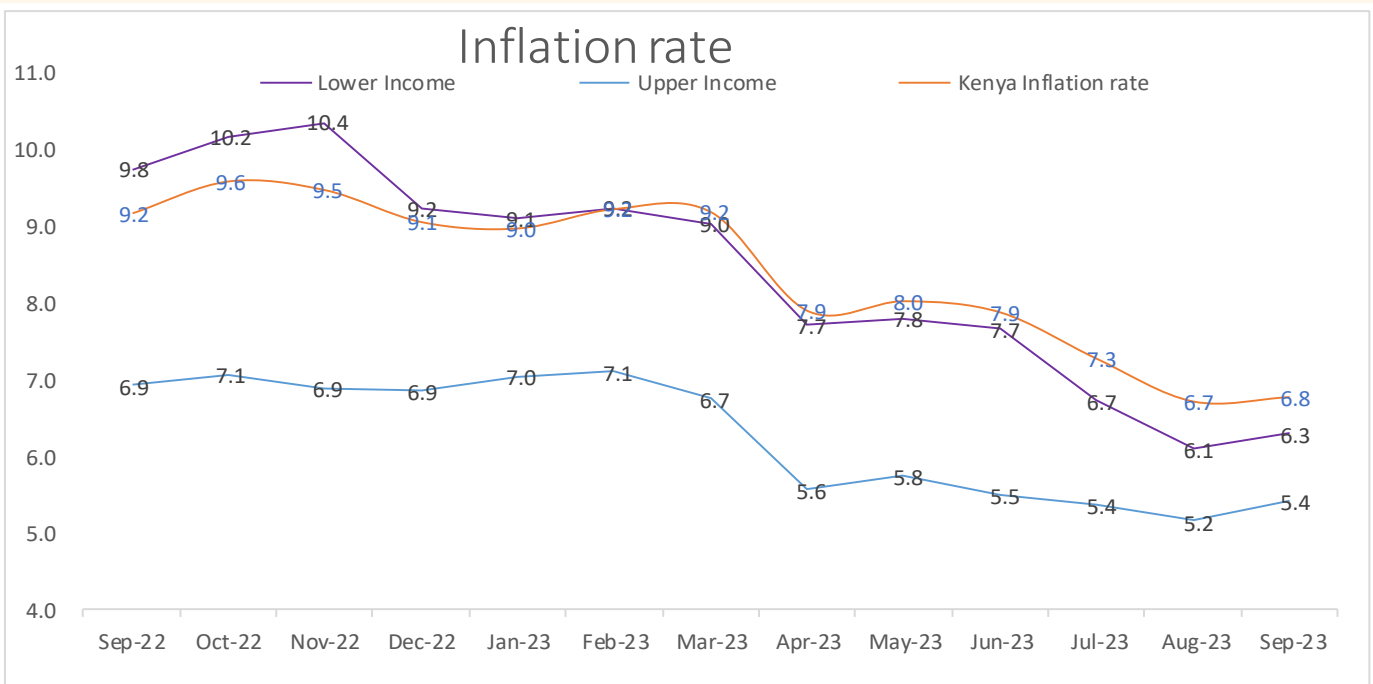

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

The Monthly Leading Economic Indicators report highlights changes in Consumer Price Indices, inflation, interest rates and exchange rates. In addition, the report details changes in selected indicators of international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 1.0 per cent, from an index of 134.02 in August 2023 to an index of 135.32 in September 2023, as indicated in Table 1(a). Additionally, the overall inflation, as measured by the Consumer Price Indices, increased from 6.7 per cent to 6.8 per cent during the same period, as presented in Table 1(b).

In September 2023, the Kenyan shilling demonstrated varied performance against selected major trading currencies. The shilling appreciated against the Sterling Pound and the Euro, but depreciated against the US Dollar, Japanese Yen, and South African Rand, as shown in Table 2.

The average yield for 91-day Treasury Bills, a significant indicator of interest rate trends, increased from 13.25 per cent in August 2023 to 14.38 per cent in September 2023. The central bank of Kenya maintained its benchmark interest rate at 10.50 per cent in September 2023. Average deposit rates rose from 8.10 per cent in July 2023 to 8.39 per cent in August 2023. Overdraft rates followed suit, increasing from 12.84 per cent to 13.24 per cent during the same period. The Inter-bank rates went up significantly from 10.34 per cent in July 2023 to 12.57 per cent in August 2023. Additionally, savings rates (Commercial Banks Rates) exhibited a modest increase, from 3.97 per cent to 4.05 per cent over the same period, as shown in Table 3.

The Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE) 20 share index declined from 1,540 points in August 2023 to 1,508 points in September 2023. During the same period, the total volume of shares traded increased from 241 million to 424 million. The number of equity transactions decreased from 23,885 in August to 20,474 in September 2023. Equities Market turnover increased from KSh 4.38 billion to KSh 5.22 billion during the same period, as outlined in Table 4.

Table 5(a) provides statistics on Money Supply. Broad money supply (M3), a crucial indicator for monetary policy, increased from KSh 5,698.19 billion in July 2023 to KSh 5,811.98 billion in August 2023. Foreign currency deposits rose from KSh 1,248.37 billion in July 2023 to KSh 1,328.58 billion in August 2023, as presented in Table 5(b).

AGRICULTURE



The quantity of coffee sold dropped from 4,407.45 MT in April 2023 to 1,373.50 MT in May 2023, as indicated in Table 6. The production of tea decreased from 48,127.89 MT in June 2023 to 44,696.62 MT in July 2023. The average auction price for Kenya tea in July 2023 was slightly lower at KSh 291.30 per Kg compared to KSh 291.87 per Kg in June 2023, while its average auction price during the seven-month period of 2023 stood at 2.25 USD per Kg as shown in Table 7.

Cane deliveries declined from 395.23 thousand metric tonnes in July 2023 to 295.81 thousand metric tonnes in August 2023 as shown in Table 8. The average monthly retail market price for one Kg of maize decreased from KSh 75.70 in August 2023 to KSh 71.20 in September 2023, as shown in Table 9(b). On the other hand, the average monthly retail market price for one Kg of beans increased from KSh 168.40 in August 2023 to KSh 170.40 in September 2023, as outlined in Table 9(d).

The quantity of exported coffee decreased from 4,652.03 MT in August 2023 to 2,967.04 MT in September 2023, along with a decrease in value from KSh 3.26 billion to KSh 2.02 billion over the same period. The quantity of exported tea decreased from 58,590.66 MT in August 2023 to 47,806.68 MT in September 2023, while the value decreased from KSh 20.19 billion to KSh 16.98 billion over the same period, as shown in Table 10.

Table 11 presents data on the monthly export of fresh horticultural produce. The quantity of exported vegetables increased from 5,254.93 MT in July 2023 to 6,536.28 MT in August 2023, with a rise in value from KSh 1,565.52 million to KSh 1,960.67 million during the same period. Additionally, the quantity of exported fruits increased from 22,916.07 MT in July 2023 to 23,159.46 MT in August 2023, with their value rising from KSh 3,702.47 million to KSh 3,880.63 million. The quantity of cut flowers exported was 9,121.84 MT, with a corresponding value of KSh 5,530.50 million in August 2023.



Table 12 presents monthly statistics on external trade. Volume of trade decreased from KSh 333.09 billion in August 2023 to KSh 306.79 billion in September 2023. The total export value also saw a decline, from KSh 94.27 billion in August 2023 to KSh 91.19 billion in September

2023. Similarly, the import value dropped from KSh 238.82 billion in August 2023 to KSh 215.60 billion in September 2023.

In September 2023, Uganda and Pakistan emerged as Kenya's major trading partners for exports, with values of KSh 10.10 billion and KSh 8.38 billion, respectively, as detailed in Table 13 (a). Food and beverages constituted a significant portion of domestic exports, comprising 47.2 per cent of the total exports, while industrial supplies made up 26.4 per cent, as indicated in Table 13(b). The main sources of imports, as outlined in Table 14(a), indicate that United Arab Emirates was the primary importing partner with a value of KSh 41.59 billion, followed by China with a value of KSh 40.96 billion in September 2023. The leading import category was non-food industrial supplies, accounting for 34.6 per cent of total imports in September 2023. Food and beverages represented 12.4 per cent of the total imports during the same period, as presented in Table 14(b).

The number of mobile money agents increased from 330,912 in July 2023 to 333,428 in August 2023. During the same period, the number of mobile money subscriptions rose from 77.21 million to 77.55 million. The number of mobile money transactions surged from KSh 202.85 million in July 2023 to KSh 208.61 million in August 2023. However, the total value of mobile money transactions decreased from KSh 684.64 billion in July 2023 to KSh 666.63 billion in August 2023, as highlighted in Table 14(c). The value of imports for telecommunication equipment decreased from KSh 4.49 billion in July 2023 to KSh 2.80 billion in August 2023, as shown in Table 14(d).



Tables 15(a) and 15(b) provide a comprehensive overview of the monthly electricity statistics. Local energy generation experienced a 2.6 per cent decrease, from 1,098.73 million KWh in August 2023 to 1,069.83 million KWh. During the same period, total KPLC sales dropped from 885.17

million KWh to 874.35 million KWh.

Electricity exports, saw an increase of 10.6 per cent, from 4.45 million KWh in August 2023 to 4.92 million KWh in September 2023. In contrast, electricity imports decreased from 55.47 million KWh in August to 49.93 million KWh in September 2023. Geo-Thermal emerged as the leading source of electricity generation, producing 511.88 million KWh, followed by Hydro with 247.20 million KWh in September 2023.

The national average domestic retail prices for motor gasoline premium, light diesel, and kerosene were KSh 212.25, KSh 201.73 and KSh 203.34 per litre, respectively in September 2023, as presented in Table 15(e). Charcoal prices averaged KSh 71.66 per Kg, while a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,795.69 during the same period. On the international front, the OPEC crude oil basket price increased from US Dollars 87.33 per barrel in August 2023 to US Dollars 94.01 per barrel in September 2023, as presented in Table 15(f).

Tables 17(a) to 17(f) outline various monthly manufacturing metrics. Sugar production witnessed a notable decline from 33,246 MT in July 2023 to 27,680 MT in August 2023. Production of soft drinks increased from 38,269 thousand litres in May 2023 to 42,192 thousand litres in June 2023. The number of assembled vehicles increased from 906 units in June 2023 to 974 units in July 2023. Production of galvanized sheets rose from 21,100 MT in June 2023 to 23,930 MT in July 2023. Cement production decreased from 865,310 MT in August 2023 to 831,534 MT in September 2023. Similarly, cement consumption decreased, from 826,947 MT to 799,297 MT during the same period. Milk intakes in the formal sector declined from 71.48 million litres in August to 67.71 million litres in September 2023.



The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports (MIA) decreased from 158,100 persons in July 2023 to 158,093 persons in August 2023, as shown in Table 18.

Tables 19(a) and 19(b) presents international passengers air traffic departures and arrivals through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. The number of international passengers departures increased by 4.9 per cent from 291,369 in July 2023 to 305,735 in August 2023. The number of international passengers arrivals, saw a slight increase of 0.8 per cent, from 299,108 in July 2023 to 301,644 in August 2023.

Table 19(c) presents the numbers of newly registered motor vehicles categorized by body type. The number of newly registered motor vehicles declined marginally by 2.7 per cent from 18,864 units in August 2023 to 18,352 units in September 2023. Newly registered motorcycles increased from 4,025 units in August 2023 to 5,343 units in September 2023

The Standard Gauge Railway (SGR) witnessed a substantial 26.1 per cent decrease in passenger numbers, declining from 278,929 in August 2023 to 206,090 in September 2023. This reduction in passengers led to a notable 23.3 per cent decrease in revenue from KSh 295.5 million in August 2023 to KSh 226.7 million in September 2023. Similarly, the volume of cargo transported via SGR saw a slight dip from 580,882 tonnes in August 2023 to 579,202 thousand tonnes in September 2023. Consequently, there was a 10.2 per cent drop in revenue from KSh 1,677.1 million in August 2023 to KSh 1,506.3 million in September 2023 as presented in Table 19(d). The number of passengers using the Metre Gauge Railway (MGR) decreased from 330,927 in August 2023 to 314,523 in September 2023. This decline in passengers resulted in a decrease in revenue generated from MGR passenger traffic from KSh 18.62 million to KSh 17.18 million during the same period, as outlined in Table 19(e).

Table 19(f) presents Mombasa Port throughput. The volume of cargo handled declined by 6.5 per cent from 2,955.36 thousand tonnes in August 2023 to 2,762.51 thousand tonnes in September 2023. Imports volume declined by 5.5 per cent from 2,363.28 thousand tonnes in August 2023 to 2,234.44 thousand in September 2023. Additionally, exports volume reduced by 9.8 per cent from 421.33 thousand tonnes in August 2023 to 379.99 thousand tonnes in September 2023. Transshipment and restows declined by 12.9 and 19.5 per cent respectively, during the same period.

Figure 1: Inflation Rates: 2022 - 2023

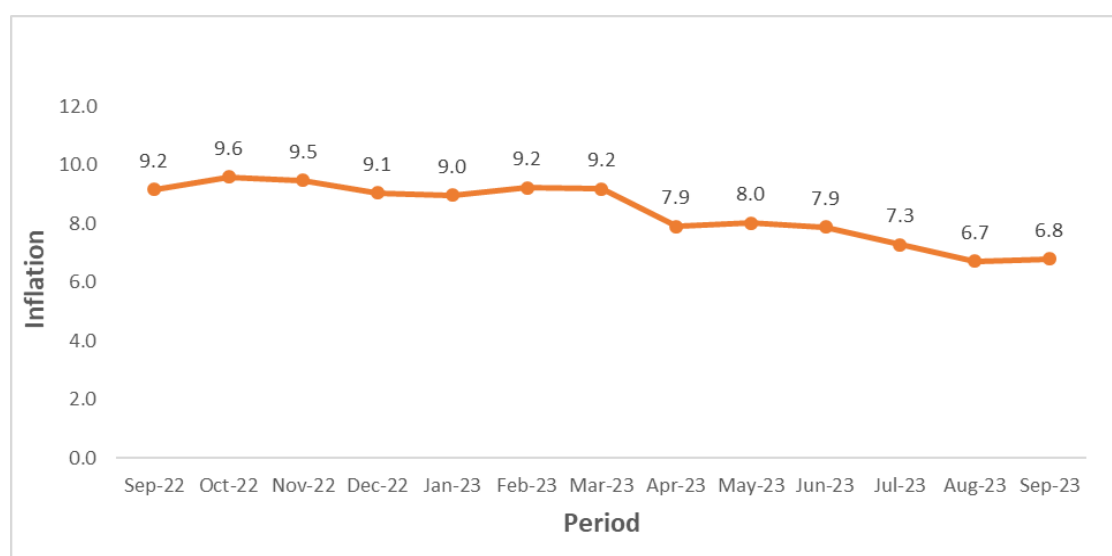

Figure 2: Mean Monthly Foreign Exchange Rates of Kenya Shillings against Selected Major Currencies

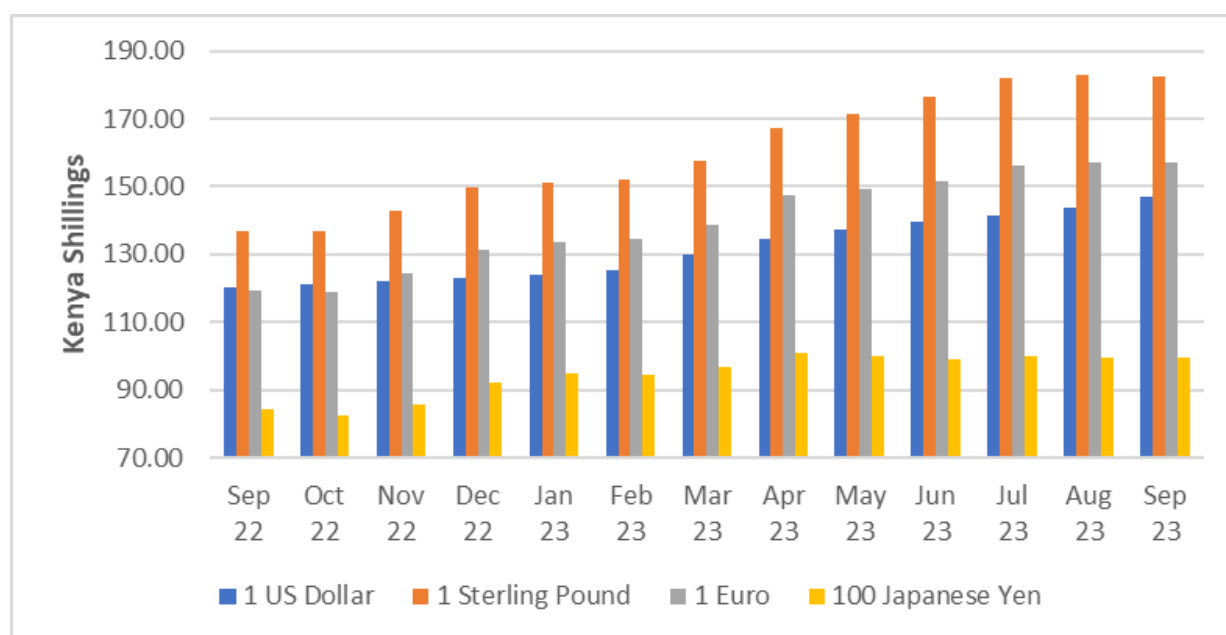

Figure 3: Nairobi Securities Exchange 20 Share Index

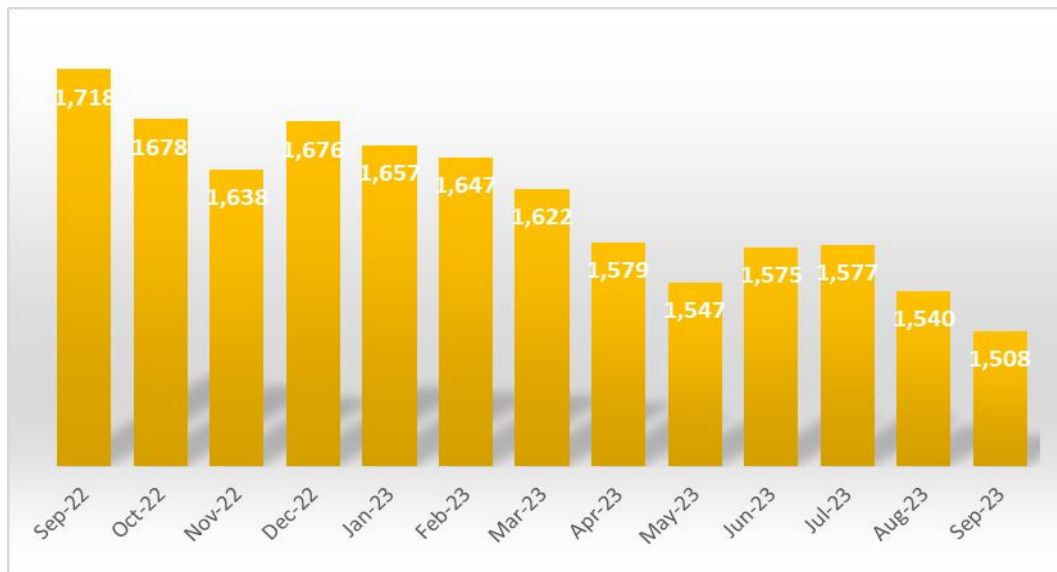

Figure 4: Coffee Sales at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange

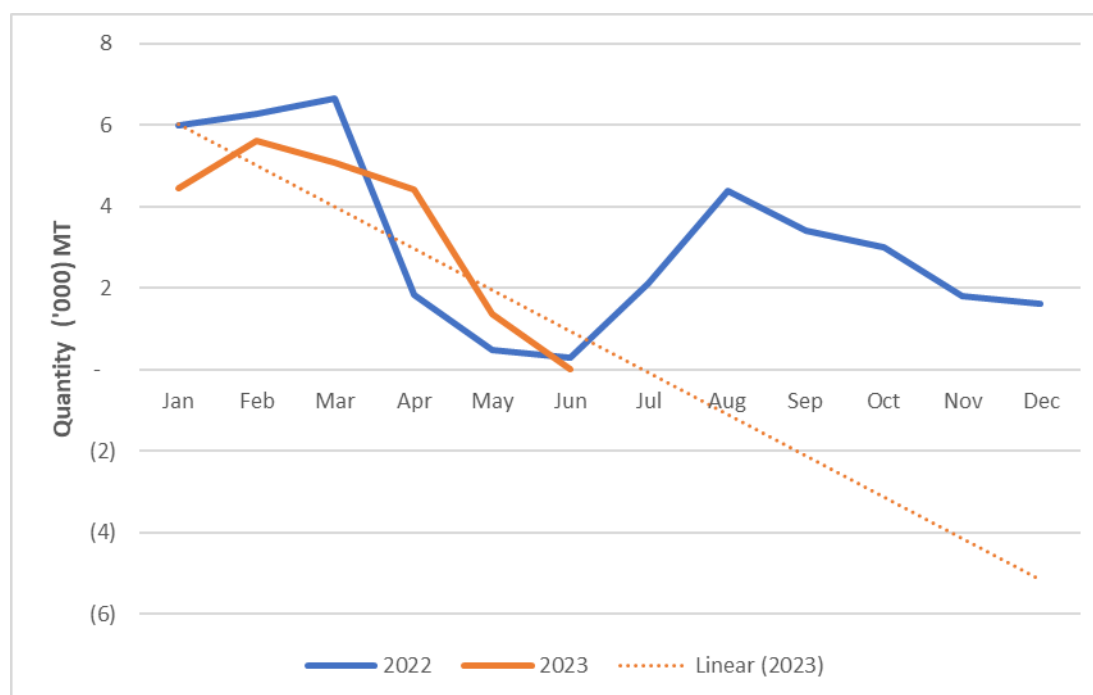

Figure 5: Tea Production

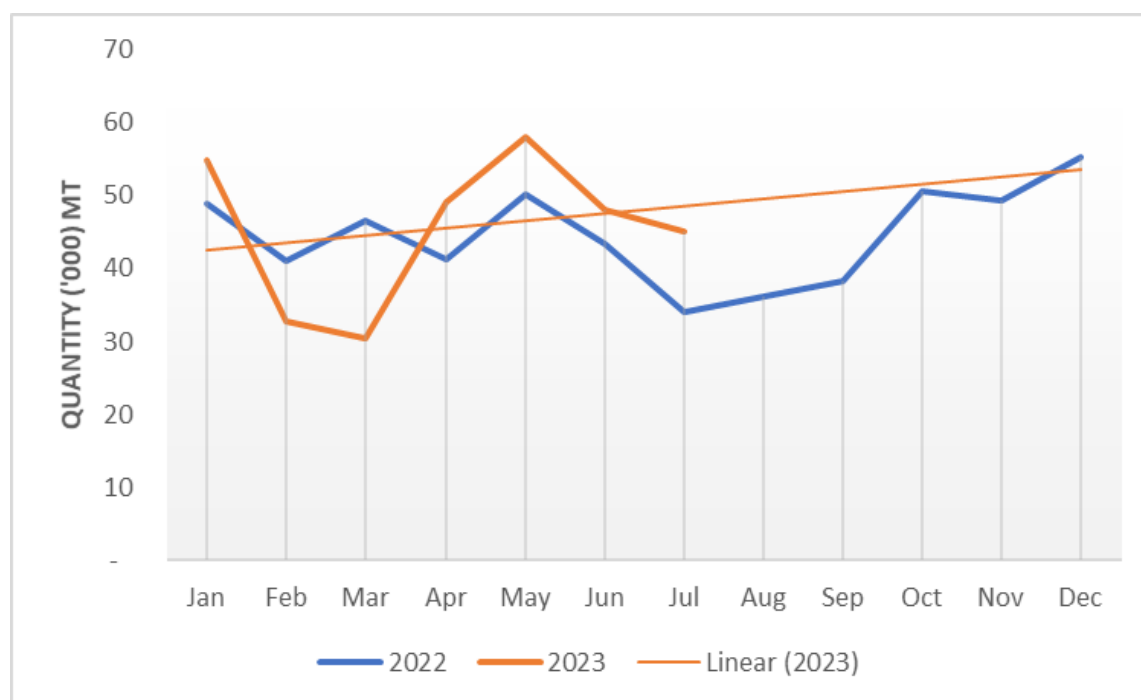

Figure 6: Cane Deliveries

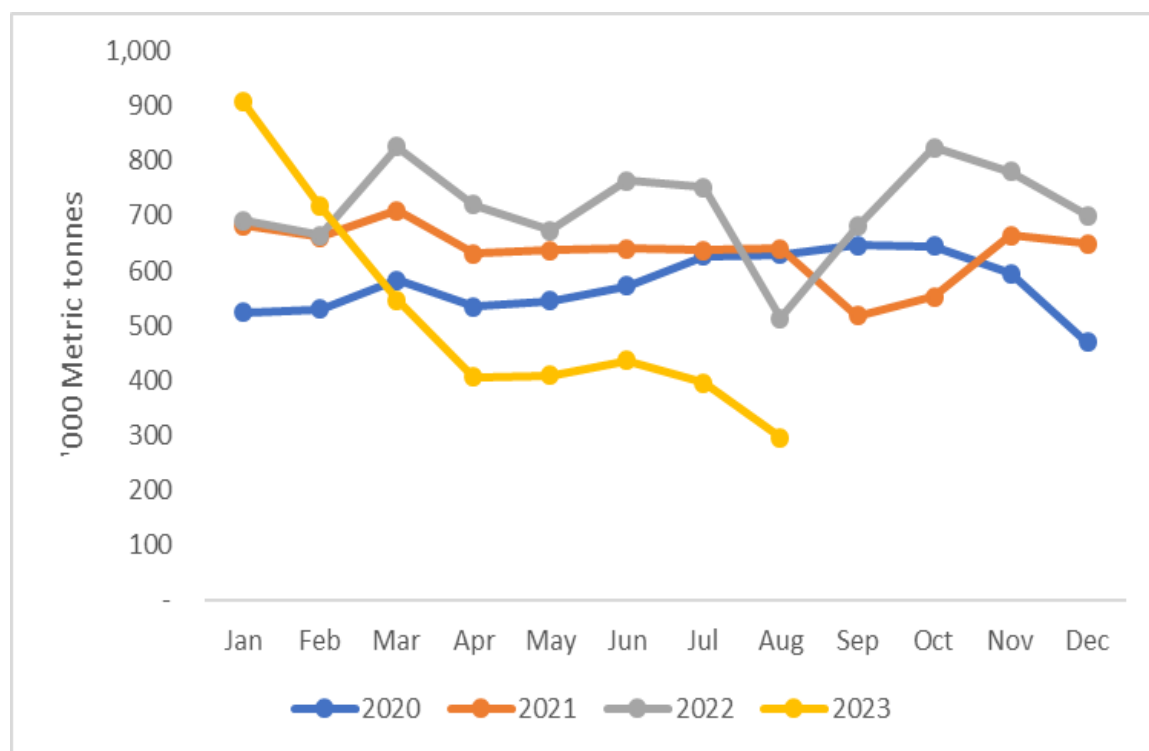

Figure 7: Electricity Generation by Source

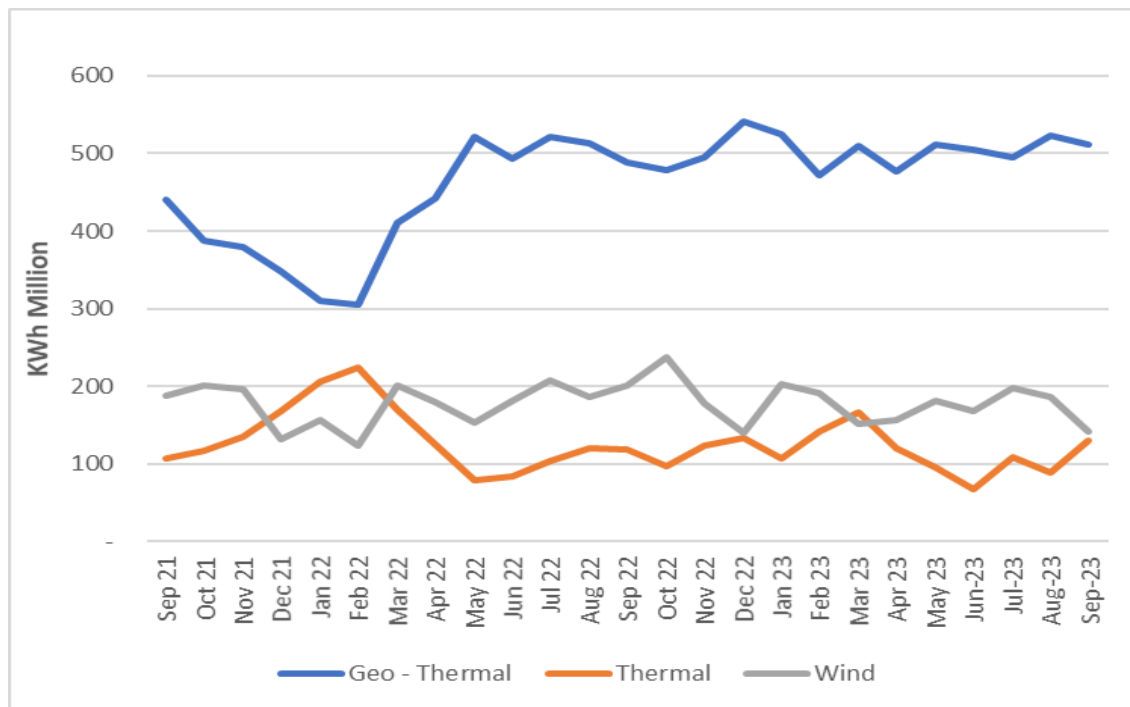

Figure 8: Average Prices for Liquefied Petroleum Gas in Kenya per 13 Kg cylinder

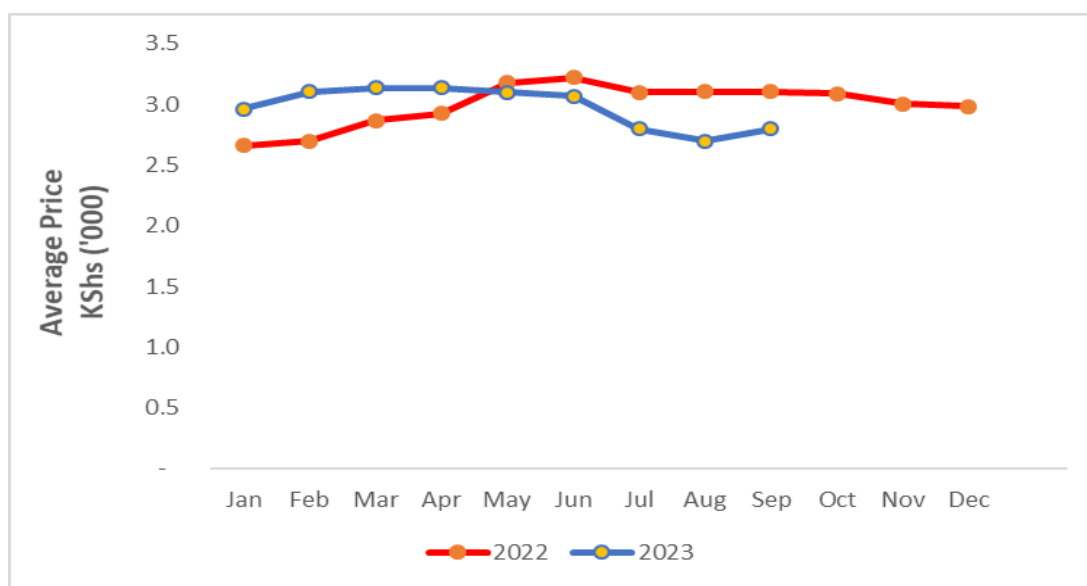

Figure 9: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector

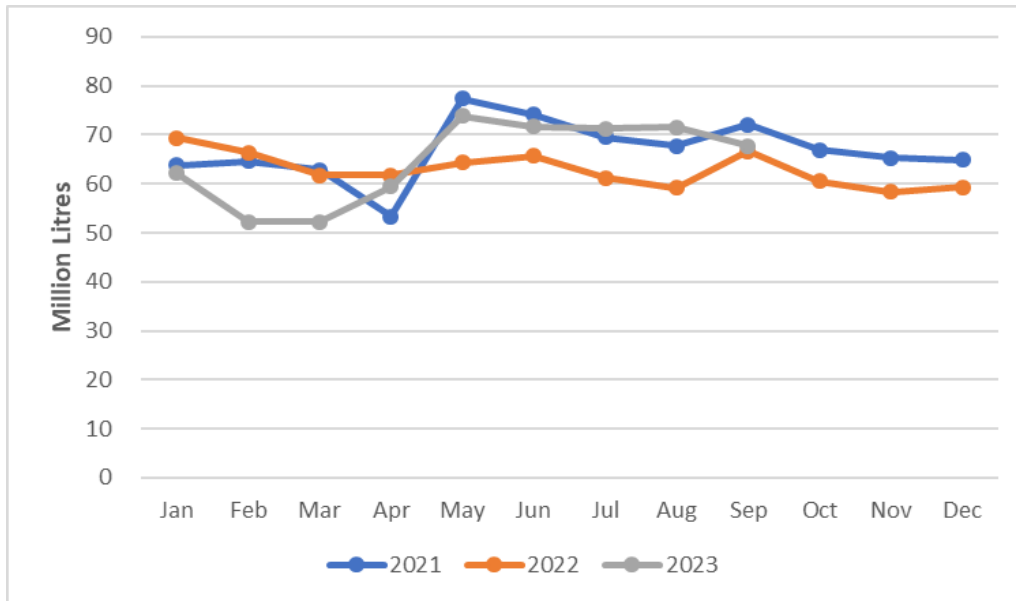

Figure 10: Visitor Arrivals through JKIA and MIA

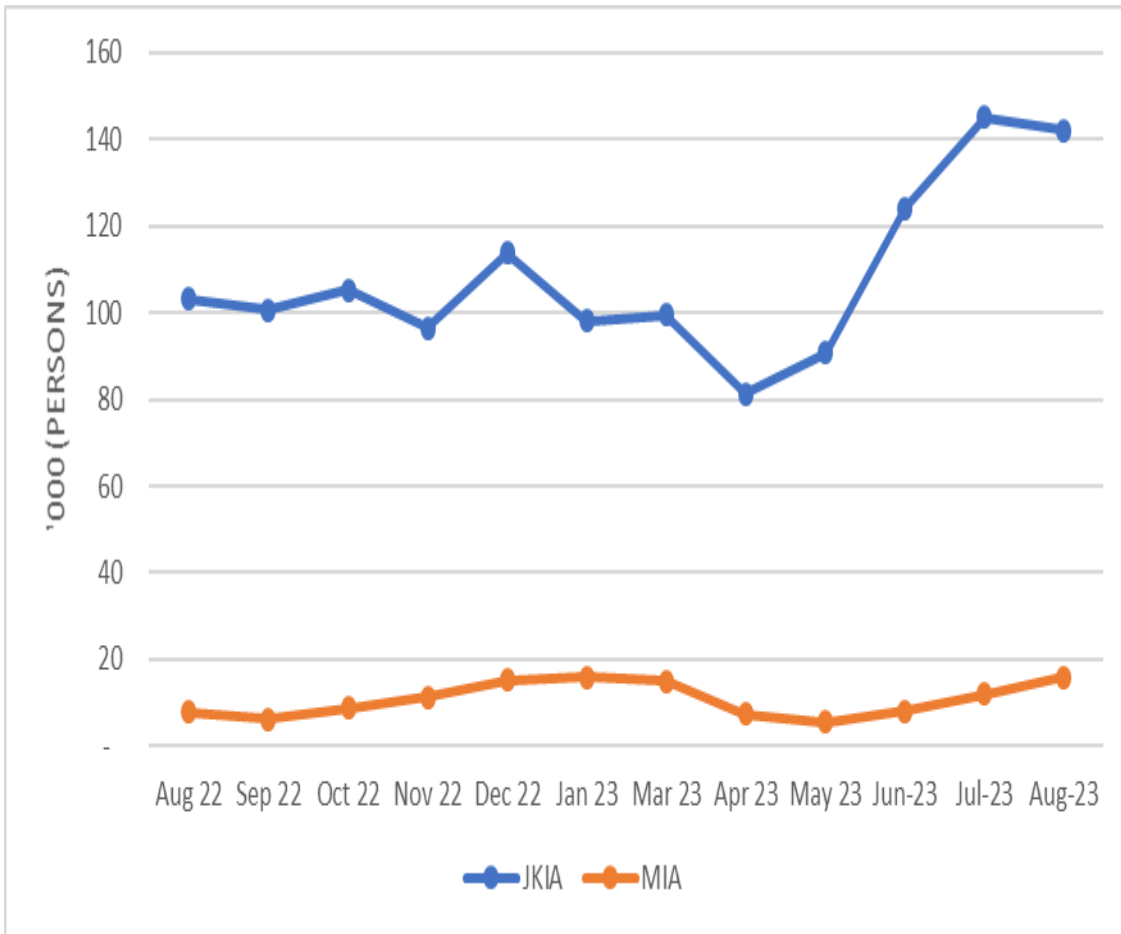
