# **Quarterly Balance of Payments**

## **Third Quarter, 2025**

## Balance of Payments

The current account deficit widened markedly from KSh 43.5 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 135.3 billion in the third quarter of 2025 as presented in Table 1. This increased deficit was largely driven by a wider merchandise trade deficit, valued on free on-board basis, and a decline in the Services Account surplus. The merchandise trade deficit expanded from KSh 321.1 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 355.8 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2025, reflecting a sharper increase in import expenditure relative to earnings from total exports. Imports rose by KSh 82.7 billion, compared to an increase of KSh 48.0 billion in exports. The higher import bill was mainly attributed to increased imports of industrial machinery, iron and steel, and road motor vehicles.

The net services surplus declined from KSh 100.6 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 57.2 billion in the third quarter of 2025. This was largely observed in a reduction in net inflows from travel, transport; and Government goods and services during the quarter under review. The deficit in the Primary Income narrowed from KSh 80.8 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 76.5 billion in the third quarter of 2025, supported by an increase of KSh 3.1 billion in primary income receipts to KSh 13.1 billion. The surplus in the Secondary Income account declined from KSh 257.7 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 239.8 billion in the third quarter of 2025, despite a marginal increase in diaspora remittances from KSh 164.9 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 165.5 billion in the third quarter of 2025.

Net external financing declined by 57.8 per cent from KSh 60.9 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 25.7 billion in the third quarter of 2025. This was partly attributable to reduced inflows, coupled with increased debt servicing, particularly on debt liabilities of General Government during the quarter under review. There was a KSh 63.7 billion draw down in Reserve Assets in the third quarter of 2025 compared to an increase of KSh 17.8 billion recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024, which is indicative of an increase in debt servicing.

## Stock of External Debt Liabilities of General Government

The stock of external debt liabilities of General Government amounted to KSh 5,618.2 billion at the end of September 2025 from KSh 5,434.7 billion at the end of September 2024 as presented in Table 2. The increase in the stock of external debt liabilities was majorly attributable to a 19.9 per cent increase in the stock of International Sovereign Bond following issuance of these debt securities in March and June 2025.

The stock of external loans accounted for 76.4 per cent of the stock of external debt liabilities at the end of September 2025 at KSh 4,292.6 billion with loans from multilateral sources increasing by 7.4 per cent to KSh 3,057.8 billion. On the other hand, the stock of debt from bilateral sources and commercial banks declined by 5.7 per cent and 28.3 per cent to KSh 996.5 billion and KSh 223.8 billion, respectively, at the end of September 2025. The reduction was attributable to a restructuring of debt in July 2025.

Non-resident holdings of Treasury Bonds declined from KSh 349.4 billion at the end of September 2024 to KSh 298.8 billion at the end of September 2025 while that of Treasury Bills rose by 36.2 per cent to KSh 4.1 billion at the end of September 2025. The stock of International Sovereign Bond accounted for 18.2 per cent of the stock of external liabilities of General Government at the end of September 2025.

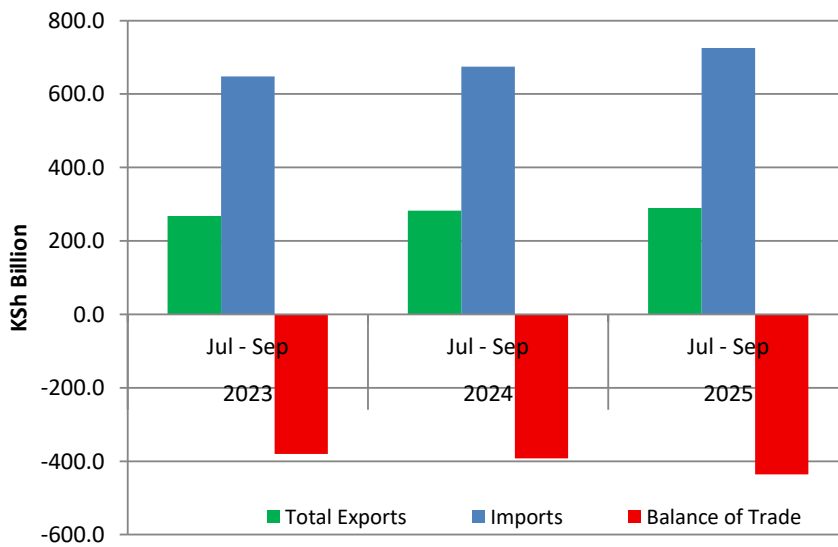
Debt issued by non-residents is recognized as external irrespective of the currency in which the debt is denominated or issued and vice versa.

### International Merchandise Trade

In the third quarter of 2025, the total volume of trade increased to KSh 1,014.4 billion from KSh 957.3 billion recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024. This growth was driven by increases in both imports and total exports, as shown in Figure 1 and Table 3. The higher increase in import values compared to that of total exports resulted in worsening of the balance of trade, from a deficit of KSh 392.5 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to a deficit of KSh 435.6 billion in the third quarter of 2025.

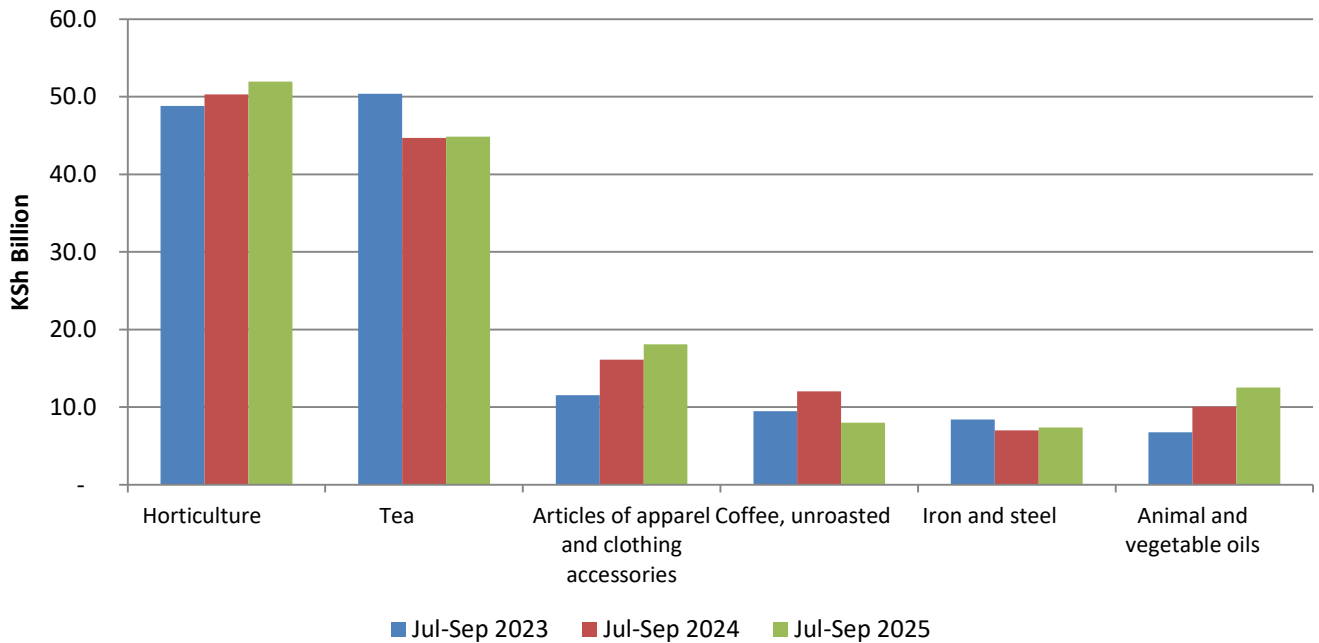

### Value of Domestic Exports

Earnings from domestic exports increased by 1.2 per cent in the third quarter of 2025 compared with the same quarter of 2024. This was primarily contributed by higher export values of animal and vegetable oils, and cut flowers, which rose by 24.3 per cent and 11.6 per cent, respectively, as presented in Figure 2 and Annex 1. Articles of apparel and clothing accessories as well as edible products and preparations, also recorded notable increases in their values during the review period.

Despite the increase in domestic export revenues, earnings from domestic exports of coffee declined significantly, largely occasioned by a decline in exported quantities, which more than halved compared to the third quarter of 2024, as indicated in Annex 2.

The Broad Economic Category (BEC) analysis shows that food and beverages category remained the leading source of foreign exchange in the third quarter of 2025, accounting for 43.4 per cent of total earnings from domestic exports. This performance was primarily supported by the primary food and beverage subcategory, as shown in Annex 7. The value of domestic exports of fuel and lubricants increased from KSh 4.1 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 4.6 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2025, largely driven by a higher export value of lubricants.

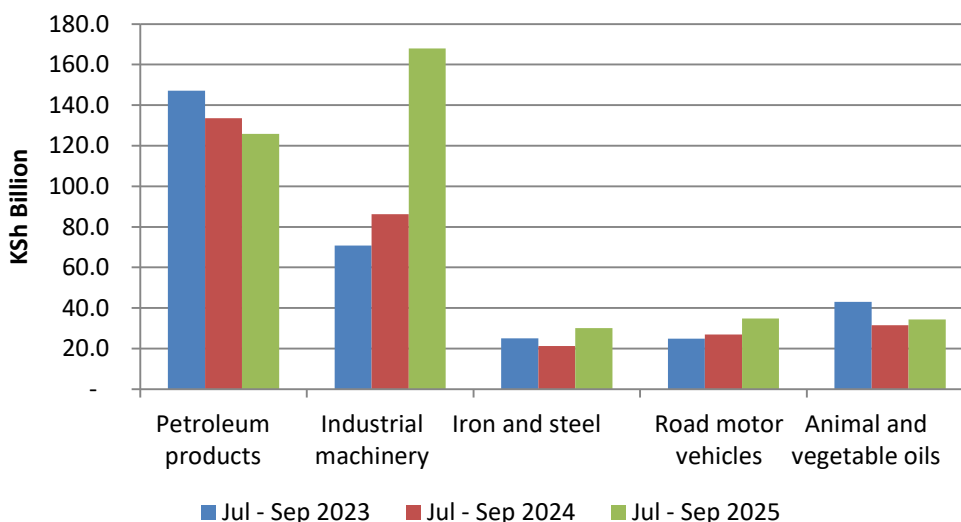
### Value of Imports

During the third quarter of 2025, the import bill amounted to KSh 725.0 billion, representing a 7.4 per cent increase compared with the same quarter of 2024. This increase was largely on account of increased expenditure on imported industrial machinery (94.8%), iron and steel (41.0%), road motor vehicles (29.1%); and sugars, molasses and honey (88.4%), as shown in Figure 3 and Annex 3. In contrast, there were reductions in import expenditures on medicinal and pharmaceutical products, petroleum products, wheat and chemical fertilizers of 32.1, 5.8, 19.8 and 29.7 per cent, respectively.

Analysis of imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) showed that non-food industrial supplies accounted for the largest share of the total import bill during the quarter under

review at 34.4 per cent, following a 9.4 per cent increase from the corresponding quarter of 2024, as shown in Annex 8. Notably, expenditure on imports of machinery and other capital equipment rose from KSh 96.3 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 139.1 billion in the third quarter of 2025. Conversely, expenditure on imports of fuel and lubricants; transport equipment; and consumer goods not elsewhere specified declined by 3.7, 6.1 and 12.0 per cent, respectively, over the same period.

### Direction of International Merchandise Trade

Total export earnings in the third quarter of 2025 rose to KSh 289.4 billion from KSh 282.4 billion recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024. This represented 2.5 per cent growth, primarily supported by improved exports to Africa and Europe. Africa remained the largest destination for Kenya's exports accounting for 44.6 per cent of the total export earnings after registering a 15.3 per cent increase, over the review period. This performance was primarily driven by increased exports to Democratic Republic of Congo (57.5%), Uganda (34.5%), Egypt (31.1%) and Rwanda (10.9%). Specifically, increases were recorded in re-exports of kerosene type jet fuel to Democratic Republic of Congo; domestic exports of potatoes and re-exports of gas oil and motor spirit (gasoline) premium to Uganda; domestic exports of tea to Egypt; and re-exports of motor spirit (gasoline) premium to Rwanda. Conversely, there were notable declines in export earnings from Sudan, South Sudan and Somalia, by 92.1, 26.1 and 21.7 per cent, respectively, during the review period.

Foreign exchange earnings from exports to Europe rose by 5.2 per cent to KSh 60.8 billion in the third quarter of 2025. This growth was mainly as a result of increased exports to the Netherlands (14.2%) and Kazakhstan (61.4%), partly occasioned by increased domestic exports of cut flowers and macadamia nuts.

On the other hand, revenue from exports to the Americas declined from KSh 26.2 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 24.4 billion in the third quarter of 2025, largely due to decreased domestic exports of coffee to the United States of America. Exports to Asia contracted by 14.2 per cent to KSh 68.0 billion, mainly on account of reduced export earnings from the United Arab Emirates (43.5%), India (52.8%), Pakistan (13.1%) and Yemen Arab Republic (86.0%).

Import expenditure in the third quarter of 2025 went up by 7.4 per cent to KSh 725.0 billion, supported by increased imports from countries in Far East Asia and the European Union. Asia remained the dominant source of Kenya's imports, with the region's share rising by 5.9 per cent to account for 68.6 per cent of the total import expenditure during the quarter under review. This was largely on account of increased imports from Saudi Arabia and South Korea, which more than doubled, as well as China (8.6%) and Malaysia (20.4%). Specifically, there were increased imports of gas oil from Saudi Arabia, condensers for steam or other vapour power units from South Korea, crushing and grinding machines from China and palm oil from Malaysia. In spite of the overall growth in imports from Asia, there was a substantial decline in imports from the United Arab Emirates (UAE), attributed to reduced imports of motor spirit (gasoline) premium and gas oil. Consequently, total imports from the UAE declined from KSh 88.8 billion in the third quarter of 2024 to KSh 68.8 billion in the third quarter of 2025.

The value of imports from Europe amounted to KSh 99.6 billion in the third quarter of 2025, a 7.8 per cent increase from the same quarter of 2024. This growth was largely driven by increase in imports from Belgium and Germany which jointly contributed KSh 15.5 billion to the overall increase. Particularly, there were increased importation of motor spirit (gasoline) premium from Belgium; and vacuum pumps and dish washing machines from Germany. Conversely, imports from the Netherlands and Russian Federation decreased by 31.0 per cent and 36.4 per cent to KSh 5.3 billion and KSh 11.8 billion, respectively, partly due to reduced imports of residual oils from the Netherlands and wheat and meslin from the Russian Federation.

In the third quarter of 2025, the import bill from Africa amounted to KSh 74.7 billion compared to KSh 66.3 billion recorded in the third quarter of 2024, representing an increase of 12.6 per cent. This increase was partly due to increased importation of coal from South Africa and sugar from Uganda.

Similarly, import expenditure from the Americas grew by 19.8 per cent to KSh 50.5 billion in the third quarter of 2025. The rise was primarily boosted by increased imports of turbo jets and coal from the United States of America, which singly contributed KSh 7.1 billion to the overall growth.

In contrast, during the same review period, the value of imports from Australia and Oceania halved compared to the corresponding quarter of 2024. The decline was primarily occasioned by decreased imports of butanes from Australia which slowed down imports from this region.
