

The Africa Natural Accounting Policy Forum



Kenya National Bureau of Statistics in collaboration with the **World Bank's Global Program on Sustainability (GPS)** and **United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD)** is co-hosting the **Africa Natural Accounting Policy Forum** from **September 6-7, 2023**. The event is being held at Radisson Blu Hotel, Upper Hill, Nairobi.

The Africa Natural Accounting Policy Forum aims to provide participants with a platform to discuss the use of natural capital approaches, including natural capital accounting (NCA), and the challenges and opportunities in using natural capital data, tools and analysis to inform and support policies in African countries. The Forum will foster dialogue and sharing of experiences on using NCA and related data and analysis to address policy issues like climate change, biodiversity, and nature protection.
