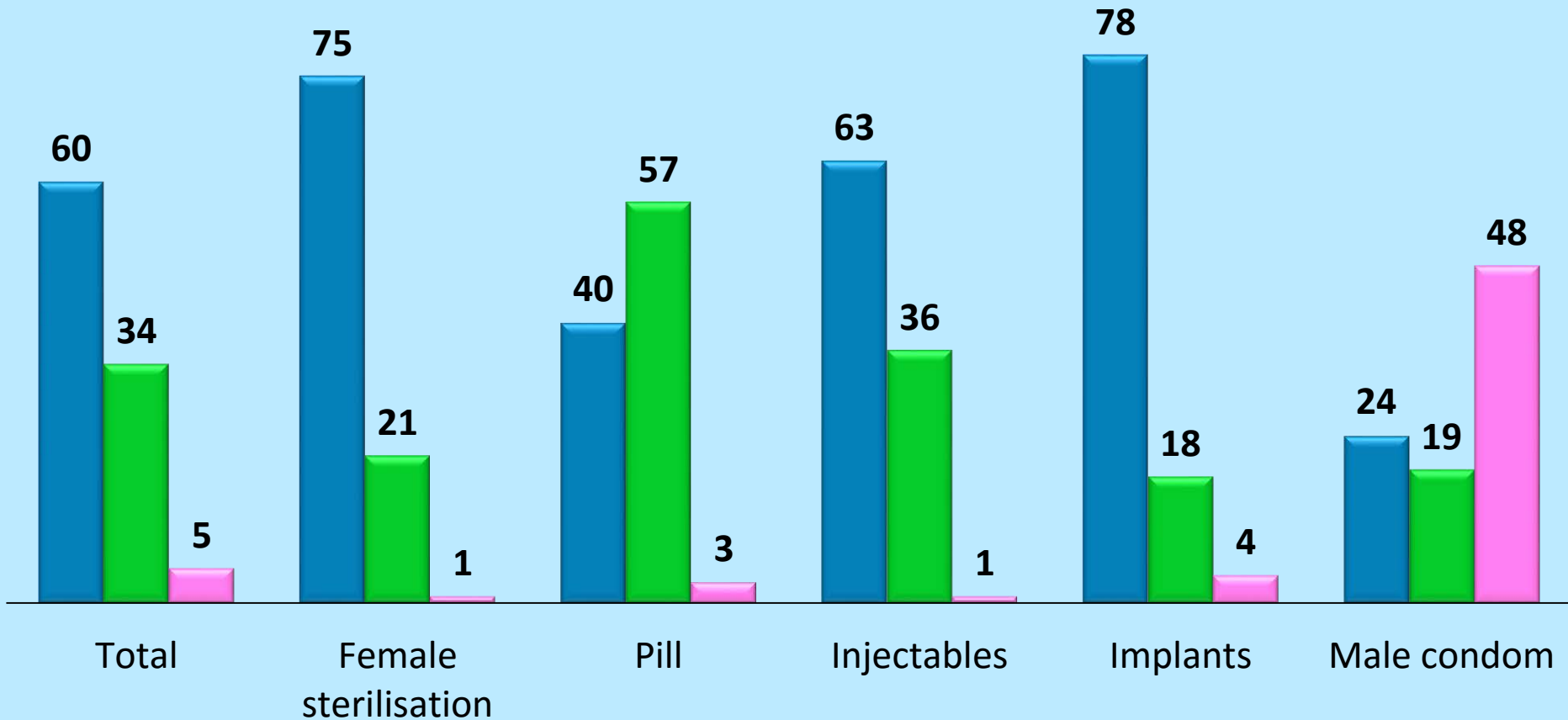

OR

to limit childbearing altogether

BUT

are not using contraception

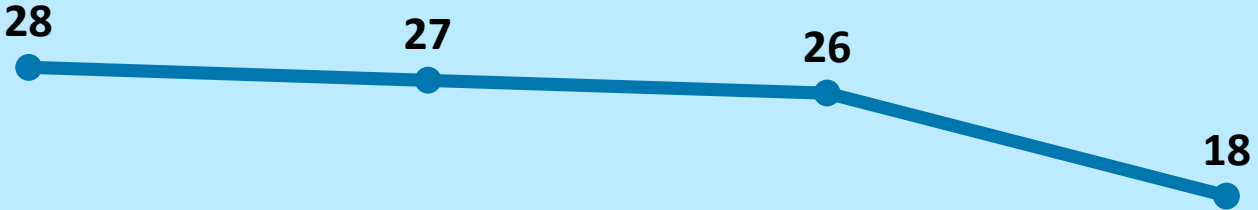
Unmet Need

18% of currently married women have an **unmet need for family planning:**

- **9% for spacing**
- **8% for limiting**

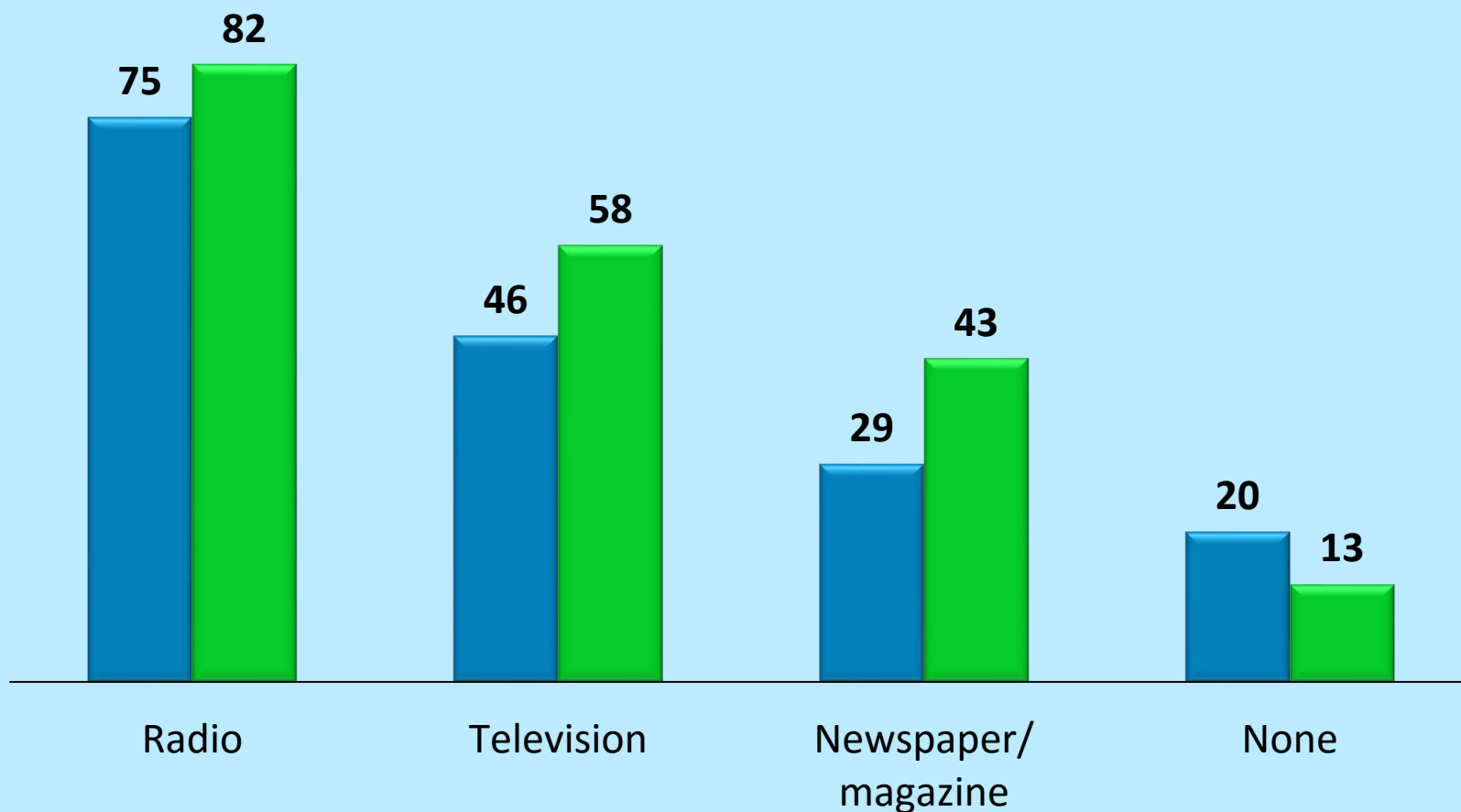

Source of Family Planning Messages

Percent of women and men age 15-49 who heard or saw a message about family planning in the past few months

■ Women ■ Men



Contact of Non-Users with Family Planning Providers

- **6%** of women were **visited by a field worker** who discussed family planning
- **14%** of women who visited a health facility in the past 12 months **discussed family planning with a health care provider**
- Overall, **82%** of non-users **did not discuss family planning** with any health worker in the 12 months before the survey
